### Four Injured After Single Vehicle Collision in Whitby

Three occupants suffered serious injuries and one occupant suffered minor injuries following a single vehicle collision in Whitby. On Thursday, May 28, 2026, at approximately 5:30 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a single vehicle collision near Myrtle Road West and Duffs Road. A Toyota RAV4 was travelling eastbound on Myrtle Road when it lost control and went off the roadway, ejecting at least two occupants from the vehicle. An 18-year-old male and a 19-year-old male were transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious injuries. A 16-year-old female was airlifted to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious injuries. A 14-year-old male suffered minor injuries and was transported to a local-area hospital.

### Four Arrested Following Break-and-Enter Investigation in Ajax

Three males and one female are facing charges following a break-and-enter investigation in Ajax. On Friday, May 22, 2026, at approximately 8:55 a.m., members of the West Division Community Response Unit, with the assistance of front-line officers, were conducting proactive patrols in the area of Commercial Avenue and Hunt Street. Two persons were seen entering a secured sea can container. Officers checked the container and located four individuals inside, who were all taken into custody without incident. A search of the four suspects located break-in tools, cash, weapons, ammunition, and drugs, including: fentanyl, MDMA, and cocaine. **Robert-Lee GEORGE**, age 41 from Pickering is charged with: Possess Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl), Possess Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine), Possess Weapon Dangerous, Break-and-Enter, Possess Break-in Instruments, and Fail to Comply with Release Order. At the time of his arrest, the

accused was on weapons prohibition conditions.

**Jefferson Kempes MCQUILLAN**, age 47 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Break-and-Enter, Possess Break-in Instruments, Possess Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (MDMA), and Fail to Comply with Undertaking. At the time of his arrest, the accused was on weapons prohibition conditions.

### Suspects Wanted After Robbery in Ajax

Police are looking for two suspects after an elderly female was robbed in Ajax. On Sunday, May 17, 2026, at approximately 4:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call outside of a residence in the area of Old Harwood Avenue and Bray Drive. A 76-year-old female was outside of her home gardening when a vehicle being driven by a male suspect stopped in front of her residence. A female suspect exited the vehicle and assaulted the victim, stealing several gold bracelets and a necklace she was wearing, before throwing fake jewellery at the victim and fleeing the area. The victim suffered minor injuries.

### Male Suffers Injuries After Dirt Bike Collision in Clarington

Male in stable but serious condition following single dirt bike collision in Clarington. On Friday, May 15, 2026, at approximately 11:00 a.m., members of East Division responded to a single vehicle accident on the unmaintained section of Boundary Road near Enfield Road. The 73-year-old male rider was driving his dirt bike eastbound on the unmaintained portion of Boundary Road near Enfield Road when he lost control and struck a tree off the roadway/trail. He was transported to a Toronto-area trauma center where he remains in seri-

### Serious Collision in Clarington

One male remains in life-threatening condition after a collision in Clarington. On Sunday May 17, 2026, at approximately 12:07 p.m. officers from East Division responded to a head-on motor vehicle collision involving two vehicles at Trulls Road, north of Prince Rupert Drive. A black GMC pick-up truck was driving southbound and a grey Chevrolet SUV was driving northbound on Trulls Road prior to colliding head-on. The 63-year-old male driver of the pick-up truck was transported to a local hospital where he remains in life-threatening condition. The 48-year-old male driver of the Chevrolet SUV and two

patrons fleeing the area. No injuries have been reported to police at this time.

### Motorcycle and Vehicle Collide in Whitby

A motorcyclist sustained serious life-altering injuries following a collision in Whitby. On Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at approximately 12:10 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a collision in the area of Taunton Road East and Thickson Road North. A Yamaha motorcycle was eastbound on Taunton Road East when it collided with a westbound Honda sedan turning left at the intersection. The 21-year-old male driver and two other occupants in the Honda sustained no

injuries. A Nissan SUV and a Triumph motorcycle were stopped in the left through lane on Park Road North at the intersection of Park Road North and King Street West, when a Dodge Journey collided with both vehicles from behind. The Dodge continued along the roadway finally coming to a stop after colliding with the Harvey's restaurant at the north east corner of the intersection. No pedestrians were injured. The 69-year-old male motorcyclist was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre in critical condition with life altering injuries. His condition has since been upgraded to stable. The 45-year-old male driver of the Nissan and his 15 and 7-year-old passengers were transported to a local-area hospital with minor injuries. The driver of the Dodge did not sustain any injuries from the collision. He was arrested at the scene without incident.

**Timothy Eugene WILSON**, age 39 from Oshawa is

to a local-area hospital in life-threatening condition and later succumbed to his injuries.

### Male Arrested After Driving Stolen School Bus While Impaired in Ajax

A male is facing numerous charges following a collision in a stolen school bus while impaired in Ajax. On Monday, May 11, 2026, at approximately 11:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to an impaired driving call in the area of Taunton Road West and Westney Road North. Police received reports of a shortened school bus driving erratically before attempting to pull into a McDonald's drive-thru and colliding with the drive-thru barrier. Officers arrived on scene and initiated a traffic stop, successfully stopping the vehicle. The driver exhibited signs of impairment and was taken into custody without incident. Further investigation revealed that the school bus had sustained exterior damage after the suspect unlawfully entered a bus yard in North York and stole the bus, possibly colliding with other parked unoccupied busses. In addition, the suspect stole radios and keys to other vehicles in the yard. During the investigation, the suspect provided officers with a false name but was subsequently identified.

### Suspects Wanted After Home Invasion in Ajax

Police are searching for at least three suspects following a home invasion in Ajax. On Saturday, May 9, 2026, at approximately 2:35 a.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call at a residence in the area of Cranston Avenue and Carpendale Crescent. Three suspects brandishing firearms broke into a residence and stole electronics before assaulting the occupants and fleeing the area.
