



POLICE MAKE AN ARREST AFTER MULTIPLE SEXUAL ASSAULTS ON THE SAME DAY IN OSHAWA

A man is facing a number of charges after entering several homes and sexually assaulting multiple victims in Oshawa.

On November 11, at approximately 4:20 p.m., officers responded to calls for a man entering homes and exposing himself to residents in the area of Simcoe Street South and Royal Street.

The suspect entered a home and exposed himself to the residents before being startled by a dog and fleeing.

He then entered a second residence on the same street, where he sexually assaulted the homeowner when she confronted him.

The suspect fled to the Simcoe Street and Fairbanks Street area where he entered a third home, sexually assaulting an older female who was in bed.

He fled the third residence through the bedroom window.

Officers attended the area and located the suspect, who was taken into custody without incident, they think there may be further victims.

Mohamed Basil Lafir, 28 of no fixed address is charged with: Break-and-enter x3, Commit Indecent Act, Forcible Confinement, and Sexual Assault x2.

SUSPECTS WANTED AFTER JEWELRY STORE ROBBERY AT OSHAWA CENTRE

Two suspects are wanted after a jewelry store robbery at the Oshawa Centre.

On Tuesday, November 11,

2025, at approximately 8:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery call at the Paris Jewellers in the Oshawa Centre located at 419 King Street West. Two masked males entered the business and began smashing display cases. The suspects stole jewelry prior to fleeing the area in a vehicle. Further investigation revealed the vehicle was stolen.

MALE FACING CHARGES AFTER CHILD LURING

A 30-year-old male has been arrested after a child luring investigation.

In late May 2025, members of the DRPS Internet Child Exploitation Unit (ICE) began an investigation into an adult male communicating with a 12-year-old girl online. The male sent sexually explicit messages and shared sexually explicit material to the victim.

On November 11, 2025, members from the DRPS ICE Unit executed a Criminal Code Search Warrant at the suspect's residence in Bowmanville and arrested the suspect without incident.

Police are concerned there may be other victims and would like to speak with anyone with information. The male suspect operated under the username "sinister.illustrations." on TikTok and Instagram

IMPAIRED DRIVER ARRESTED AFTER COLLISION WITH POLICE CRUISER IN PICKERING

A male has been arrested for impaired operation of a vehicle after colliding with a police cruiser in Pickering.

On Wednesday, November 12, 2025, at approximately 3:05 a.m., members of West Division responded to a collision involving an Audi SUV and a police cruiser in the area of Kingston Road and the Whites Road westbound 401 Highway off ramp.

Two cruisers on the way to a call for service were making a left-hand turn onto Kingston Road from the Whites Road westbound 401 Highway off ramp when an Audi SUV travelling eastbound on Kingston Road failed to stop for a red light at the intersection. The Audi SUV slammed its brakes near missing the first police cruiser as it turned left. The Audi continued eastbound through the intersection at a high rate of speed, still against the red light, and t-boned the second police cruiser. The driver of the Audi exited his vehicle and attempted to flee the area on foot. Officers located the suspect driver a short distance away and took him into custody. The suspect was found to be operating the Audi with a G1 licence.

The involved officer was transported to local-area hospital with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

LOADED FIREARM AND DRUGS SEIZED IN BOWMANVILLE

Officers seized a loaded firearm and drugs following the execution of a search warrant in Bowmanville.

On Thursday, November 6, 2025, members of the DRPS East Crime Team concluded an investigation which resulted in a Criminal Code search warrant and a Controlled Drugs and Substances search warrant being executed at a residence in the area of Bowmanville Avenue and Hartwell Avenue. Officers seized a loaded handgun, a large quantity of cocaine and fentanyl, as well as cash.

Four individuals were at the residence and arrested without incident.

POLICE SEEKING INFORMATION AFTER DECEASED DOG LOCATED IN OSHAWA

Police are appealing for witnesses after a deceased dog was located in a suitcase in Oshawa.

On Friday, November 7, 2025, at approximately 9:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an animal abuse call in the area of Gibb Street and Grenfell Street. A passerby called the police after locating a small deceased dog in a suitcase near the green space.

Further investigation revealed a suspicious male was seen in the area at approximately 3:00 -3:30 p.m. carrying a suitcase. Police are looking to identify and speak with this male and are appealing to the public for information.

The suspect is described as male, White with a goatee and beard. He was wearing a bright orange construction style hat and jacket (with yellow reflective stripe) and jeans. He was carrying a grey suitcase and black metal trolley.

SUSPECTS WANTED AFTER TWO VEHICLES STOLEN

Police are looking for at least three suspects after two vehicles were stolen from the driveway of a residence in Oshawa.

On Friday, October 31, 2025, at approximately 6:40 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a stolen vehicle call at a residence in the area of Montrave Avenue and Pacific Avenue. Three

suspects entered three vehicles parked on the driveway of the residence. The suspects fled the area in two of the vehicles, a black 2023 Cadillac Escalade and a grey 2020 Chevrolet Corvette, prior to police arrival.

THREE ARRESTED AFTER ARMED HOME INVASION IN WHITBY

An adult and two youth are in custody and three suspects are wanted after stealing a vehicle during an armed home invasion in Whitby.

On Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at approximately 2:50 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a home invasion call at a residence in the area of Applewood Crescent and Applewood Avenue. Six masked suspects broke into a residence and assaulted the homeowner with a firearm. The suspects demanded car keys and took several items from the home before stealing the victim's blue Ford Raptor Pick-up truck. The suspects fled the area in the stolen pick-up truck as well as a Jeep Grand Cherokee the suspects arrived in. The suspects also attempted to steal another vehicle from the victim's garage, but were unsuccessful.

A short time later, officers located the suspect Jeep Grand Cherokee abandoned on Highway 407. Officers, with the assistance of the K9 Unit, searched the area and located three suspects, who were taken into custody without incident. Three suspects remain wanted. The Jeep was determined to have been stolen from the Toronto area prior to this incident. The Ford Raptor was recovered in Toronto.
