Terms and Conditions

- i. The project duration from 15 June to 25 August 2022.
- ii. The programme is open only to schools from all over India.
- iii. Any school where students are allowed to explore the wild outdoors alongwith teachers/parents can apply.
- iv. Selected schools will be oriented for the project work through physical or virtual medium
- v. The project coordinators will provide resources such as datasheets and protocol. This comes absolutely free to the schools.
- vi. The school could select any three classes preferably from 6,7,8 standards to work on the project work alongwith their teachers. We would need 10 students from each class/division who could work in pairs.
- vii. Students are expected to spend a minimum time of one hour in looking for caterpillars outdoors (within the school vicinity or permissible areas in and around schools or around their respective homes and city gardens). This needs to be done once a week, till they find a caterpillar. They should be always accompanied by an adult.
- viii. Each pair will rear minimum two caterpillars of same species. Not more than two caterpillars should be collected by any student from the same plant.
- ix. Students are expected to feed in their data on weekly basis on to the datasheets and monthly data on to the project portal site.
- x. The school will also nominate one teacher co-ordinator for each class who will ensure the students are collecting data and feeding it to the project website.
- xi. The school should ensure none of the caterpillars are harmed in any manner and all care will be taken while rearing them
- xii. There will be one winner school from each zone (North, South, East and West). Schools with highest records of rearing maximum species of caterpillars will be declared as a winner.
- xiii. The winning school will receive Field Guide to Indian Moths as prize for their school library. All participating students, teachers and schools will receive participating certificates.
