ELECTION FOR LODGE OFFICERS

Any member desiring to run for an elective office shall submit their name to the Nominating Committee at least one (1) week prior to the date the Nominating Committee is required to make its report at a regular/general membership meeting.

ELIGIBILITY

Only lodge members whose dues are paid and in good standing may be considered for elective office. To be an elected officer of a lodge, the officer must be a member of that lodge. The offices of Treasurer and Trustee only require that the member be in good standing at the time of the Nominating Committee report.

A member is not eligible for the office of President, Vice President or Chaplain unless their membership in the lodge in which they seek office equals or exceeds six (6) months preceding the date of the election.

CAMPAIGNING

The printing, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, tickets, other written or printed matters, or through any electronic media by a member or anyone acting on their behalf, suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of any proposed candidates for office, is strictly prohibited. Electronic media includes email, social networking sites, websites, blogs and text messages. Electronic media does not include the use of the telephone to call a member friend or member relative. For any violation of this section, the Chief Compliance Officer may suspend the membership of the offending member(s) and, declare the election of such officer(s) void and order a new election. Verbal campaigning is allowed.
