The Southern Association of Basketball Officials (SABO) Annual Referee Camp is being held in conjunction with the Jacksonville University's Boys Varsity Team Camp. Top- High School and College officials will evaluate campers on NFHS approved 3-person mechanics. Campers will receive written evaluations as well as receive video breakdown of their game performance. During classroom instruction, campers will review play situations in addition to receiving classroom instruction to boost in-game performance and increase awareness. Campers should expect to work at least three game assignments.

At the SABO Basketball Officials Camp, we focus on teaching three (3) person NFHS Mechanics, Structure, Positioning and combining them with officiating guidelines and principles to ensure all attendees leave better equipped to work 3-person games. Our focus on proper high school mechanics and guidelines will help prepare you for the next level of high school games.

ON SITE ACCESS TO VIDEO BREAKDOWN

Watch your game video with Staff members to learn how to evaluate positioning, call selection, consistency, teamwork and focus. This provides a great opportunity to take what has happened on the court and take it straight to the video so what is being taught is easier to understand while the information is fresh.
