Regional – Caribbean – Transport

Improve maritime connectivity in the Caribbean to foster regional integration, economic growth and food security.

Jamaica

- Support the development of the green bond market
- Targeted investment to position Jamaica as a global logistics hub
- Improvement of solid waste management in the Harbour area and urban renewal
- Inclusive access to digital technologies in education and MSMEs
- Island-wide broadband access

Cuba

- Support to the Biotechnology industry to meet international standards and increase production scale
- New Wind and Photovoltaic power plants to increase the share of renewables in electricity generation

Regional – Caribbean – Climate & Energy / Education & Research

Turn Sargassum algae from a threat to an economic opportunity (e.g. biofuel, water purification, agriculture).

Antigua and Barbuda, Dominica, Grenada, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

- Investments in solar, wind, geothermal and green hydrogen technology
- Reduce chronic water shortages and improve wastewater systems
- Climate Finance: mitigating or adapting to the impacts of climate change
- Supporting Caribbean biodiversity and fighting ocean pollution

Suriname

- Construction of Suriname – Guyana Bridge
- Rehabilitation of Paramaribo's historic centre and climate change adaptation and mitigation measures

The Bahamas

- Modernisation of the archipelago's energy system

Haiti

- Quality education and climate-resilient school facilities for uninterrupted access to learning
- Education as an agent of change (access, quality, governance)

Barbados

- Health systems resilience and digital transformation of health facilities
- Investments in solar, wind, geothermal and green hydrogen technology
- Reduce chronic water shortages and improve wastewater systems
- Climate Finance: mitigating or adapting to the impacts of climate change

Trinidad and Tobago

- Support the digital transition, including e-IDs
- Security of water supply, wastewater collection and treatment, storm-water management, flood prevention, coastal protection and solid waste management
- Facilitate shift from grey to green hydrogen through a transition to renewable energy (off-shore wind and solar)

Dominican Republic

- Sustainable urban transport infrastructure
- Integrated waste and water management
- Support the development of the green bond market in LAC and access to finance
- LAC Cyber Competence Centre (LAC4) and e-commerce and digitalisation

Belize

- Financing small infrastructures for indigenous communities
- Improve access to credit for MSMEs and individual farmers
- Better business and innovation climate for MSMEs
- Support women-led MSMEs located in rural communities

Guyana

- Implementation of the Forest Partnership and VPA FLEGT
- Expanding off-grid solar panels for the hinterland and transition away from fossil fuels
- Upgrading of the water treatment facilities
- Development and manufacturing of health products

Regional – LAC – Digital Alliance

- Extension of BELLA cable to Central America and the Caribbean countries
- Regional policy dialogue on cybersecurity, connectivity, e-governance and data governance
- Establishment of two regional Copernicus centres in Panama and Chile
- EU-LAC Digital Accelerator: supporting joint ventures between EU and LAC innovative start-ups, SMEs and corporations

Regional – LAC – Health Resilience

Support the development of local medicines and vaccine manufacturing and health systems resilience, including regulatory frameworks.

Regional – LAC – Global Green Bonds Initiative

Support the development of the green bond market in LAC, thus mobilising capital for financing a sustainable transition.

Regional – LAC – Social Cohesion

- Stronger linkages among academia, research and business, better responding to education, innovation and labour market needs
- Partnerships to reduce inequalities and reinforce social policies, accountable public institutions, and inclusive investments to foster just transitions
