Suspect Sought After Male Shot in Oshawa

Police are searching for a suspect after a male was shot in Oshawa.

On Sunday, June 14, 2026, at approximately 3:00 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a shooting in the area of Ritson Road North and Pentland Street. Officers arrived on scene and located a male suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim was transported to a local area hospital in serious but non-life-threatening condition and has since been upgraded to stable.

Male from Ontario Shores Wanted on Warrant of Committal

Police are searching for a male who is wanted on a Warrant of Committal in Whitby.

Delroy APPLE, age 47, was last seen at approximately 7:00 p.m., on Thursday, June 18, 2026 at Ontario Shores located at 700 Gordon Street in Whitby.

APPLE is wanted on a Warrant of Committal. If you see him, do not approach and call the police.

He is described as: male, Black, 5'6", short dark hair, with a medium build. He was last seen wearing a white shirt, grey pants and multi-coloured shoes.

Female Arrested for Identity Fraud at Bank in Clarington

A female is facing charges after attempting to fraudulently open a bank account in Clarington.

On Thursday, May 28, 2026, at approximately 2:40 p.m., members of East Division responded to a fraud call at the Scotia Bank located at 1500 Regional Highway 2. A female was at the bank attempting to open an account using a fraudulent driver's licence. Officers arrived on scene and took the suspect into custody without incident. The suspect had reportedly attempted to open an account at a different bank earlier that morning, using fraudulent identification, but was refused.

Alicia Dawn MILLER, age 41 from Toronto is charged with: Possess Identity Document of Another, Utter Forged Document, and Fraud Under \$5000.

Male Wanted for Counterfeit Currency Fraud at Oshawa Centre

Police have issued a warrant for a male who attempted to use counterfeit currency to make purchases at the Oshawa Centre.

On Friday, March 20, 2026, at approximately 7:20 p.m.,

members of Central East Division responded to a fraud call at the Oshawa Centre located at 419 King Street West. A male attended various businesses and attempted to use fraudulent currency to purchase items. Mall security attempted to stop the suspect; however, he fled the area on foot.

Liam Dylan BRAMLEY-MONTGOMERY, age 30 from Oshawa is wanted for: Fraud Under \$5000 x3, Utter Counterfeit Currency x3, and Breach Probation.

Four Arrested Following Joint Gun and Drug Investigation

Three males and one female are facing drug and firearm charges following a joint investigation between the Durham Regional Police Service and the Toronto Police Service.

In April 2026, Durham Regional Police launched Project Vista, after two victims were threatened and assaulted with a firearm.

On Wednesday, June 3, 2026, through a joint operation with the Toronto Police Service Gun and Gang Task Force, a suspect was identified and arrested after search warrants were executed at a Toronto residence. As a result, drugs, a prohibited firearm magazine, and ammunition were located and seized.

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, an additional search warrant was executed at a residence in Oshawa where several individuals were taken into custody without incident. As a result, a loaded firearm, a quantity of drugs (including cocaine, methamphetamine, heroin, fentanyl, and hydro-morphone), drug paraphernalia, and Canadian currency were located and seized.

Dane FAIRCLOUGH, age 32 from Oshawa is charged with: Assault with a Weapon x3, Assault Cause Bodily Harm, Uttering Threats, Assault, Point Firearm, and Forcible Confinement.

Baldwin Oswald CLARKE, age 35 from Oshawa is charged with: Point Firearm, Possess Weapon Dangerous, Forcible Confinement, Disobey Court Order, Assault Cause Bodily Harm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm – No Licence, Possession of Firearm While Prohibited, Possess Loaded Firearm, and Possess Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking x5.

Andria SCHWAB, age 42 from Oshawa is charged with: Forcible Confinement, Assault Cause Bodily Harm, and Possess Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking x5.

Suspects Sought After Shooting in Pickering

Police are searching for at least one suspect following a shooting in Pickering.

On Saturday, June 13, 2026, at approximately 2:15 a.m., members of West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Dunbarton Road and Dunchurch Street. Police received reports of several gun shots heard in the area. Officers arrived on scene and located evidence of gunfire.

Two Arrested After Stabbing Investigation in Scugog

A male and female are facing attempt murder charges following an investigation in Scugog.

On Wednesday, May 13, 2026, at approximately 9:15 p.m., members of North Division responded to an armed person call at a park in the area of Water Street and Mary Street. Officers arrived on scene and administered medical care after locating a male suffering from stab wounds. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre in serious life-threatening condition, where he was later upgraded to stable.

Further investigation revealed that the victim was brought to the park by a known female. While at the park, the victim was ambushed by the known female and a suspect male who stabbed the victim several times and attempted to force him into a vehicle. The suspects fled the area after the victim was able to defend himself.

On Wednesday, June 10, 2026, investigators located and arrested both suspects without incident in Toronto.

James Leigh HASTINGS, age 36 from Toronto is charged with: Attempt Murder, Aggravated Assault, Forcible Confinement, Possess Weapon Dangerous, Fail to Comply with Release Order, and Breach Probation. At the time of the incident, the accused was on weapons prohibition conditions.

Shannon Lois Marjorie KEHOE, age 51 from Toronto is charged with: Attempt Murder, Aggravated Assault, and Forcible Confinement.

One Arrested One Wanted After Firearm Investigation in Courtice

A male is wanted and a female is facing charges following a firearm investigation in Courtice.

In May 2026, investigators with the Drug Enforcement Unit began an investigation into a male believed to be in possession of a firearm.

On Friday, June 5, 2026, the Drug Enforcement Unit, with the assistance of the Tactical Support Unit, executed a search warrant on a residence in Courtice. A firearm with ammunition and over \$118,000 of Canadian currency was located and seized. A female suspect was located in the residence and taken into custody without incident. A male suspect remains wanted.

Daniella BURGHER, age 46 from Clarington is charged with: Possession of a Firearm, and Possession of Unloaded Firearm with Ammunition. She was held for a bail hearing.

Robert Andrew PINNOCK, age 45 from Clarington is wanted for: Possession of a Firearm, Possess Unloaded Firearm with Ammunition.

Pedestrian Suffers Serious Injuries After Collision in Bowmanville

A pedestrian has suffered serious injuries following a single vehicle collision in Bowmanville.

On Friday, June 5, 2026 at approximately 12:25 p.m., members of East Division responded to a pedestrian involved collision in the parking lot of 2340 Regional Hwy 2. A Chevrolet pick-up truck was parked near the Montana's restaurant when a male approached the vehicle and started an altercation. The pick-up truck attempted to leave the area; however, the pedestrian held onto the driver's door handle and subsequently fell.

As a result of the collision, the male pedestrian was transported to a local-area hospital and later to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

Single Vehicle Collision in Scugog

A 25-year-old male suffered serious life altering injuries

after a single vehicle collision in Scugog.

On Saturday, June 6, 2026 at approximately 8:30 p.m., members of North Division responded to a single vehicle collision in the area of Simcoe Street and Whitfield Road. A 25-year-old male was operating an off-road motorized vehicle on private property when they lost control and rolled over.

The driver sustained serious life altering injuries as a result of the collision and was transported by Air Ornge to a Toronto-area trauma, where they were they remain in stable condition.gation. AddInvis

Male Arrested Following Robbery Investigation in Orono

A male is facing charges following an investigation into a convenience store robbery in Orono.

On Monday, April 27, 2026, at approximately 12:40 p.m., members of East Division responded to an unknown trouble call at Mister Convenience located at 5351 Main Street. A male entered the business and picked up several bottles of liquor before attempting to leave without paying. The suspect assaulted an employee when confronted and fled the store on foot. A second employee followed the suspect and was also assaulted before the suspect fled the area in a waiting vehicle. Both victims suffered minor injuries.

The suspect was later identified by investigators and taken into custody, following a separate break-and-enter investigation.

Male Arrested for Identity Fraud in Whitby

A male is facing charges after attempting to fraudulently open a bank account in Whitby.

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, at approximately 4:00 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a fraud call at the CIBC located at 308 Taunton Road East. Bank staff contacted police after a male attended their location and attempted to open an account using fraudulent identification documents. Officers arrived on scene and took the suspect into custody without incident. A search of the suspect produced multiple banking cards not in his name.

At the time of his arrest, the accused was wanted by several other police services for similar offences. The accused was also already bound by conditions not to possess any banking documents or cards unless in his name.

Suspects Wanted After Vehicle Stolen in Clarington

Police are searching for at least two suspects after a vehicle was stolen from a business in Clarington.

On Friday, June 6, 2026, at approximately 10:10 p.m., members of East Division responded to a break-and-enter call at a business in the area of Courtice Road and Baseline Road West. Two males arrived to the business in a dark-coloured Ford pick-up truck. The two males broke onto the business property through the front gate and stole a parked black Audi sedan. Officers later located the Ford pick-up truck abandoned in the area of Shuttleworth Drive and Partner Drive.

Male Facing Drug Charges Following Traffic Stop in Oshawa

A male is facing drug trafficking charges following a traffic stop in Oshawa.

On Saturday, June 6, 2026, at approximately 12:20 a.m., members of East Division on proactive patrol initiated a traffic stop for excessive noise in the area of King Street and Eastlawn Street. Officers searched the vehicle after observing open liquor containers while speaking with the driver. As a result, over 48 grams of suspected cocaine was located and seized. The driver was taken into custody without incident.
