Five Arrested and Three Guns Seized in Pickering

Two adults and three youth are facing charges after three guns were seized during a robbery investigation. On Sunday, May 17, 2026, at approximately 12:40 a.m., members of West Division received information related to a robbery that had just occurred in Toronto. A male suspect pointed a firearm at a limo driver before stealing a passenger's backpack from the vehicle trunk. The passenger was not inside the limo at the time of the robbery. The suspect fled the area in a second limo that was later located by officers near Kingston Road and Liverpool Road in Pickering. Officers initiated a traffic stop on the limo and took seven occupants into custody. Three firearms with two prohibited over capacity magazines and a large quantity of cash was located. One of the firearms had an altered serial number, while another was confirmed stolen from the United States. Of the seven arrested, the limo driver and another occupant were released unconditionally. At the time of their arrests, four of the accused were already on weapons prohibition conditions. The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

Nicole Marie PROUT, age 47 from Toronto is charged with: Possess Firearm – No Licence x3, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Device x2, Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm x3, Possess Loaded Firearm x3, Tamper with Serial Number of Firearm, and Possess Firearm Obtained by Crime.

Elias MAHAMOUD-HILL, age 19 from Toronto is charged with: Possess Firearm – No Licence x3, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Device x2, Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm x3, Possess Loaded Firearm x3, Tamper with Serial Number of Firearm, Possess Firearm Obtained by Crime, and Breach Probation.

At the time of his arrest the accused was on weapons prohibition conditions. A 17-year-old male from Ajax is charged with: Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited

Firearm x3, Possess Restricted/Prohibited firearm x3, Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm x3, Knowingly Possesses Prohibited/Restricted Firearm x2, Tamper with Serial number of Firearm, Possess Firearm Obtained by Crime, Fail to Comply with Release Order x2, Fail to Comply with Probation Order, and Possession Contrary to Order.

At the time of his arrest the accused was on weapons prohibition and curfew conditions. A 14-year-old male from Toronto is charged with: Possess Firearm – No Licence x3, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Device x2, Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm x3, Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm x3, Possess Firearm with Altered Serial number, Possess Firearm Obtained by Crime, and Fail to Comply with Release Order x2.

At the time of his arrest the accused was on weapons prohibition and house arrest conditions. A 15-year-old male from Toronto is charged with: Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm x3, Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm x2, Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm x3, Possess Firearm Knowing Serial Number has been Altered, Possess Firearm Obtained by Crime, Fail to Comply with Release Order x3.

At the time of his arrest the accused was on weapons prohibition conditions. **Male Suffers Injuries After Dirt Bike Collision in Clarington**

Male in stable but serious condition following single dirt bike collision in Clarington. On Friday, May 15, 2026, at approximately 11:00 a.m., members of East Division responded to a single vehicle accident on the unmaintained section of Boundary Road near Enfield Road. The 73-year-old male rider was driving his dirt bike eastbound on the unmaintained portion of Boundary Road near Enfield Road when he lost control and struck a tree off the roadway/trail. He was transported to a Toronto-area trauma cen-

ter where he remains in serious but stable condition.

Serious Collision in Clarington

One male remains in life-threatening condition after a collision in Clarington. On Sunday May 17, 2026, at approximately 12:07 p.m. officers from East Division responded to a head-on motor vehicle collision involving two vehicles at Trulls Road, north of Prince Rupert Drive. A black GMC pick-up truck was driving southbound and a grey Chevrolet SUV was driving northbound on Trulls Road prior to colliding head-on. The 63-year-old male driver of the pick-up truck was transported to a local hospital where he remains in life-threatening condition. The 48-year-old male driver of the Chevrolet SUV and two passengers were transported to a local hospital where they have since been medically cleared.

Motorcycle and Vehicle Collide in Whitby

A motorcyclist sustained serious life-altering injuries following a collision in Whitby. On Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at approximately 12:10 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a collision in the area of Taunton Road East and Thicksen Road North. A Yamaha motorcycle was eastbound on Taunton Road East when it collided with a westbound Honda sedan turning left at the intersection. The 21-year-old male driver and two other occupants in the Honda sustained no injuries. The 24-year-old male motorcyclist was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre

Park Road North. A Nissan SUV and a Triumph motorcycle were stopped in the left through lane on Park Road North at the intersection of Park Road North and King Street West, when a Dodge Journey collided with both vehicles from behind. The Dodge continued along the roadway finally coming to a stop after colliding with the Harvey's restaurant at the north east corner of the intersection.

No pedestrians were injured. The 69-year-old male motorcyclist was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre in critical condition with life altering injuries. His condition has since been upgraded to stable.

The 45-year-old male driver of the Nissan and his 15 and 7-year-old passengers were transported to a local-area hospital with minor injuries. The driver of the Dodge did not sustain any injuries from the collision. He was arrested at the scene without incident.

Timothy Eugene WILSON, age 39 from Oshawa is charged with: Dangerous Operation Cause Bodily Harm, Drive While Under Suspension, and Breach Probation.

Male Arrested After Driving Stolen School Bus While Impaired in Ajax

A male is facing numerous charges following a collision in a stolen school bus while impaired in Ajax.

On Monday, May 11, 2026, at approximately 11:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to an impaired driving call in the area of Taunton Road West and Westney Road North. Police received reports of a shortened school bus driving erratically before attempting to pull into a McDonald's drive-thru and colliding with the drive-thru barrier. Officers arrived on scene and initiated a traffic stop, successfully stopping the vehicle. The driver exhibited signs of impairment and was taken into custody without incident. Further investigation revealed that the school bus had sustained exterior damage after the suspect unlawfully entered a bus yard in North York and stole the bus, possibly colliding with other parked unoccupied buses. In addition, the suspect stole radios and keys to other vehicles in the yard.

During the investigation, the suspect provided officers with a false name but was subsequently identified. **Tanner Jon DAVIS**, age 38 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Impaired Operation, Impaired Operation – Exceed, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000 x2, Obstruct Police, and Breach Probation x3.

Suspects Wanted After Home Invasion in Ajax

Police are searching for at least three suspects following a home invasion in Ajax. On Saturday, May 9, 2026, at approximately 2:35 a.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call at a residence in the area of Cranston Avenue and Carpendale Crescent. Three suspects brandishing firearms broke into a residence and stole electronics before assaulting the occupants and fleeing the area.



Shooting Outside of Ajax Restaurant

No injuries have been reported following a shooting outside of an Ajax restaurant. On Monday, May 18, 2026, at approximately 1:00 a.m., members of West Division responded to a shooting outside of the Cloud 9 Bar and Grill located at 368 Bayly Street West in Ajax. Police received several reports of gun shots being fired following a large physical altercation outside of the restaurant. Officers arrived on scene and
