

Langshire HOA Crime Prevention Recommendations

If there is an emergency, please dial <u>911</u>. For all other non-emergency issues, please dial <u>239-477-1000</u>. (Lee County Sheriff's Office)

- Always lock car doors and do not leave valuables in your car or in site while your car is parked.
- Lock your front door (with a dead bolt), lanai door, windows and close your garage door at all times.
- Always turn on your alarm system (if you have one) when leaving your home or at night when you are home.
- Keep your outside garage door lights on during night tome hours. Light sensitive devices are available at home building stores.
- If you have a trusted neighbor, let them know when you are leaving for an extended time. You can also fill out an Online Vacation House Check Request with the Lee County Sheriffs Office.

- Leave a light and/or a radio on in your home when leaving during evening hours.
- Install safety locks on your lanai door or wedge shut with a board in the track behind the moving section.
