AFTER
SEXUAL
ASSAULT IN
OSHAWA

Police are searching for a male suspect following a sexual assault in Oshawa. On Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at approximately 9:40 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a sexual assault call in the area of Adelaide Avenue and Thornton Road. The suspect knocked on the front door of a resident he is familiar with to ask if he could park his vehicle on their property. The suspect then asked the victim if he could use their washroom. Once the suspect entered the residence, he physically assaulted the victim before exposing himself. The victim was able to flee the residence and contact police. The suspect fled the area in a silver sedan prior to police arrival. **Daniel Robert WATSON**, age 50 from Clarington is wanted for: Assault, Assault by Choking, Sexual Assault with a Weapon, Forcible Confinement, and Unlawfully in Dwelling House.

WHITBY

An adult and two youth are in custody and three suspects are wanted after stealing a vehicle during an armed home invasion in Whitby. On Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at approximately 2:50 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a

home invasion call at a residence in the area of Applewood Crescent and Applewood Avenue. Six masked suspects broke into a residence and assaulted the homeowner with a firearm. The suspects demanded car keys and took several items from the home before stealing the victim's blue Ford Raptor Pick-up truck. The suspects fled the area in the stolen pick-up truck as well as a Jeep Grand Cherokee the suspects arrived in. The suspects also attempted to steal another vehicle from the victim's garage, but were unsuccessful. A short time later, officers located the suspect Jeep Grand Cherokee abandoned on Highway 407. Officers, with the assistance of the K9 Unit, searched the area and located three suspects, who were taken into custody without incident. Three suspects remain wanted. The Jeep was determined to have been stolen from the Toronto area prior to this incident. The Ford Raptor was recovered in Toronto.

2025, members of the DRPS Drug Enforcement Unit (DEU) and Provincial Repeat Offender Parole Enforcement Unit (ROPE) attended a residence in the area of Oxford Street and Dwight Avenue to arrest a male wanted on a Canada-wide warrant for parole violation. The suspect was located at the residence and taken into custody by the ROPE Unit without incident. As investigators sought a search warrant for the residence, a second male exited and attempted to flee while carrying a backpack. Following a physical confrontation with police the suspect was taken into custody. Located in the suspect's backpack was a firearm, loaded magazine, and several drugs.

Adrian GREEN, age 37 of No Fixed Address faces outstanding charges of: Assault, Uttering Threats, and Theft Under \$5000. He was returned to a correctional facility for his outstanding parole violations.

Lukas James SEMPLE, age 29 from Oshawa is charged with: Possession of a Firearm, Possess Firearm with Ammunition, Attempt to Disarm Peace Officer, Resist Arrest/Assault Peace Officer, Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine), and Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl).

THREE MALES
CHARGED
AFTER DRUG
TRAFFICKING

Three males are facing charges following a drug trafficking investigation. On Tuesday, October 28, 2025, members of the DRPS

Drug Enforcement Unit concluded an investigation which resulted in the arrest of three males and two Criminal Code search warrants being executed at residences in Ajax and Toronto. Officers seized more than 15 kilograms of cocaine, more than five kilograms of crystal methamphetamine, more than one kilogram of MDMA, a large quantity of fentanyl and prescription pills as well as approximately \$70,000 in Canadian currency.

Edward BRIONES HERRERA, age 35 of Mississauga is charged with: Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Cocaine) x2; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Fentanyl); Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (methamphetamine) x2 and Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (MDMA)

Devin WILSON, age 37 of Markham is charged with: Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Cocaine) x2; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Fentanyl); Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (methamphetamine) x2 and Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (MDMA)

Trevor BOGDANOW, age 53 of Ajax is charged with: Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Cocaine) x2; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Oxycodone) and Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking (Hydromorphone).

PEDESTRIAN
STRUCK IN
OSHAWA

An 81-year-old male suffered life-threatening injuries after being struck by a vehicle in Oshawa. On Sunday, November 2, 2025, at approximately 6:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a collision at the intersection of Simcoe Street South and Mill Street. An 81-year-old male pedestrian was crossing Simcoe Street South within the crosswalk when he was struck by a southbound Chevrolet SUV travelling through the crosswalk on a green light. The

pedestrian sustained life-threatening injuries and was transported to Toronto-area trauma centre. His condition has since been upgraded to stable.

The 53-year-old male driver of the SUV did not sustain any injuries and remained on scene with police.

PEDESTRIAN
STRUCK IN
AJAX

A 50-year-old pedestrian has died after being struck by a vehicle while attempting to cross an intersection in Ajax. On Friday, October 31, 2025 at approximately 6:38 p.m., officers from West Division responded to a report of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle on Taunton Road East near Warner Drive. A black Acura 4-door was eastbound on Taunton Road East at Warner Drive and struck a pedestrian as he attempted to cross the roadway east of the intersection and not at the crosswalk. The 50-year-old male pedestrian was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver of the Acura was uninjured and remained on scene where she co-operated with police.
