



Attempted Robbery at Jewelry Store in Oshawa Centre

A female youth is in custody and two males are wanted after an attempted robbery at a jewelry store in the Oshawa Centre.

On Saturday, November 29, 2025, at approximately 5:55 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery call at Bellagio Jewellers located in the Oshawa Centre at 419 King Street West. Three suspects entered the mall and approached the jewelry store while wearing masks and hoods. Security observed the suspects and immediately intervened forcing the suspects to flee. One of the suspects was apprehended by security before they could exit the mall, while the other two suspects fled the area in a small SUV.

No employees sustained any physical injuries.

A 15-year-old female from Toronto is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, Disguise with Intent, and Possess Weapon for Committing Offence.

Suspect Sought After New Condo Building Heavily Damaged

Police are searching for at least one suspect after emergency fire hoses were intentionally activated inside a newly built Courtice condominium, causing significant water damage.

On Monday, December 1, 2025, at approximately 12:35 a.m., members of East Division responded to an assist fire call at a condominium complex located at 1607 Regional Highway 2. Police were contacted after fire services discovered that the emergency fire hose water valves had been intentionally opened throughout the 92-unit building. As a result, the newly built complex was heavily flooded and damaged. The building was unoccupied.

A male suspect was observed fleeing the area prior to the arrival of police and fire services.

The suspect is described as: male, White, with a medium/heavy build, dressed in all black clothing.

Pedestrian Struck in Pickering

A 60-year-old male pedestrian is in critical condition after being struck by a vehicle in Pickering.

On Saturday, November 29, 2025, at approximately 10:40 a.m., members of West Division responded to a pedestrian involved collision in the area of Kingston Road

and Fairport Road. A 60-year-old male pedestrian was walking on the shoulder of the roadway when a white SUV left the roadway striking him. The 46-year-old male driver remained on scene and cooperated with police. The pedestrian was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre where he remains in critical condition.

Male Arrested After Incident Near High School

A 49-year-old male has been arrested after an incident near a high school in Clarington.

On Thursday, November 27, 2025, at approximately 11:50 a.m., members of East Division responded to reports of an armed person near a high school in the area of Brookhill Boulevard and Clarington Boulevard. The incident began as a road-rage incident off school property. The suspect followed the victim's vehicle to a parking lot near the high school.

The student's approached the suspect vehicle and observed what they believed to be a firearm inside. The male suspect proceeded to exit his vehicle and walk along school property before returning back to his vehicle and leaving the area.

The school was immediately placed on lockdown.

The male suspect was located a short time later and arrested without incident.

Further investigation revealed the alleged firearm was a BB gun.

Foluwa REWANE, age 49 of Oshawa is charged with: Possess Weapon Dangerous to Public Peace and Uttering Threats/Death or Bodily Harm.

Male Suspect Wanted in Oshawa

One suspect has been arrested and police are searching for a 31-year-old male after a stabbing in Oshawa.

On Monday, November 24, 2025, at approximately 3:20 p.m., members from Central East Division responded to Albert Street and Albany Street for an armed person call. Officers arrived on scene and located a female who had



been stabbed. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious, non-life-threatening injuries. Two suspects fled prior to police arrival.

Further investigation revealed the two suspects were linked to two previous stabbings in Oshawa that left two victims with minor injuries.

On Wednesday, November 26, 2025 police located and arrested one of the suspects without incident.

Investigators have identified the second suspect as 31-year old **Jose LOPEZ** of Oshawa. LOPEZ is described as: male, Hispanic, medium build, brown short hair and has a goatee.

If you see this male, do not approach and call 9-1-1 immediately.

Jose LOPEZ, age 31 of Oshawa is wanted for several offences including: Aggravated Assault x3; Assault with Weapon or Imitation Weapon x3; Possess Weapon for Committing an Offence x3; Fail to Comply with Probation Order x12; Disobey Lawful Order of the Court x6

Sharlie BLOXAM, age 30 of Oshawa is charged with several offences including: Assault x3; Assault with Weapon or Imitation Weapon; Possess Weapon for Committing an Offence; Uttering Threats / Death or Bodily Harm and Possession of a Prohibited Weapon

Suspect Sought After Shooting in Oshawa

Police are searching for at least one suspect after a residence was shot at in Oshawa.

On Monday, December 1, 2025, at approximately 3:45 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call at a resi-

dence in the area of Glen Street and Wentworth Street West. Officers arrived on scene and observed several shell casings outside of the residence. At least six shots were fired into the residence leaving bullet holes in the kitchen and living room. The home was occupied at the time of the shooting; however, no persons sustained any physical injuries.

Suspects Sought After Commercial Break-and-Enter in

Police are searching for several suspects after they broke into a photography equipment business in Oshawa.

On Wednesday, December 3, 2025, at approximately 3:00 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to a break-and-enter alarm at Henry's Photography located at 245 King Street West. Officers arrived on scene and observed the glass front door and multiple glass counters inside the business destroyed. All suspects fled the area prior to police arrival.

Armed Robbery at Convenience Store in Oshawa

On Friday, October 10, 2025, at approximately 8:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery at Circle K, located at 1051 Simcoe Street North. Two suspects entered the store and brought an item to the cash for purchase. While the female suspect paid, the male suspect pointed a firearm at the employee and ordered the employee to hand over cash. The suspects stole a quantity of cash and fled the area prior to police arrival.

Suspect one is described as: male, Black, slim build, approximately 6'ft", approximately 20-22 years of age. The suspect was wearing a

black balaclava, black Nike hoodie, black track pants and black shoes. The male suspect was also carrying a black satchel. A photo of the suspect is attached.

Suspect two is described as: female, White, slim build, approximately 5'ft", wearing a grey face covering, black hoodie and black pants.

Police are looking to identify a suspect following a stabbing in Oshawa

On Monday, November 24, 2025, at approximately 9:00 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to the area of Parkwood Court and Simcoe Street North. Upon arrival, officers located a male suffering from stab wounds. The victim advised he had approached a group of people during which time an altercation ensued and the victim was stabbed. The victim was transported to a Toronto area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

The incident initially took place in the area of Centre Street South and Debwewin Miikan in Oshawa.

The suspect is described as: male, White approximately 25 years old, wearing a hat and black jacket.

Nine Arrested After Gun and Drug Investigation

Six males and three females are facing numerous charges following a drug and gun investigation.

On Tuesday, November 18, 2025, members of the Gun & Gang and Drug Enforcement Units, with the assistance of Kawartha Lakes Police Service, concluded an investigation into nine suspects.

Multiple search warrants were executed at residences in Ajax, Oshawa, Toronto and Lindsay by the DRPS Tactical Support Unit, Toronto Police Emergency Task Force, and Peterborough Police Service's Tactical Support Unit. Officers seized more than 700 grams of cocaine, 300 grams of fentanyl, 100 grams of MDMA, 90 grams of crystal methamphetamine, as

well as approximately \$30,000 in Canadian currency. Five hand guns were also located and seized.

All suspects were taken into custody without incident.

Five Youth Arrested in Ajax

On Monday, November 24, 2025, at approximately 1:20 p.m., members of West Division responded to a suspicious person call at the Freedom Mobile located at 235 Bayly Street West. Employees contacted police after seeing five males wearing masks and gloves sitting in a parked vehicle in front of the business.

The suspects attempted to enter the business but were unsuccessful after employees locked the doors. Officers located the suspect vehicle behind the business and were able to block it, however, all five suspects fled on foot. After a brief foot pursuit, all suspects were taken into custody. The suspect vehicle was determined to be stolen.

A 16-year-old male from Mississauga is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Disguise with Intent.

A 15-year-old male from Toronto is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Disguise with Intent. He is currently on conditions stemming from previous robbery and weapons charges.

A 17-year-old male from Toronto is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Disguise with Intent. He is currently on conditions stemming from previous break-and-enter charges

A 17-year-old male from Brampton is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Disguise with Intent.

A 16-year-old male from North York is charged with: Robbery, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Disguise with Intent.
