The Student Athlete Foundation launched in 2024 and since its inception has raised over \$51,000 for deserving student athletes. This incredible accomplishment was due to the generous donations and support from our fundraisers throughout the school year, including the Fall Tailgate, Spring Cornhole Tournament, Superbowl boxes, and March Madness tournament. While \$51,000 was raised through the end of the 2025 school year, The Student Athlete Foundation began the process of awarding the first scholarships in March 2025 (with \$30,000 raised) and awarded over \$29,000 in scholarships to 8 deserving students for the 2024-2025 school year. The remaining funds will be rolled to the following school year for hosting events and 2025-2026 scholarships.
