Youth Responsible for Oshawa Shooting Arrested in Bowmanville

A 17-year-old male responsible for shooting a 20-year-old male has been arrested in Bowmanville.

On Sunday, June 14, 2026, at approximately 3:00 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a shooting in the area of Ritson Road North and Pentland Street. Officers arrived on scene and located a male suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim was transported to a local area hospital in serious but non-life-threatening condition and has since been upgraded to stable.

Following an extensive investigation, on Thursday, July 30, 2026, members of the East Crime Team, with the assistance of the Offender Management Unit and Tactical Support Unit, located the suspect and took him into custody in Bowmanville.

At the time of the shooting the accused was on weapons prohibition conditions.

A 17-year-old male from Oshawa is charged with: Aggravated Assault, Assault with a Weapon, Discharge Firearm with Intent to Endanger Life, Possess Prohibited/Restricted Firearm – No Licence, Possession of Prohibited/Restricted Firearm, Careless Use of Firearm, Possess Weapon Dangerous, Carry Concealed Weapon, Point Firearm, and Fail to Comply with Undertaking.

Youth Arrested After Attempted Stabbing in Oshawa

A 13-year-old male is facing charges after attempting to stab another youth during an altercation in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, July 28, 2026, at approximately 7:50 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to an armed person call at the McDonalds restaurant located at 2585 Thoroughbred Street. Two youth were involved in an altercation when a 13-year-old male brandished a knife and attempted to stab a 16-year-old male before the victim was able to flee.

The suspect fled the area prior to police arrival. The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

The suspect was located at his residence where he was taken into custody without incident. Investigators later executed a search warrant at the suspect's residence and found the knife used in the incident.

A 13-year-old male from Oshawa is charged with: Assault with a Weapon, Assault, and Possess Weapon Dangerous.

Male Arrested in Stolen Vehicle with Drugs in Pickering

A male is facing stolen vehicle and drug charges following an investigation in Pickering.

On Wednesday, July 22, 2026, at approximately 4:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to an assist police call regarding a stolen vehicle in Pickering. At the same time, police received information that a white Genesis SUV was driving in a dangerous manner and at high speeds. Officers located the vehicle parked in the area of Liverpool Road and Kingston Road. The driver was observed exiting the vehicle and taken into custody without incident. A search of the suspect located a quantity of cocaine.

Further investigation revealed that the vehicle had previously been towed by 'East Side Towing' to what was believed to be the auto repair business 'AutoFix' in Georgina, Ontario. The vehicle was reported stolen after the owner attended the location for 'AutoFix' and discovered the business did not exist.

Nithoosan SELVAKUMAR, age 35 from Toronto is charged with: Dangerous Operation, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, Obstruct Peace Officer, Possession of Schedule I Substance (cocaine), Drive Motor Vehicle with Open Container of Liquor, and Drive Motor Vehicle While Suspended.

Male Arrested After Armed Robbery on Older Victim in Clarington

A male is facing charges after using scissors to rob a 79-year-old female in Clarington.

On Monday, July 13, 2026, at approximately 3:00 p.m., members of East Division responded to a robbery call at the Canadian Tire located at 2000 Green Street. A female was approached outside of the business by a male armed with a pair of scissors, who attempted to cut her handbag straps and flee. The victim attempted to stop the suspect from fleeing; however, the suspect made threats with the scissors. The suspect then stole the victim's car keys and attempted to flee in her vehicle but was stopped and restrained by members of the public. Officers arrived on scene a short time later and took the suspect into custody. The victim suffered minor injuries.

Robert Gerald ARSENAULT, age 27 from Clarington is charged with: Robbery, Assault with a Weapon, and Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000.



Male Arrested After Assaulting Two GO Transit Employees in Oshawa

A male is facing charges after assaulting two GO Transit employees in Oshawa.

On Thursday, July 9, 2026, at approximately 12:50 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to an assault call at the Oshawa GO Station located at 915 Bloor Street West. A male was directed by GO Transit personnel to leave the property. The male suspect refused and assaulted two GO Transit employees before fleeing the area.

Officers arrived on scene, and with the assistance of the K9 Unit and Air1, searched the area. A short time later, the suspect was located hiding in dense brush and tall grass by the K9 Unit, who took him into custody without incident. The victims suffered minor injuries.

Emmerson John FORRESTER, age 19 from Oshawa is charged with: Assault x2.

Male Arrested After Stunt Driving and Fleeing Police in Oshawa

A male is facing charges after stunt driving and fleeing police in Oshawa.

On Thursday, July 16, 2026, at approximately 8:05 a.m., members of the East Division Community Resource Unit initiated a traffic stop in the area of Coldstream Drive and Ritson Road after observing an Acura sedan operating in an unsafe manner. The suspect vehicle failed to stop and fled from police.

While fleeing from police, the suspect vehicle lost control and struck two unoccupied parked vehicles. The driver then attempted to flee the vehicle on foot, before being taken into custody by officers.

Israel BARNES, age 21 from Toronto is charged with: Dangerous Operation, Stunt Driving, Flight from Peace Officer, Disobey Stop Sign, Drive Vehicle – Improper Licence.

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Male Arrested After Making Threats with Knife in Oshawa

A male is facing charges after breaking into a vehicle and threatening the vehicle's owner in Oshawa.

On Sunday, July 19, 2026, at approximately 6:15 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Bruce Street and Court Street. The victim returned to his parked vehicle and found a male suspect inside. The victim confronted the suspect, who then threatened the victim with a knife before fleeing the area.

Officers arrived in the area a short time later and observed the suspect fleeing. Following a brief foot pursuit, the suspect made threats toward officers with the knife and a hammer. Officers deployed a Conducted Energy Weapon and were able to safely take the suspect into custody.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

Jonathan Joseph CYR, age 18 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Assault with a Weapon, Possess Weapon Dangerous, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000, Possess Break-in Instrument, Mischief Under \$5000, Obstruct Peace Officer, and Theft Under \$5000.

Serious Injuries After Collision in Whitby

Two suffer serious injuries following head-on collision in Whitby.

On Friday, July 17, 2026, at approximately 2:15 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a two-vehicle collision in the area of Lake Ridge Road and Highway 407. A Hyundai SUV was travelling southbound on Lake Ridge Road near Highway 407 while a Mitsubishi SUV was exiting the Highway 407 off-ramp. The Mitsubishi SUV appeared to enter the intersection, causing the Hyundai SUV to veer out of its lane, resulting in a head-on collision

with a Dodge minivan travelling northbound on Lake Ridge Road.

The 24-year-old driver of the Hyundai SUV suffered life-threatening injuries and was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre.

A 77-year-old passenger in the Dodge minivan suffered critical but non-life-threatening injuries and was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre.

The 69-year-old driver of the Dodge minivan suffered minor injuries and was transported to a local area hospital.

Description of Ajax Sexual Assault Suspect Updated

Police have updated the description of the Ajax sexual assault suspect following further investigation.

On Thursday, July 9, 2026, at approximately 8:30 a.m., the suspect approached a female in the area of Harwood Avenue North and Rossland Road. The suspect attempted to make conversation and shake her hand, before sexually assaulting her, and fleeing the area.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

The suspect is described as: male, Brown, approximately 5'4" tall, approximately 60-70 years-old, with a medium build, balding short grey hair, facial stubble, and gaps in his teeth. He was wearing a tan coloured shirt.

Suspect in Violent Whitby Sex Assault Arrested

Police have arrested the male responsible for a violent sexual assault in Whitby.

On Monday, July 13, 2026, at approximately 10:15 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a sexual assault at Iroquois Beach Park in the area of Gordon Street and Waterfront Trail. Police were contacted after receiving reports of a female who was sexually assaulted.

The victim was leaving Iroquois Beach Park, walking along the sand path that runs north-west toward Gordon Street, when she was assaulted by an unknown male. The suspect forced the victim off the path into a tree line where he made threats and sexually assaulted her.

Following an extensive investigation by members of the Special Victims Unit, with the assistance of tips from the public, the suspect was identified. On Thursday, July 16, 2026, investigators with the Special Victims Unit, with the assistance of the Offender Management Unit, located the suspect in Whitby and took him into custody without incident.

At the time of this incident, the accused was bound by house arrest curfew conditions.

age 33 from Ajax is charged with: Sexual Assault, Uttering Threats, Robbery, and Fail to Comply with Release Order x4.

Fatal Collision in Ajax

A 64-year-old female has died after being struck by a dump truck in Ajax.

On Saturday, July 11, 2026, at approximately 3:50 p.m., officers from West Division responded to a collision involving a dump truck and a pedestrian at Hunt Street and Harwood Avenue South. The dump truck was making a right turn from Harwood Avenue South to go west on Hunt Steet when it struck the pedestrian. Life saving measures were performed by emergency services personnel; however, the pedestrian succumbed to their injuries at the scene.

Fatal Collision in Pickering

A 68-year-old male has died after being struck by a vehicle in a Pickering parking lot.

On Saturday, July 11, 2026, at approximately 10:15 p.m., officers from West Division responded to a collision involving a motor vehicle and a pedestrian in the parking lot of 1105 Kingston Road. A black Ford SUV was driving through the parking lot when it struck a pedestrian. The pedestrian was trapped under the motor vehicle for a period of time. Responding police officers lifted the Ford SUV to extract the pedestrian and performed life-saving measures. Despite the efforts of emergency services personnel, the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries at the scene. The driver of the motor vehicle stayed on scene and is cooperating with police.

Male Arrested for \$45,000 Metal Theft in Ajax

A male is facing charges after being arrested for recycled metal theft valued at over \$45,000 in Ajax.

On Thursday, June 25, 2026, at approximately 9:15 p.m., members of West Division responded to an alarm call at AIM Recycling located at 140 Dowty Road. A male suspect was observed breaking into the business's scrap metal yard. Officers, with the assistance of the K9 Unit, Tactical Support Unit, and Drone Unit, searched the area and located the suspect, who was taken into custody without incident.

Further investigation revealed the suspect had committed multiple thefts from the business, stealing more than \$45,000 in metal.

Haron MOHAMMAD, age 35 from Pickering is charged with: Break-and-Enter, and Theft Over \$5000.
