

EAGLE SCOUT PROJECT IS A "GO!"


Emelia Lagousis, daughter of members Ted and Kendra Lagousis and granddaughter of Administrator Don Thompson, is spearheading a project which will not only help her earn the rank of Eagle Scout, but will also benefit the Verdugo Hills Memorial Hall. The project will install two needed handrails; one along the 50' ramp leading to the south door of the building, and another along the steps on the other side of the door. These handrails will provide much needed safety measures for members entering the Lodge building from both the street and the parking lot.

Emelia made her presentation to the Officers of American Legion Post #288 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #1614, owners of the VHMH, at their monthly pancake breakfast in August, which became a fundraiser for the project. The money raised will help pay for the railing materials and paint. Installation will be under the supervision of Moose members Chuck Hughes, First-Year-Trustee, and Darren Azarian, 3rd-Year-Trustee. Project completion is scheduled for the end of September.
