



SUSPECTS WANTED AFTER 16 YEAR-OLD STABBED IN PICKERING

Police are searching for at least one suspect after a 16-year-old male was stabbed following an altercation at a residence in Pickering. On Friday, October 25, 2025, at approximately 8:50 p.m., members of West Division responded to an armed person call at a residence in the area of Breezy Drive and Mink Street. A large number of youth were at the residence for a party when a physical altercation occurred and a male youth was stabbed. Officers arrived on scene as numerous individuals were fleeing the area. Police later located the victim at a Toronto-area hospital. He was subsequently transferred to a Toronto-area trauma centre for serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

MULTIPLE SHOTS FIRED AT RESIDENCE IN PICKERING

Police are seeking information after shots were fired at a residence in Pickering. On Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at approximately 1:10 p.m., members of West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Frontier Court and Chantilly Road. Officers arrived on scene and located multiple bullet holes in a residence. Further investigation revealed the shooting occurred overnight. The residents were home at the time of the shooting, however no physical injuries were reported.

MALE FACING CHARGES AFTER LOADED FIREARM, DRUGS AND

CASH SEIZED

One male is facing charges following the execution of a search warrant. On Friday, October 24, 2025, at approximately 8:50 p.m., members of the Durham Regional Police Service concluded an investigation which resulted in a Criminal Code search warrant being executed at a residence in Markham. Officers seized a loaded handgun, more than 1,000 grams of fentanyl, a large quantity of cocaine and crystal methamphetamine as well as \$100,000 in cash.

Jai'Lyn MITCHELL-CHARLES, age 25 of Markham is charged with several offences including: Possession of a Loaded Restricted / Prohibited Firearm; Possession of a Firearm Knowing the Serial Number has been Tampered with; Unauthorized Possession of a Restricted / Prohibited Firearm Knowing it's Unauthorized; Possession of a Prohibited Device x3; Possession Contrary to Order; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Cocaine); Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Fentanyl); Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (methamphetamine)

FATAL COLLISION IN PICKERING

An 85-year-old female suffered fatal injuries after a two-vehicle collision in Pickering. On Monday, October 27, 2025, at approximately 10:45 a.m., members of West Division were dispatched to a collision on Altona Road, south of Pickering Concession Road 3. An 85-year-old female was driving a Pontiac sedan northbound on Altona Road when it was struck by a southbound Toyota SUV, that crossed into the northbound lane. The driver of the Pontiac was transported to a local-area hospital where she was pronounced deceased. An 84-year-old female passenger in the Pontiac was transported to a Toronto-area trauma cen-



ter, where she remains in stable but critical condition. The 74-year-old female driver of the Toyota was transported to a local-area hospital with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

PEDESTRIAN STRUCK IN MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISION

Pedestrian struck in motor vehicle collision in Oshawa. On Sunday, October 26, 2025, at approximately 2:00 p.m., members of East Division responded to a motor vehicle collision involving a vehicle and pedestrian in the area of Olive Avenue and Townline Road South. A motor vehicle was heading east on Olive Avenue, making a left-hand turn onto Townline Road South, when it struck a pedestrian who was crossing the roadway at a marked crosswalk. The 66-year-old pedestrian was seriously injured and transported to a local-area hospital where they remain in critical condition.

The driver of the motor vehicle remained on scene and did not sustain any injuries.

MALE FACING FIREARM AND ASSAULT CHARGES AFTER INVESTIGATION

A male is facing numerous firearm, drug and assault charges after an investigation. In early October 2025, investigators commenced an investigation after receiving information about a male who, on multiple occasions assaulted

males were held for bail hearings before being released on release orders issued by the Ontario Court of Justice. One of the conditions of the release order was to reside at the addresses the accused provided to the courts. Members of the DRPS Financial Crimes Unit conducted compliance checks on both accused and neither reside at the addresses they provided to the court.

THREE FEMALES WANTED AFTER SIGNIFICANT THEFT FROM PICKERING MALL

Police are searching for two wanted females and attempting to identify a third after more than \$30,000 of sunglasses were stolen from a business in the Shops at Pickering City Centre. On Monday, September 29, 2025, at approximately 8:20 p.m., three females entered the Lenscrafters store located in the Shops at Pickering City Centre at 1355 Kingston Road. The three suspects stole more than 60 pairs of designer sunglasses before fleeing the store. Through investigation, members of the West Division Criminal Investigations Branch (CIB) were able to identify two suspects. On Sunday, October 26, 2025, the West Division CIB team executed a search warrant at a residence in the area of Dundas Street West and Scarlett Road in Toronto. Over \$25,000 of the stolen property was located. Two of the suspects have been identified and are wanted by police.

Carolyn Vanessa WALKER, age 33 from Toronto is wanted for: Theft Over \$5000, and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000.

A 17-year-old female from Mississauga is wanted for: Theft Over \$5000, and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000.

An unidentified third suspect is wanted for: Theft Over \$5000, and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000.

Investigators are advising the suspects to contact counsel and turn themselves into police. Anyone who is found to be assisting the suspects to evade police is guilty of an offence under the Criminal Code of Canada and will be prosecuted to the full extent.

SHOOTING IN OSHAWA LEAVES VICTIM WITH SERIOUS INJURIES

Police are seeking for information after an overnight shooting in Oshawa left one male with serious injuries. On Wednesday, October 22, 2025, at approximately 11:50 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to shooting in the area of Simcoe Street South and John Street East. Officers arrived on scene and located a male who had been shot. The victim was transported to a local hospital with serious, non-life-threatening injuries. Police are currently looking for two suspects who fled the area prior to police arrival. The first suspect is described as: male wearing a black baseball hat, black jacket, red hooded sweater, red pants and black shoes. The second suspect is described as: male, with long dread-style hair. He was wearing a light-coloured hat, bright blue jacket with black shoulders and a white logo on the rear right shoulder and dark pants with a white stripe down the side.
