RESOLUTION NO. 2020-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY MAYORS ASSOCIATION IN SUPPORT OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED 2020 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Mayors Association is a nonprofit organization whose membership is comprised of the mayors of all thirty-six (36) municipalities located in Jefferson County, Alabama;

WHEREAS, Section 11-46-21, <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975), as amended, provides that regular municipal elections for public office in Alabama cities and towns shall be held on the fourth (4th) Tuesday in August 1984 and quadrennially thereafter; and, runoff elections, if required, shall be held on the sixth Tuesday next thereafter following said regular election;

WHEREAS, the novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) has been detected in Alabama, and the State Board of Health has designated COVID-19 to be a disease of epidemic potential, a threat to the health and welfare of the public, or otherwise of public health importance;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, on the recommendation of the State Health Officer, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, declared a State public health emergency exists in the State of Alabama; and, on April 3, 2020, the State Health Officer, on behalf of the State Board of Health issued a Statewide Stay at Home Order (the "Stay at Home Order");

WHEREAS, the right to vote in municipal elections once every four (4) years for candidates for municipal public office is one of the most fundamental rights of Alabama citizens;

WHEREAS, elected municipal public officers serve four (4) year terms, and the municipal electorate has a right to expect subsequent elections for the offices held by those elected officials to occur on the election date established by law at time the electorate voted them into office;

WHEREAS, the mayor-members of the Association place the health, safety and welfare of their citizenry first among their many responsibilities of public municipal office; and

WHEREAS, the Association is consulting with Jefferson County health officials on measures to protect voters from unnecessary risks associated with COVID-19 when visiting municipal polling places so that voters may continue to exercise their right to vote without undue disruption.

NOW THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the mayor-members of the Association, while in a [regular/special] meeting on the 15 day of $\frac{15}{15}$ day of $\frac{15}{15}$, 2020, at [], local time, that the Association strongly supports holding 2020 municipal elections without interruption, abeyance or delay; provided, however, that the elections can be held safely in accordance with guidance from public health officials for avoiding undue risk to the public health associated with COVID-19.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
