

# Expressive Arts

At Woodend Farm school our Expressive Art lessons aim to inspire pupils and develop their confidence to experiment and invent their own works of art. The lessons are designed to give pupils every opportunity to develop their ability, nurture their talent and interests, express their ideas and thoughts about the world, as well as learning about art and artists across cultures and through history. Our curriculum supports pupils to meet the National curriculum attainment targets.

Over a series of lessons pupils will be:

- Generating ideas
- Using sketchbooks
- Making skills, including formal elements (line, shape, tone, texture, pattern, colour)
- Widening their knowledge of artists
- Evaluating and analysing

Our lesson plans are sequential, allowing children to build their skills and knowledge, applying them to a range of outcomes. Key skills are revisited again and again with increasing complexity. This allows pupils to revise and build on their previous learning. The pupils' learning will incorporate drawing, painting and mixed-media, sculpture and 3D art and craft and design.
