

## BIRREGURRA - LORNE - TORQUAY:

Meeting time will be 1:30pm at the “Rotary Motor Show Flag” in front of the Mechanics Hall, corner Main and Strachan Streets Birregurra. Public toilets are located in the park opposite and behind the Hall. You may like to arrive earlier to give yourself the chance to grab some lunch or a coffee and snack in Birregurra.



1. On arrival in Birregurra, parking is available on Main Street, the service road as well as side streets. Enjoy a stroll and grab some food if you have time.
2. 1:30 pm meet at the “Rotary Motor Show Flag”.
3. You will be given basic instructions and a report on road conditions. We will have some printed versions of the instructions for those who require them, but it would be worthwhile printing this page or refer to it on your phone.
4. 1:45 pm depart Birregurra. Head south-east on Main Street (C152), becomes Birregurra-Deans Marsh Road **14.2 km**
5. Turn right onto Deans Marsh-Lorne Road (C151) **22.5 km**. This is a lovely yet very winding road so please drive carefully.
6. At the roundabout in Lorne you can choose to
  - a. turn right into Lorne and have “tourist break” but keep in mind it does get very busy along the main street. OR
  - b. turn left and continue on the journey along the Great Ocean Road (B100). If you need a break, a short distance along the GOR to Hall Street there is a nice parking spot on the beach side also with toilets/water.
7. Continue to stay on the B100 heading towards Torquay **39.8 km**
8. At the roundabout in Bellbrae take the second exit and stay on the Great Ocean Road (B100) **4.9 km**
9. After entering Torquay continue past the RACV Resort, cross over Spring Creek,
10. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Bell Street **700 m**
11. At the second roundabout, take the 1st exit onto The Esplanade
12. Continue along The Esplanade, turn right into the carpark for “Elephant Walk” which is opposite Zeally Bay Road **850 m**. This is the same park where the Torquay Motor Show is held.
13. You have arrived at the final destination. You are welcome to stay and relax or wander and enjoy this section of the Surfcoast.
14. Hopefully you enjoyed the drive, scenery and some culinary delights along the way. We look forward to seeing you at the Motor Show on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> February as well.
