## FOUR MALES IN CUSTODY AFTER ROBBERY IN OSHAWA

Four males are facing charges after a robbery at a cell phone store in Oshawa. On April 30, 2025, at approximately 12:30 p.m., members of East Division responded to a robbery in progress call at the Telus store, located at 1300 King Street East. An employee opened the door for a female believed to be a customer, and three males rushed into the store. The suspects assaulted the employee and forced him to the back of the business in an attempt to access the safe. No entry was gained, and the suspects fled the scene prior to police arrival. A fourth male suspect remained in a silver Honda CR-V parked nearby. The suspects fled to the waiting Honda and fled westbound on King Street. Shortly after the incident, the suspects were located by Peel Regional Police Service and taken into custody. The four suspects were transported to Durham where they were held for bail hearing in relation to the robbery. Investigation determined that the female posing as a customer was also involved in the robbery. She remains outstanding. She is described as: female, Black, 15-24 years of age, 5'5" with a slim build, black hair. She was wearing a white hooded sweater, black pants and white/black Nike sneakers. The employee did not sustain any physical injuries. The four suspects are facing charges as follows:

**Trejean OUELLETTE**, age 21, of Kitchener is charged with: Robbery/Assault With Intent To Steal and Disguise With Intent.

Toronto is charged with: Robbery/Assault With Intent To Steal and Driving While Under Suspension.

## SUSPECTS SOUGHT AFTER ROBBERY IN PICKERING

Police are looking for four suspects after a commercial robbery in Pickering. On Monday, April 28, 2025, at approximately 12:05 a.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call at Shoppers Drug Mart located at 560 Kingston Road. Three male suspects rushed into the store just as an employee was closing it for the night. The suspects used a hammer to break the perfume display cases and left with a quantity of perfume. The suspects fled to a waiting vehicle operated by a fourth suspect, and were gone upon police arrival. The victim suffered no physical injuries. The suspects are described as:

**Suspect #1:** male, White, 18-25 years of age. He was wearing a black mask, dark track suit with a hoodie and red running shoes.

**Suspect #2:** male, White, 18-25 years of age. He was wearing a black mask, black and grey jacket with hoodie, black pants and black shoes.

**Suspect #3:** male, White, 18-25 years of age. He was wearing a black and grey jacket with a hoodie, black pants and black shoes.

### MALE ARRESTED AFTER ARMED CARJACKING IN BOWMANVILLE

A 17-year-old male is in custody after an armed carjacking in Bowmanville. On Saturday, April 26, 2025, at approximately 4:45 a.m., members of East Division responded to an armed carjacking in the area of

the stolen vehicle. A short time later, officers from Central West Division located the vehicle traveling westbound on Highway 401. The suspects exited the highway at Westney Road in Ajax, where the vehicle left the roadway and struck a traffic light pole. Both suspects fled the scene on foot. After a brief foot pursuit, officers placed one of the suspects in custody. The second suspect remains outstanding and the investigation is ongoing. The victim did not sustain any physical injuries. A 17-year-old male from Ajax is charged with numerous offences including: Robbery Using A Restricted/Prohibited Firearm; Disguise with Intent; Possess Property Obtained By Crime Over \$5000.00 and Obstruct/ Resist Peace Officer.

### FEMALE SUFFERS LIFE-ALTERING INJURIES IN UXBRIDGE COLLISION

A 71-year-old female passenger suffered life-altering injuries after a collision in Uxbridge. On Tuesday April 29, 2025 at approximately 3:35 p.m. officers from North Division were dispatched to a two-vehicle collision on Davis Drive West of Uxbridge Concession 4. A Ford pickup operated by a 45-year-old male from Barrie was westbound on Davis Drive when he pulled out to

veered left off of the roadway, while the Dodge veered right off the roadway. The result was both vehicles hitting head on off of the roadway. A 71-year-old female passenger in the Dodge suffered serious life-altering injuries and had to be extricated from the vehicle. She was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre where she remains in stable condition. The driver of the Ford and driver of the Dodge both were transported to a local hospital with minor injuries.

### POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING AFTER AN ARMED ROBBERY AT A CANNABIS STORE IN OSHAWA

The suspect entered the store with a firearm and ordered an employee to hand over cash and cannabis products. The suspect stole a quantity of cash and fled the area prior to police arrival.

Police are appealing for witnesses following an arson at a Pickering residence. On Tuesday, April 22, 2025, at approximately 10:15 p.m., members of West Division responded to a fire in the area of Granby Court and Altona Road where a front door of a residence was fully engulfed in flames. The homeowner, who was not at home at the time, was able to alert the sole occupant at the time of the fire after observing it on their doorbell camera. Fire identified that an accelerant was used to start the fire. Further investigation revealed a suspect placing a flaming item in the middle of the front porch. The suspect fled the area prior to police arrival. No physical injuries were reported to police as a result of the arson.

### MALE ARRESTED FOR 72-YEAR-OLD MALE ARRESTED AFTER CHILD LURING INVESTIGATION

A 72-year-old male is facing charges following a child luring investigation. On Tuesday, April 8, 2025, members from the DRPS Internet Child Exploitation Unit (ICE) concluded an investigation concerning an adult male communicating with whom he believed was a 13-year-old girl. The male sent sexually explicit messages and images to the girl, asking her to send him photos. A Criminal Code search warrant was executed at two residences in Hamilton and the suspect was taken into custody without incident. The suspect communicated on "Chat IW" with the username: "JuniorJohnson". Police are concerned there may be other victims and are requesting anyone with information to come forward.

**James DAW**, age 72, of Hamilton is charged with: Luring a Person Under 16 to Facilitate the Offence of Sexual Assault; Luring a Person Under 16 to Facilitate the Offence of sexual Interference; Luring a Person Under 16 to Facilitate the Offence of Exposure; Luring a Person Under 18 to Facilitate the Offence of Making Child Pornography and Make Sexually Explicit Material Available to a Person Under 18 for the Purpose of Making Child Pornography.
