MOOSE INTERNATIONAL, INC. ANNUAL CONVENTION REPORT

On July 1, 2021, I attended the Annual Moose International Convention in Cincinnati, Ohio. I have attended many conventions in the past, but this one was different. When our CEO, Scott Hart, gave his opening address on the evening of 7/1/21 the membership responded with so much vigor and enthusiasm to a degree I have never witnessed at past conventions. The highlight of his address was when he announced that our fraternity was doing very well. Our membership has grown considerably since last year to the count of slightly over 850,500 members. That evening there were over 2,000 members at the convention to hear him deliver his opening address.

We also heard from the Membership Director, Mike Rios, who stated to us that the fraternity has been averaging 18,000 new members per month. At this rate, our membership will exceed 1,000,000 (1 million) members by convention time next year. In our Glendale Lodge, our membership has grown by 13 new members in the past three months. Now that we are a “One Moose” fraternity, we have seen women sign up as new members of our Lodge, more so than men. Ladies, you are putting the men to shame when it comes to new members – keep it going. Hopefully, these new members will sign up more individuals to become Glendale Moose members.

From September 16-19, 2021 I will be attending the CA/NV Moose Association Convention in Sparks, NV. I am looking forward to hearing how our membership has grown since July of this year.


