ORDER

Appellants Pepper Black and S. Brad Dozier have moved for an additional ten minutes of oral argument for both the State of Tennessee and Appellants on the grounds the State wishes to have additional time to argue the constitutional question. The State has responded that it no longer desires additional time for oral argument. Appellee Theresa Baldwin opposes the motion for additional time. Upon due consideration, we find no grounds to grant additional time for oral argument.
