Proposed Amendment to SABO's Constitution

ARTICLE X: ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Current

- D. The procedure shall be:
- ...3. If any candidate for a specific office fails to receive a simple majority of all votes cast on the first ballot, there shall be a runoff balloting for that particular office, with the candidates receiving the highest number and second highest number of votes being subject to election in the second ballot. The voting then shall continue until one candidate receives a simple majority of all votes cast.

Proposed Change

- D. The procedure shall be:
- ...3. If any candidate for a specific office fails to receive a majority of all votes cast on the first ballot, there shall be a runoff balloting for that particular office between the candidates receiving the highest number and second highest number of votes. The voting then shall continue until one candidate receives a simple majority of all votes cast.

(If adopted, this amendment will take effect retroactively July 1, 2024)

<u>Definitions</u>

MAJORITY - more than half of a total. It is a subset of a set consisting of more than half of the set's elements. For example, if a group consists of 31 individuals, a majority would be 16 or more.

ABSOLUTE MAJORITY - a majority over all rivals combined; more than half.

SIMPLE MAJORITY - a majority in which the highest number of votes cast for any one candidate, issue, or item exceeds the second-highest number, while not constituting an absolute majority.

PLURALITY - (or relative majority) describes the circumstance when a party, candidate, or proposition polls more votes than any other but does not receive more than half of all votes cast.

Proposed Amendment to SABO's Constitution

ARTICLE VII: DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Current

- C. The duties of the Secretary shall be:
- ...6. Perform such other duties as are set forth, or shall be set forth, elsewhere in this Constitution.

Proposed Change

- C. The duties of the Secretary shall be:
- ...6. Create correspondence at the direction of the President, Treasurer, Commissioner or Assistant Commissioner for the collection of fees, dues and any other monetary funds due SABO.
 - 7. Perform such other duties as are set forth, or shall be set forth, elsewhere in this Constitution.

ARTICLE XII: Dues and Compensation

Current

- C. Compensation for the Commissioner will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be equal to all booking fees collected for games assigned by the Commissioner...
- D. Compensation for the Assistant Commissioner will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be \$2,000.00 for the season.
- E. Compensation for the Treasurer will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be \$2,000.00 for the season, plus all Administrative Fees (not to exceed \$1500) associated with the performance of his/her duties.

Proposed Change

- C. Compensation for the Commissioner will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be equal to 90% of all booking, fines & schedule change fees collected for games assigned by the Commissioner...
- D. Compensation for the Assistant Commissioner will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be equal to 90% of all booking, fines & schedule change fees collected for games assigned by the Assistant Commissioner for the season (\$2500 minimum in the absence of sufficient fees collected).
- E. Compensation for the Treasurer will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be 90% of all Administrative/Rebate Fees collected for the season (\$2500 minimum in the absence of sufficient administrative/rebate fees).
- F. Compensation for the Secretary will be paid out of the SABO treasury and shall be \$1200 for the season.

(If adopted, these two amendments will take effect retroactively July 1, 2024)

Proposed Amendment to SABO's Constitution

ARTICLE XII: DUES AND COMPENSATION

Current

- A. Prospective members will pay dues as follows:
- 1. All first-time members of SABO will pay \$45 as annual dues.
- 2. All returning/active SABO members will pay \$55 as annual dues.

Proposed Change

- A. Prospective members will pay dues as follows:
- 1. All first-time members of SABO will pay the equivalent of one junior varsity game fee as annual dues.
- 2. All returning members of SABO will pay the equivalent of one regular season varsity game fee as annual dues.
