

Investing \$22.5 Million to Strengthen Health Care in Durham Region

DURHAM — The Ontario government is investing more than \$22.5 million to support healthcare services, hospital operations and critical infrastructure upgrades across Durham Region, helping ensure residents can continue to access high-quality care close to home. The investment includes \$19.58 million to support hospital operations at Lakeridge Health and Ontario Shores Centre for Mental Health Sciences, \$2.64 million for infrastructure upgrades and repairs at Lakeridge Health, and \$296,602 for infrastructure upgrades and repairs at Durham Community Health Centre and Lakeridge Health. In Durham Region, organizations receiving funding include:

- Lakeridge Health – \$19,097,571
- Ontario Shores Centre for Mental Health Sciences – \$3,203,300
- Durham Community Health Centre – \$217,279

The \$19.58 million operational investment is part of Ontario's broader \$1.1 billion investment in the hospital sector through Budget 2026, A Plan to Protect Ontario, representing a four per cent increase in annual support for the fourth consecutive year. This funding will support Lakeridge Health's core clinical services, including keeping its emergency department open, addressing inflationary and wage pressures, and reducing wait times for diagnostic imaging and surgical procedures, including MRI, CT, cardiac, stroke, neuroservices, orthopedics and

cataracts. The additional \$2.64 million through the Health Infrastructure Renewal Fund will support critical repairs and upgrades at Lakeridge Health, helping maintain safe, reliable facilities for patients, families and health-care professionals. A further \$296,602 through the Community Infrastructure Renewal Fund will support infrastructure upgrades and repairs at Durham Community Health Centre and Lakeridge Health. The fund helps community health-care providers address urgent infrastructure needs, including roofs, windows, security systems, fire alarms and emergency generators. "Hard-working families in Whitby and across Durham Region deserve confidence that they can access quality health care close to home," said Lorne Coe, MPP for Whitby, Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Children, Community and Social Services, and Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Colleges, Universities, Research Excellence and Security. "This investment will help strengthen the services residents rely on every day, reduce wait times and ensure our health-care facilities have the infrastructure they need to provide safe, high-quality care." "Our government remains fully committed to supporting our front-line health-care teams by making the necessary investments to reduce wait times, improve operations and advance crucial mental health services for all residents of

Durham Region," said the Hon. Todd McCarthy, MPP for Durham. "Our community relies on Lakeridge Health and Ontario Shores to deliver accessible and efficient care, and our record investments in Ontario will continue to ensure more individuals and families receive the support they need, when they need it." "Our government is making

historic investments to protect Ontario's health-care system, ensuring that more people in Durham Region can connect to the care they need, where and when they need it," said Sylvia Jones, Deputy Premier and Minister of Health. "These investments will enable health-care partners across Durham Region to address priority needs, strengthen

Over the next 10 years, the province is investing approximately \$64 billion in major health infrastructure, including more than 50 major hospital projects that will deliver approx-

imately 3,000 new hospital beds. Through Your Health: A Plan for Connected and Convenient Care, Ontario is expanding and modernizing hospitals and building new health-care facilities, making it faster and easier for people of all ages to connect to the high-quality care they need, where and when they need it.
