In California, diabetics make up 40% of the COVID deaths and disposable income is barely covering food, according to Assembly Member Adrin Nazarian. He is fighting in Sacramento to get AB2203 passed and signed into law. This bill would cap insulin copays at \$50 a month. The soaring price of insulin has disrupted millions of lives. Type 1 and some Type 2 diabetics need insulin to stay alive. This uncertain time during the COVID-19 is difficult for all of us. Assemblyman Nazarian said, "More than 13 states passed similar legislation into law."

Whether you shop online or in the stores that are open now, do take a moment to make your security list. Check it twice. Below are a few tips that can help you stay safe anytime:

- 1) Never put your personal ID, financial information or user IDs and passwords in emails.
- 2) Never send your debit/credit card numbers or social security numbers via email.
- 3) Think before you click:
.....Do not click on a link or open a file attachment unless you are sure that it is legitimate.
.....Links in emails can take you to fraudulent site4s that look identical to the legitimate site.
- 4) Use only secure websites:
.....When making purchases online, be sure the web address begins with "https://" vs "http://."
.....Most browsers will show a padlock icon.
- 5) Do not fill out forms in emails:
.....Especially those that ask for your personal information. Instead, go to the company's website directly and ensure you are using a secure server (see #4 above).
- 6) Check your accounts: debit/credit card and bank accounts and statements:
.....Many scammers count on consumer inattention to get away with fraudulent charges.
.....If you see anything suspicious, contact your financial institution immediately.
- 7) Make security your first stop:
.....Familiarize yourself with your computer or mobile device and how best to protect them.
.....Never leave your device unattended or unlocked.
- 8) Next: Be aware!
.....If you believe your email has been hacked or your credentials have been compromised,
.....you should put a hold on your accounts, cancel credit cards and notify the credit bureaus.

No matter the time of year, follow the best practices below:

Protect your online accounts and information.

Change your passwords on a regular basis.

Keep anti-virus software up to date. Scan and remove viruses frequently.

Never give your password to anyone.

Review your online accounts regularly.

Make sure the appropriate security and functional settings remain in place.

Revive your spirit and nurture your soul, spend a day in the park when it is allowed.

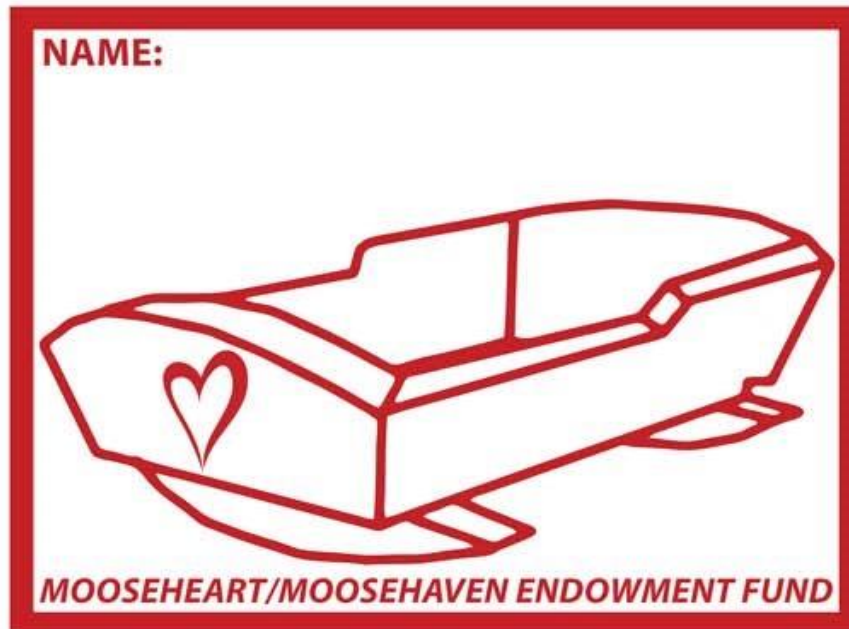
