Risk Involved: Wrong selection of a career path, Career dissatisfaction, and Self interest mismatch.





 - c.Discuss questions/problems in a group or with a study-buddy










- Advises patients and community concerning diet, activity, hygiene, and disease prevention.
- Plans, implements, or administers health programs or standards in hospital, business, or community for information, prevention, or treatment of injury or illness.
- Directs and coordinates activities of nurses, students, assistants, specialists, therapists, and other medical staff.
- Prepares reports for government or management of birth, death, and disease statistics, workforce evaluations, or medical status of individuals.
