## Governor's Report

So you are planning a vacation this summer and you are going to Moosehaven.



Not so fast! You are planning to fly. Do you have a "REAL ID?" Sure you have; you beat the crowd. You knew all along Congress passed the REAL ID Act in 2005. The Federal Government "set standards for the issuance of sources of identification, such as driver's licenses." You did all the right things: 1) Made an appointment at the DMV, 2) You went on line and filled out the application and received a code number, 3) The process begins at DMV, **REAL ID DRIVER LICENSE/ID CARD application fee: \$36 for Driver License.**

California REAL ID driver licenses and identification cards have a bear and star in the upper right corner. The new federal ID requirements begin October 1, 2020. You must visit a DMV field office. Bring original documents to prove your identity, Social Security number and California residency. Two documents are required. Photocopies of residency documents are accepted. Additional original or certified documents are also needed if you have changed your legal name. You can use a federal compliant REAL ID driver license or identification card to fly within the United States or enter a secure federal facility that requires identification.
