The 39-year-old male wanted after an assault at a residence in Whitby has been arrested. On Friday, August 29, 2025, members of Central West Division responded to a check call at a residence in the area of Annes Street and Jermyn Street. Officers attended and located an adult male suffering from serious injuries. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre. A warrant was issued for the male suspect. On Tuesday, October, 7, 2025 members of Central West Division arrested the wanted male suspect. **Tristan KALIJUNDIC**, age 39, of Whitby is charged with: Aggravated Assault

Four male youth and one adult male are in custody after an armed robbery at a jewelry store in the Oshawa Centre. Three of the suspects arrested were out on release orders from previous incidents. Of those three, two are young offenders. Those two young offenders are currently before the courts for previous robbery charges. On Wednesday, October 8, 2025, at approximately 10:55 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed robbery call at Paris Jewellers in the Oshawa Centre located at 419 King Street West. Four males entered the business and smashed display cases with

hammers and a pickaxe. The suspects stole jewelry before fleeing the area in a waiting SUV being driven by a fifth suspect. The vehicle was tracked along Highway 401 into Ajax, where the suspects abandoned the vehicle and fled on foot. Officers, with the assistance of the K9 Unit, searched the area and took all five suspects into custody. **Ahnaf SAMI**, age 19 from Toronto is charged with: Robbery, Disguise with Intent, Possession of Weapons Dangerous, and Possess Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000 x2. A male is in custody after an assault in Oshawa that left the victim in life-threatening condition. On Monday, October 6, 2025, at approximately 5:40 p.m., members from Central East Division responded to an assault in progress call in the area of Ritson Road North and Taunton Road East. Officers attended and located a male victim suffering from obvious signs of trauma. Witnesses provided information that the victim was crossing the street when the suspect approached him from behind and began assaulting him in what appeared to be an unprovoked attack. The victim and accused are not known to one another. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre and is currently in life-threatening condition. The male suspect was located nearby and arrested without incident. **Dwayne WALLEN**, age 33, of Oshawa is charged with: Aggravated Assault.

A 28-year-old male is facing a manslaughter charge in Durham's sixth homicide of 2025. On Saturday, October 4, 2025, at approximately 11:55 p.m., members from Central West Division responded to a

parking lot near Colborne Street East and Green Street in Whitby for a fight. Officers arrived on scene and located a male who had been assaulted. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre where he succumbed to his injuries. The male victim has been identified as 24-year-old Thomas Holm of Whitby. The suspect was located at his residence in Ajax and arrested without incident. **Austin HILL**, age 28 from Ajax is charged with: Manslaughter.

A 58-year-old male operating an electric scooter suffered serious injuries after a collision with a vehicle in Oshawa. On Sunday, October 5, 2025, at approximately 7:15 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a collision at Albert Street and Athol Street East. An electric scooter was travelling east on Athol Street when it collided with a vehicle making a right turn from Albert Street. The 58-year-old driver of the e-scooter was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre with life-threatening injuries where he remains in critical condition. Members of the DRPS - Collision Investigation Unit, attended the scene to conduct an investigation. Alcohol is believed to be a factor in this collision; however, it is still under investigation.

A youth and adult male are in custody after an armed street level robbery in Oshawa. On Monday, September 29, 2025, at approximately 7:20 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Albert Street and Fisher Street. A 19-year-old and 17-year-old male met with the victim to purchase a bb-gun. When the victim showed the suspects the bb-gun, the suspects made threats with a firearm and a large knife before stealing the bb-gun and fleeing. Officers searched the area and located both suspects, who were taken into custody without incident. Further investigation revealed the firearm used during the robbery to be an imitation weapon. The victim did not sustain any physical injuries. **Brandon SANDERS**, age 19 from Oshawa is charged with: Robbery, Pointing a Firearm, Use of a Firearm During the Commission of an Offence, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000, and Possess Weapon Dangerous to Public. A 17-year-old male from Whitby is charged with: Robbery, Disguise with Intent, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000, and Possess Weapon Dangerous to Public.

Police are searching for a suspect after a male was shot

in Oshawa. On Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at approximately 6:15 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call at a residence in the area of Oxford Street and Wentworth Street West. The victim was in his residence when the suspect entered and started a verbal altercation. The suspect shot a firearm toward the victim before fleeing the area. The victim was transported to local area hospital with minor injuries. At this time, police believe this to be an isolated incident. The suspect is described as: male, Black, approximately 20-21 years-old, 5'8" tall, with hair in short dreadlocks.

RESULTS IN 20
ARRESTS
TARGETING
RETAIL THEFT

Twenty people have been arrested following a four-day project targeting retail theft at a plaza in Oshawa. Five of the parties arrested were also charged with breaching court-imposed conditions. On Friday, September 26, 2025, the DRPS East Division Community Response Unit concluded a pro-active retail theft initiative after an increase in thefts from businesses in a plaza at Harmony Road North and Taunton Road East. The initiative, called 'Safe Shop' was implemented to help combat retail theft and provide outreach and education about theft prevention to businesses. In addition, DRPS provided targeted enforcement through proactive police patrols to arrest retail theft offenders. The initiative resulted in 20 arrests, 26 charges and five breach related charges. Of the 20 arrested, five accused were already on previous court-imposed conditions relating to previous theft charges, highlighting a concerning pattern of recidivism
