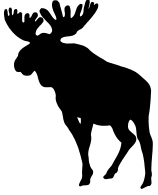

MONTROSE SEARCH AND RESCUE: SAVING LIVES & SERVING THE COMMUNITY

On Saturday, September 24th, the Glendale Moose Lodge #641, American Legion Post #288, and VFW Post #1614 had a booth at the 75th annual event held to raise funds for Montrose Search and Rescue. The funds are to be used for equipment and training.

“The Montrose Search and Rescue Team are dedicated volunteers from the local community. They come from all walks of life and bring their own unique skills and experiences to the team. All team members are Reserve Deputies, EMT’s and Mountain Rescue (MRA) certified. Additionally, some members have specialized training in underground and mine rescue. The men and women of the team are trained and ready to respond to virtually any wilderness emergency 24-hours-a-day. Every year, Montrose Search and Rescue volunteers respond to an average of 65-100 calls for help.”

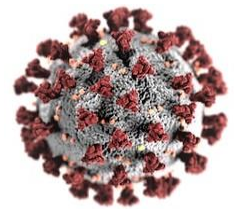

ARE YOU?

November, 2021: (COVID-19)

The New York Times reported that there were at least 770,000 deaths in the United States, more than 47 million cases in all of the 50 states.



August, 2022:

According to the USFDA, updated boosters include a component of the original strain to provide an immune response that is broadly protective against COVID-19 and a component in common between the Omicron variants (BA.4 and BA.5) to provide better protection against COVID-19 caused by the variant. These variants are currently causing most cases of COVID-19 and are predicted to spread this fall and winter. Dr. Robert M. Califf, FDA Commissioner said, "The COVID-19 vaccines, including boosters, continue to save countless lives and prevent the most serious outcomes (hospitalization and death) of COVID-19. As we head into fall and begin to spend more time indoors, we strongly encourage anyone who is eligible to consider receiving a booster dose with a bivalent COVID-19 vaccine to provide better protection against currently circulating variants." Those who have been recently infected with COVID-19 can wait three months before receiving the updated booster. Keck Medicine is now offering bivalent boosters at USC Medical Plaza Pharmacy, Monday - Friday, 9a.m. - 5p.m., and at USC Verdugo Hills Professional Pharmacy in Glendale. Walk-ins are accepted, or you can make an appointment. Pharmacies such as CVS, Walgreens and Rite Aid offer bivalent boosters.

Get Vaccinated

Lower your odds of getting COVID-19 or the flu.

Wear a Mask: when you cough or sneeze, anytime you have cold or flu-like symptoms, around sick people, inside public places, outdoors in big crowds.



Wash Your Hands: Some viruses can live on hard surfaces longer than others. Those germs can make you sick if they get inside your eyes, mouth, or nose.

Keep Your Distance: Viruses can spread through the air, and germs can linger longer indoors.

Keck Medicine: **It's time for your annual flu shot!**

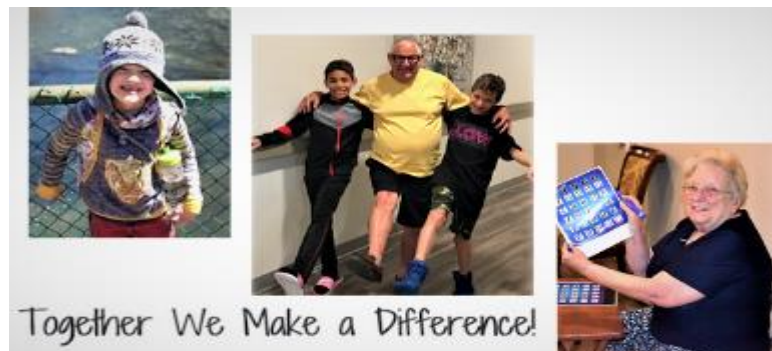
The Centers for Disease Control recommends everyone six months and older receive an annual flu vaccine, ideally by the end of October before flu season peaks. This year's flu vaccine covers the strains most likely to affect the United States. There are also three vaccines specifically recommended for individuals 65 and older.

- d. Use only secure websites. ***Make sure the web address begins with https:// vs. http://.***
- e. Make security your first stop.

FROM THE PRESIDENT

I returned from the 89th annual convention which was held at the Nugget Hotel in Sparks, Nevada with an abundance of pride in being a member of our Glendale Lodge and belonging to this great Moose fraternity. We have 27 lodges in our CA/NV Moose Association.

Last year our 27 lodges donated \$318,408 to be used in support of our kids at Mooseheart and our seniors residing at Moosehaven. This does not include any funds or volunteer services that these 27 lodges provide to their local communities. Some of the accomplishments that I would like to share with you are noted below:

1) The Women of the Moose (WOTM) donated 2 million dollars last year in support of Mooseheart and Moosehaven. The WOTM also provide Christmas gifts to our kids at Mooseheart, plus dental and beauty salon services to our women retirees at Moosehaven. The WOTM also provide hearing aids to our seniors as well.

2) We had 612 members who attended the convention and donated \$22,922 in support of Mooseheart and Moosehaven. Moosehaven has 278 residents whose average age is 82 and the oldest resident is 105. Of the 278 residents, 265 are very active and enjoying the life of contentment.

3) CA/NV Moose Association is 2nd in membership throughout the US. This past year we signed up 4,507 new members. Florida is still number one. Our 27 lodges raised over \$11,000 towards the Cradle Fund and \$13,000 towards the Rocker fund.

The toys will be distributed to the needy children throughout our community. It will be a fun night of dinner and live band music for dancing and listening.


