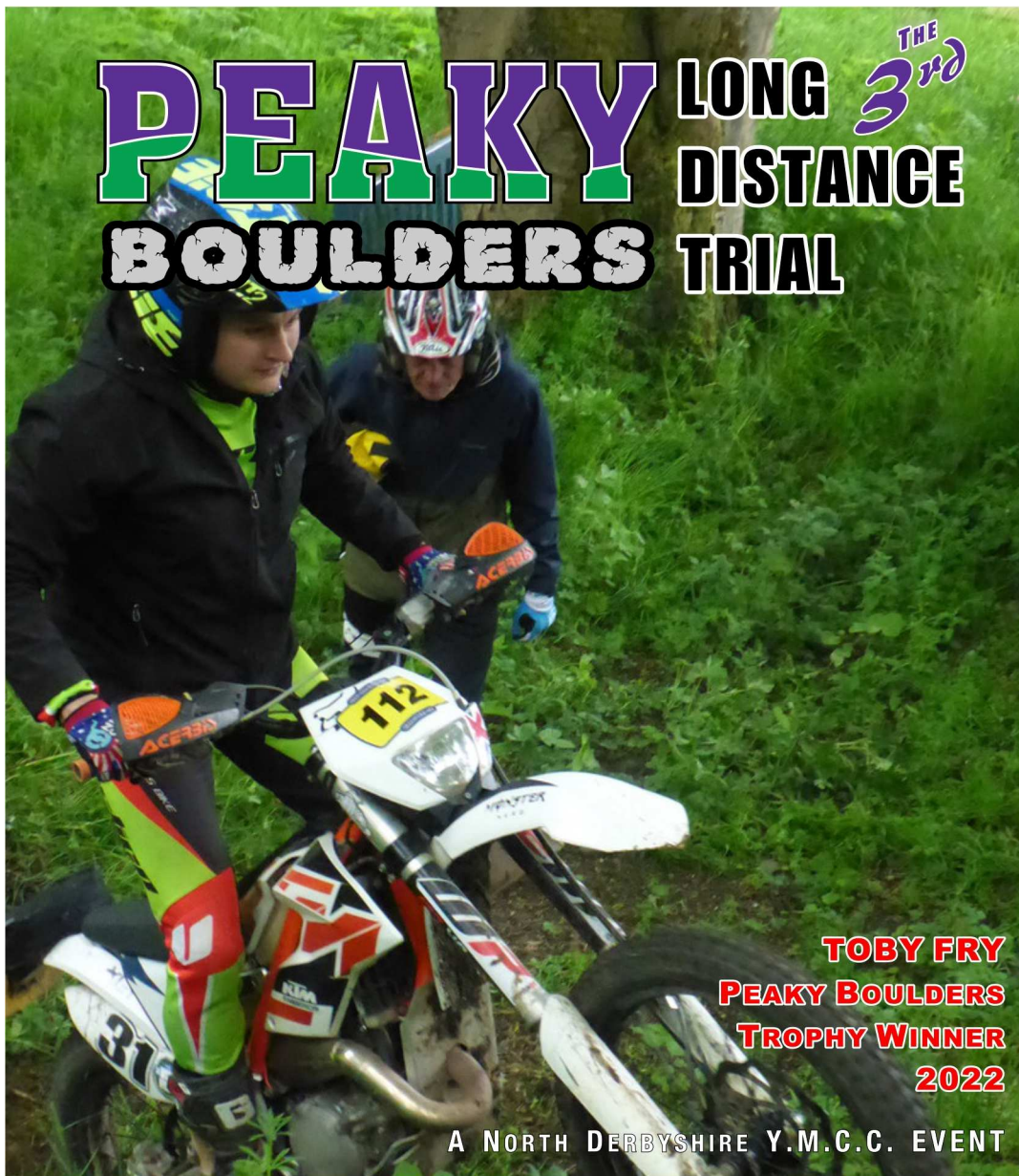

As always very big thanks go to all the landowners who have generously allowed us to use their land and of course to all the observers without whom the running of such an event would not be possible.

Our entry is smaller than in previous events and less than we really need to make the event viable. With that in mind we intend to move to a date later in the year for 2024, probably August bank holiday and possibly move back to the Buxton area. These times are only a guide and may vary depending on conditions and other factors. Observers in particular should aim to be at their sections well before these times, especially later in the trial.

DOGS NEED TO BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES

OTHER USERS This event is routed along or across public rights of way. Competitors must exercise caution and reduce their speed accordingly near other path users. Be especially careful near horses.

SLOW DOWN, STOP AND SWITCH OFF YOUR ENGINE, IF NECESSARY.

TYRES Riders doing the Hard Route MUST be fitted with APPROVED TRIALS TYRES compliant with ACU regulation TSR8 (Michelin, Dunlop, Pirelli, IRC). Riders doing the Easy Route can also use Maxxis Trailmaxx trials pattern tyres. **NO Motocross or Enduro tyres are allowed. You will not be allowed to start.**

NOTES – FLAGS, SECTIONS & OBSERVING

All riders must get their bike scrutineered at least one hour prior to their start time. Once scrutineered, sign on and collect your riding number stickers - one for the front of your bike and one for the back of your helmet

Marking will be as per ACU Standing Regulations for Trials. TSR 22 A Stop Allowed.

There will be NO on-road route marking, just the roadbook riders have been issued with. We may indicate the route at strategic points using small orange arrows, so look out for them.

All sections will be marked with red flags on the right and blue on the left.

On sections with hard and easy routes, the easy route will be marked with yellow flags on the left and white on the right otherwise follow the main red/right and blue/left route.

The section will start when your front wheel spindle passes the section Begins card and finishes when it passes the Ends card. Going outside the line of the flags will result in a 5.

REMINDERS

- ✓ Don't forget your route card - there's no route marking! Do not hang around! It's a long day - please think about our officials.
- ✓ The observer's decision is final. If you wish to discuss their decision, speak to the organisers at the end of the trial.
- ✓ All sections are on private land for which full permission has been obtained. Please do not return to them after the event.
- ✓ Wherever you are, whether on the roads, tracks or private land, be considerate to walkers, horse riders, cyclists and other users. We hope to run this event in future years and don't want to upset anyone!
- ✓ Don't forget your cash for fuel and refreshments.
- ✓ **Please support our caterers! They'll be on-site at the Start area for breakfast and later.**

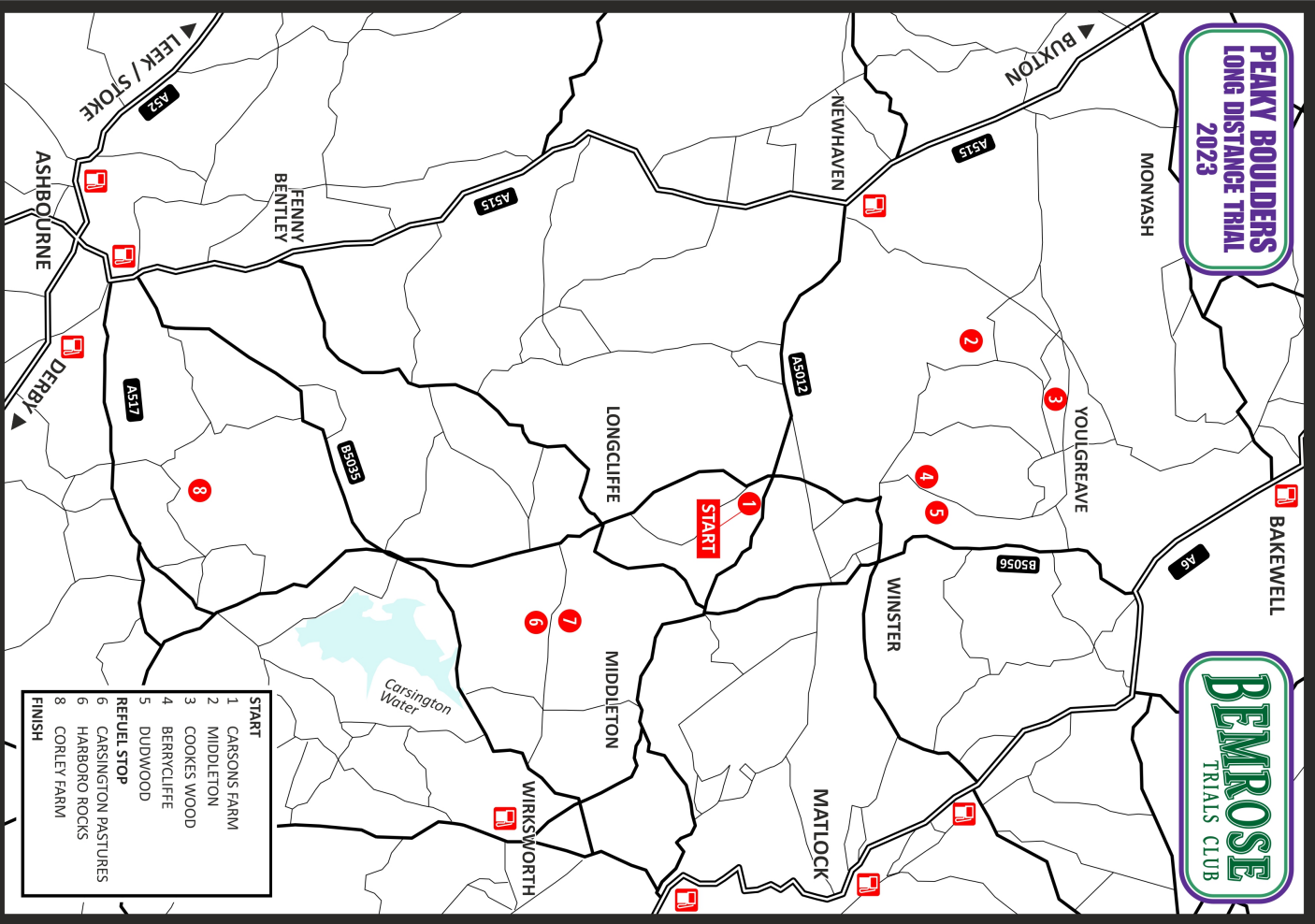
BEMROSE TRIALS CLUB
