

Student Relationships Contract

Dating and Student Relationships

While we believe that dating and relationship boundaries between students are a matter for parents/guardians to establish, Outlook Christian School does have student conduct standards that deal with all school-related activities and events.

- 1. Public displays of affection, such as intimate hugging, kissing, and cuddling, are not acceptable behaviors at school or school events.
- 2. Do not talk or bring to the attention of other students what you do outside the school with your boyfriend-girlfriend. This is something that needs to remain outside this school as it can cause gossip and unnecessary drama.
- 3. OCS students are not permitted to have a "boyfriend-girlfriend" relationship with other students.
- 4. High School students may not "invite" middle school students to events that are specific to high school, as well as middle school students inviting high school students to middle school-specific events.
- 5. High School and Middle School students are to treat elementary students with respect; they are not to be "handled" as a younger sibling. Picking up, swinging, wrestling, and other physical engagements are not permitted.

Violation of this agreement will result in parental contact, parental conference, and/or disciplinary action, including expulsion.
