



Male Arrested for Gift Card Tampering in Oshawa

A male is in custody after tampering with gift cards at a grocery store in Oshawa. On Tuesday, December 16, 2025, members of Central East Division responded to a fraud-in-progress at the Real Canadian Superstore located at 481 Gibb Street. Loss prevention officials contacted police after they observed a male taking tampered gift cards out of his pockets and placing them on shelves near legitimate gift cards. Police attended the area and took the suspect into custody without incident. A search of the suspect and his vehicle located a large quantity of tampered gift cards, including those for: the LCBO, Home Depot, Petro Canada, Canadian Tire, Roots, the Keg, Amazon, Mastercard, and Ultimate Dining. The value of tampered gift cards would have been over \$5000 if purchased by the public.

Roman TRYHUBETS, age 49 from Ukraine is charged with: Fraud Over \$5000, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, and Breach of Recognizance.

Firearm Located in Vehicle After Impaired Driving Arrest in Whitby

A firearm was located in a vehicle after the driver was arrested for impaired operation in Whitby. On Wednesday, December 17, 2025, at approximately 12:10 a.m., a member of the Festive RIDE team initiated a traffic stop in the area of Dundas Street and Brock Street. Officers took the driver into custody after observing signs of alcohol impairment. A subsequent search of the vehicle located a loaded handgun beside the driver's seat.

Five Arrested After \$2 Million Amazon Theft & Fraud Investigation in Ajax

Three males and two females are facing charges after a \$2 million Amazon theft and

fraud investigation in Ajax. In November 2025, members of the Financial Crimes Unit (FCU) began an investigation into two employees of the Amazon Fulfillment Centre located at 789 Salem Road. Investigators were contacted by Amazon Loss Prevention after it was alleged that two employees were responsible for the theft of approximately \$2 million in merchandise over a two-year period. On Monday, December 15, 2025, as a result of a collaborative investigation involving the Amazon Loss Prevention Team, investigators from the FCU took two employees into custody before executing a search warrant at a residence in Scarborough. Three additional suspects were located and taken into custody during the search warrant. As a result, police seized over \$250,000 in high-end electronics and \$50,000 in Canadian Currency.

Ashishkumar SAVANI, age 31 from Scarborough is charged with: Fraud Over \$5000, Theft Over \$5000, Trafficking in Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000, and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime for the Purpose of Trafficking Over \$5000.

Bansari SAVANI, age 28 from Scarborough is charged with: Possession of Property Obtained by Crime for the Purpose of Trafficking Over \$5000, and Possession of Proceeds of Crime Over \$5000.

Yash DHAMELIYA, age 29 from Scarborough is charged with: Possession of Property Obtained by Crime for the Purpose of Trafficking Over \$5000.

Janviben DHAMELIYA, age 28 from Scarborough is charged with: Possession of Property Obtained by Crime for the Purpose of Trafficking Over \$5000.

Male Arrested After Firing Gun Inside Oshawa Residence

A male is in custody after shooting a handgun inside a residence in Oshawa. On Tuesday, December 16, 2025, at approximately 7:00 p.m., members of East Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Beatrice Street East and Grandview Street North. Homeowners located a bullet after hearing a loud bang from within the residence. Further investigation revealed a visiting male had fired a handgun inside the residence before fleeing the area on foot. Officers identified the suspect and attended his residence,



where he was taken into custody without incident. Subsequently, a search warrant was executed at the suspect's residence which located two handguns, a rifle, and ammunition.

Liam MILLER, age 21 from Oshawa is charged with: Careless Use of Firearm, Possesses Restricted/Prohibited Firearm – No Licence, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm Knowingly Not Holding Licence, and Possession of Restricted/Prohibited Firearm.

guished the fire. An adult male was transported to a local area hospital where he remains with serious injuries. The Ontario Fire Marshal will be conducting an investigation. The premise has been deemed unsafe as a result an in-depth search has not yet been completed once the premise has been deemed safe a thorough search will be completed.

Male Arrested in Stolen Vehicle in Pickering

A male was arrested Tuesday morning in Pickering after being found in a stolen vehicle. On Tuesday, December 9, 2025, at approximately 4:45 a.m., members of West Division responded to the area of Arathorn Court and Melman Street after receiving reports of a stolen vehicle mapping in the area. Officers located the occupied vehicle, successfully blocked it in, and arrested the male driver without incident.

Male in Custody After Stabbing in Oshawa

One male has been arrested after a stabbing in Oshawa. On Friday, December 5, 2025, at approximately 1:10 a.m., members from Central East Division responded to a stabbing at a residence in the area of Olive Avenue and Albert Street. Officers arrived on scene and located one victim suffering from a stab wound. The victim was transported to a local area hospital with serious, non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect was arrested on scene without incident. Investigators believe this is an isolated incident.

Patrick LUMMISS, age 21 from Oshawa is charged with: Assault Cause Bodily Harm; Assault with a Weapon x2; Possess Weapon Dangerous to Public Peace; Fail to Comply with a Release Order; Fail to Comply with Probation Order.

Robbery at Convenience Store in Oshawa

One male and one female have been arrested after a robbery at a convenience store in Oshawa. On Tuesday, December 9, 2025, at approximately 6:10 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery at a convenience store in the area of Ritson Road North and Taunton Road East. The suspects entered the store and attempted to conceal merchandise. When confronted by an employee, the male suspect assaulted the employee, stole items, and fled the premises. The employee sustained minor injuries as a result. Police located the suspects a short distance away at which time they were placed in custody without incident.

Pablo RAMIREZ-AIZCORBE, age 19 of Ajax is charged with several offences included: Assault with a Weapon; Assault Cause Bodily Harm; Theft Under \$5000; Possession of Property Obtained by Crime; Possession of Scheduled I Substance. He was held for a bail hearing. A 16-year-old female from Oshawa has been charged with: Possession of Property Obtained by Crime.

Police continue to search for the suspect involved in the murder of 34-year-old Michael Ferdinand. Crimestoppers is now offering a \$25,000 reward for information leading to his arrest. On Monday, October 9, 2023, at approximately 5:05 a.m., members from West Division responded to reports of an armed person at the Pickering Casino Resort located at 888 Durham Live Avenue in Pickering. Police arrived on scene where they located the victim suffering from gunshot wounds. The victim was rushed to a Toronto-area trauma centre where he succumbed to his injuries. He was identified as 34-year-old **Michael FERDINAND**. Tyjae Nosworthy-Smith, age 20 is wanted on a Canada-wide warrant for Second Degree Murder. He is of no fixed address however he does have ties to the
