
Geography

At Woodend Farm school our Geography lessons aim to inspire pupils to become curious and explorative thinkers with a diverse knowledge of the world around them. We want our pupils to develop the confidence to question and observe places, measure and record necessary data in various ways, and analyse and present their findings.

Our units of learning encourage:

- A strong focus on developing both geographical skills and knowledge.
- Critical thinking, with the ability to ask perceptive questions and explain evidence.
- The development of fieldwork skills.
- An interest and knowledge of pupils' locality and how it differs from other areas of the world.
- A growing understanding of geographical concepts, terms and vocabulary.



For pupils accessing learning at a pre-key stage one level we have developed lessons that focus on the foundation of geographical skills, knowledge and enquiry.
