



YOU ARE A TERRORIST CLAIMS VICTIM...



Clarington - Hobby farms are common all over Durham Region. They are nothing new. The killing of animals for food is nothing new either, as long as the proper permits are obtained and the laws are followed. This type of activity is not new. People have been practising this for centuries. In the past two weeks, this common practice has crossed over into an ugly new reality in Canada. According to reports, former Mayor of Clarington John Mutton, following citizens' concerns, decided to investigate a property that was allegedly killing animals and selling them online without a permit at a farm located at 3548 Middle Road, Bowmanville. Mutton explains, "I was inundated with messages, calls, and photos," he said of the property. "I think we have an epidemic of illegal slaughterhouses, and I just thought, 'I better do something about it, because maybe people just don't know,'" Mutton said. "There are significant public health issues and animal welfare issues related to this, and there's definitely an underground economy with the halal meat business." The incident normally would not get much attention, as these types of incidents are usually resolved in a civil and neighbourly manner. Well, it appears that this was not the case. United Farms of Bowmanville was approached by Mutton on suspicions of an illegal slaughterhouse being operated on Middle Road, right across from the golf club. The property, owned by Mohsin Bhuiyan, was associated with Bhuiyan, who was the federal Conservative candidate for Scarborough Southwest in 2021.

While being recorded, Mr. Bhuiyan, the owner of the property, insulted Mutton and was seen on video pointing at him while making statements such as, "MUTTON YOU ARE A TERRORIST." Now this does not sound like the words of a friendly neighbour or civil-minded farmer. What began as an online theory has rapidly evolved into a coordinated campaign of white supremacist harassment to cover for activities at this location. Mr. Bhuiyan has gone on record saying there is no slaughtering, then claiming that there is, but only for personal use. Now, Mr. Bhuiyan says he and his family have been "terrorized" by those pushing misinformation about his property online, suggesting he is running an "illegal slaughterhouse" on site. "It is more of an experiment now. If we decide to operate commercially in the future, then we will go through the process for that. Right now, we sell or give away birds sometimes when we have too many," he said of the flock of ducks, which he estimates at between 500 and 600 birds. Some questioned whether 600 birds is more than personal consumption. Mr. Bhuiyan is making allegations toward Mutton, calling him a supremacist based solely on the fact that Mutton is white. Mr. Bhuiyan says he is living a "nightmare" after false allegations of an illegal slaughterhouse on his property transformed from online rumours into real-world harassment, threats, and a planned protest. That interaction was filmed by John Mutton, the former Mayor of Clarington. Mutton was the lobbyist dubbed "Mr. X" in a report into the removal of Greenbelt land.

Since this farm was brought into question, two other area farms have also been questioned. On Celina St., according to unverified sources, a cow was set on fire (picture above left). At this property, someone took a picture of a Tamil Eelam flag being flown as a form of social defiance and an anti-white supremacist symbol. The Tamil Eelam flag is not a terrorist group, but a flag that represents the proposed independent state of Tamil Eelam in Sri Lanka. However, it is heavily associated with the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE), a defunct militant organization that is legally designated as a terrorist group by several countries. Witnesses have seen dead carcasses thrown on the lawn in a pile, along with illegal tree cutting, pond work, and water being redirected. "This is just as bad as the Usual Suspects netting or clubbing our salmon in the creeks," claims Mutton. This is another affront to Bowmanville and one that is worthy of Ontario-wide and Canada-wide attention for the massive slaughter of wildlife. Subsequently, as of June 30, 2026, the Municipality has found no evidence of any illegal abattoirs (slaughterhouses) operating in Clarington. While several properties have recently been discussed on social media, Municipal Law Enforcement received formal complaints about a single property and conducted an investigation. The investigation found no evidence of an abattoir operating on the property. Building Division inspectors identified Building Code matters unrelated to meat processing; no evidence has been confirmed to support claims of illegal meat processing. Clarington Mayor Adrian Foster joined the National Council of Canadian Muslims (NCCM) and resident Mohsin Bhuiyan in Bowmanville on July 2 to denounce a recent social media campaign against Bhuiyan and other area farmers claiming they were operating illegal abattoirs. "There is no slaughterhouse," Foster said of the claims, which were investigated by

Clarington's Municipal Law Enforcement, the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Agribusiness, and Durham Region Public Health. Omar Khamissa, Chief Mobilization Officer for the National Council of Canadian Muslims, says the targeting of Bhuiyan's farm and others is part of a "spike of Islamophobia" that has turned online spaces into a "safe haven" for conspiracy theories. "It started as something that was online, and now it's transformed into real-life harassment, real-life campaigns, and real-life threats," Khamissa said. He noted that the situation escalated when the misinformation was shared by influential figures, such as Mutton. **Online comments included:** **Cassie Mayer** So sick of racism being used to avoid accountability. **Stephen Watts** They always cry racism and Islamophobia when they don't get their own way, and the councillors, mayors, government, etc. tuck their balls away to accommodate so they don't get sued or made to look bad.
