Supplementary Regulations

Announcement – The Bemrose Trials Club will be holding the above event on 25/4/26 which will be held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Trials Standing Regulations, any applicable Trials Championship Regulations together with these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued in accordance with TSR21

Eligibility – Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration Card or a SACU Licence. Riders from other federations must produce a licence and Start Permission confirming Insurance issued from their own FMN. No one event licences.

Status – National

The event will include use of the Public Highway

Entries Close on 17th April.

Entry Fee - £42 Entry is not complete until payment is made as instructed on the Entry Form.

ACU TRAIL BIKE LDT CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: (Classes 1,2 and 3 are eligible for the Derbyshire Dales Trophy)

Championship classes must have trials tyres to ACU TSR8. Trail Bikes meeting the ACU Definition are on the ACU website.

NON-CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: (Classes 8 & 9 eligible for the TRF Cup)

Easy Route classes are permitted to use Maxxis Trialsmaxx tyre.

6	Hard Route	Any bike not qualifying for championship classes but wishing to ride the Hard Route
7	Easy Route	Twin Shock and Pre 65
8	Easy Route	Rider Over 60 Trail and Enduro Bikes
9	Easy Route	Trail and Enduro Bikes
10	Easy Route	Guest Class. Default Class for incorrect class selected. No Awards

Riders on TRIALS BIKES may enter Class 6 (Hard Route). Class 7 if Twin Shock/Pre 65, or Class 10.

Start Time – 9.00am **Starting Order** - To be determined **Starting Intervals** – 2 per minute

Course – One lap of approx 60 miles with about 30 observed sections. **Time Allowance** – 7 hours

Fuel – Rider's responsibility. The course passes through the Start Area at half distance.
