

Respected Comrade Kim Jong Un inspects major munitions factory

Repeatedly expressing his satisfaction over the development and production of the excellent pistol, he offers thanks to the officials, technicians and workers of the factory

Kim Jong Un, general secretary of the Workers' Party of Korea and president of the State Affairs of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, inspected a major munitions factory under the Second Economy Commission on March 11 to learn about the munitions production.

Accompanying him were the members of the Central Military Commission of the WPK and leading officials of the WPK Central Committee.

Comrade Kim Jong Un learned about the start of the production of new pistols at the factory according to an approved design, examined and ratified by the Central Military Commission of the WPK on February 19 2025.

Saying that the factory plays a very important role in increasing the combat efficiency of the army, public security forces and militia forces as it takes full charge of the production of pistols and other portable light arms, he stressed the need for the factory to expand its production capacity in a far-sighted way, and set a high level of modernization of production lines and cultured production practices in conformity with the demand, requirements and standards specified by

the Party and achieve it in a responsible manner.

He urged the Second Economy Commission to organize the economic work well in order to produce weapons of fully guaranteed quality in a serial way by decisively raising the level of technical equipment of major munitions industry enterprises, establishing strict quality control regulations and order and supplying materials and products under contract in a planned way.

He stressed once again the need for all the munitions industry enterprises

under the Second Economy Commission to organize and conduct the work for establishing a cultured way in production and life at a more developed stage and continue to create model standards.

That day, he visited the shooting gallery of the factory to acquaint himself with the combat performance of the new-type pistol that went into production.

Noting that he received a report from the Ministry of National Defence and the General Staff on the unanimous impression that the new-type pistol is superior in the structural functions,

accuracy of hitting, concentration and combat utility, he said with satisfaction that he could personally see there a really excellent pistol developed.

He clarified his view on the opinion of the Second Economy Commission with regard to the issue of additionally establishing a new production line at the factory during the period of the five-year plan for the development of national defence, and gave an important instruction to that end.

He emphasized that the new production line should be established at a high level to be a model of modernization of the country's munitions industry.

He said that the deliberation on the plan for modernization of munitions factories in the period of the new five-year plan and on the budget bill for immediate modernization of three major munitions industry enterprises would be made at an enlarged meeting of the Central Military Commission of the WPK to be convened in April.

Repeatedly expressing his satisfaction over the development and production of the excellent pistol, he offered thanks to the officials, technicians and workers of the factory.



Destroyer *Choe Hyon* conducts test-fire of strategic cruise missiles

Amid the continued tests of operational efficiency of the destroyer *Choe Hyon* of the Navy of the Korean People's Army, a strategic cruise missile test-fire was conducted again on March 10.

Comrade Kim Jong Un oversaw the test-fire online.

He said that the test-fire on the destroyer was aimed at evaluating the reliability of the national integrated control system of strategic weapons and the warship's detection and weapon systems and verifying the combat effectiveness of the

integrated combat system in technical aspects and at demonstrating the Navy's strategic attack posture and making sailors well versed in the relevant military actions in other aspects.

The data on targets was transmitted to the destroyer *Choe Hyon*, the launch was approved according to relevant procedures and strategic cruise missiles were launched simultaneously to hit several targets.

The missiles flew along the flight trajectory set in the sky above the West Sea of Korea for 10 116s to 10 138s and hit the separate island targets.



Kim Jong Un expressed his great satisfaction over the verified reliability of the national integrated control system of strategic weapons and superiority of the vessel's integrated combat system.

He gave important instructions on reexamining in a Korean way the configuration of weapon systems of the destroyer to be built in the future in the light of the actual requirements in military aspects and from the development-oriented view.

Underlining the need to examine the military efficiency of the naval automatic gun installed on the warship in line with the specific conditions of the country, he expressed his view that it would be more advantageous to enhance the anti-warship and strategic attack capabilities in keeping

with the vessel's operational features by equipping high-speed warships of below 3 000 tonnage with such naval automatic guns and additionally installing supersonic weapon systems, instead of those guns, on the 5 000-tonnage and 8 000-tonnage destroyers in the future.

He stressed the need to examine the plan for organizing such Korean-style weapon system and apply it first to the third destroyer to be built.

Noting that it is a very important strategic task to maintain and expand the powerful and reliable nuclear war deterrent, he said:

"The components of our war deterrent are now being included in the very

In the development of science and technology of the country primary importance was attached to making all scientific research programmes directed to resolving practical problems during the eighth term of the Party Central Committee.

On several occasions including the Fourth Plenary

Meeting of the Eighth Party Central Committee, emphasis was placed on such points that the scientific research field should regard it as the seed, main assignment and priority task to resolve sci-tech problems, which need urgent solutions in economic construction and the people's living, as early as possible and step up research and development to that end and that it should widely introduce the successes in scientific research into practice and the principle it has to maintain in the course of it is to intensify and complete research projects in the direction of minimizing the costs by optimizing all processes of production and construction.

And a system was established under which the State Commission of Science and Technology grasps the

real situation of science and technology and scientific research of the country and gives unified guidance over the implementation of the sci-tech development plans of scientific research and educational institutions, ministries, national agencies and industrial establishments.

Accordingly, a series of practical measures were taken one after another including the establishment of a system to quickly and correctly disseminate necessary data to academic institutions and other relevant units.

State measures were also taken in succession to increase investment in the field of science and technology.

Scientists and technicians who contributed to the development of the country took part in the national

conferences and were invited to the national celebrations. They were awarded February 16 Science and Technology Prize, Natural Science Prize, Technical Innovation Prize and Best Inventor Prize and provided with new modern flats free of charge for their extraordinary successes in scientific research.

Several scientists, including the director of the Paper Technology Institute of the State Academy of Sciences who invented and introduced a paper production method that suits the actual conditions of the country, were selected as "outstanding sci-tech talents", the title which was instituted for the first time in the country.

Under the wise guidance of the WPK over the development of science and technology enormous

successes contributing to the implementation of the five-year plan were achieved in the field of science and technology.

Energy-saving oxygen blast furnaces and large oxygen plants were additionally installed and advanced desulphurization processes established at the large metallurgical-industry bases. Sodium carbonate production processes and melamine resin production lines were set up and scientific and technical problems were resolved to produce catalysts in Korean way at the major chemical industry bases.

A scientific and technical guarantee was provided to produce much more electric power in the electric power sector and agricultural sci-tech products and advanced technologies of great significance, valuable

research findings supporting the development of light industry and regional industry were released.

A radical change took place in the viewpoint and attitude to science and technology in the whole society and the activities of the February 17 Shock Brigade of Scientists and Technicians and the April 15 Technical Innovation Shock Brigade were intensified across the country. As a result, many industrial establishments as well as major sectors and units bustled with a mass technical innovation drive and in the course of it large numbers of scientific and technological problems arising in production and construction were solved and nearly 2 000 units won the title of model technical innovation unit in the past five years.

Sci-tech achievements conducive to economic development**Exhibition of sci-tech achievements in different sectors of the national economy-2025 held**

The exhibition of sci-tech achievements in different sectors of the national economy-2025, which opened in late December last year, ended on March 5 at the Three-Revolution Exhibition House in Pyongyang.

On display at the exhibition on the theme of "Era of prosperity advancing on the strength of science and technology" were a large number of sci-tech achievements made by many sectors and units of the national economy, including the sectors of metallurgical, chemical, electric power and machine-building industries, agriculture, light industry and fishing industry, during the five-year plan for national

economic development.

With domestic resources and technology

What were noticeable at the exhibition were the sci-tech achievements made by relying on the country's resources and technology.

The metallurgical industry sector established a high-grade manganese concentrate production process capable of raising both the grade of concentrate and the actual extraction rate while reducing the production cost by using locally-available low-grade wad.

The floating preheating-style oxygen heat blast furnace, introduced into the Kim Chaek and Hwanghae iron and steel complexes, drew the attention of people

as it can save anthracite and oxygen while increasing productivity as compared to ordinary oxygen blast furnaces.

The chemical industry sector made an achievement conducive to putting the production of the catalyst for polypropylene plastic production on a Juche basis. "The fourth-generation catalyst, a carrier-style catalyst, is being produced only in a few countries with the developed chemical industry in the world as it requires high-purity raw materials and advanced manufacturing techniques. The fourth-generation propylene polymerization catalyst we have developed is made from domestic raw materials and superior to previously used catalyst in

action," said Maeng Thae Won, head of an office of Kim Il Sung University.

The new crystal thenardite production process established at the December 5 Youth Mine, which uses locally-abundant glauberite, was built at one go and completely by the Korean scientists with their own efforts and technology, ranging from conception to design, building, installation and trial run of facilities.

The Ryongnam Dockyard established a new welding rod production process which ensures a high proportion of the domestic production of equipment and raw materials and which is helpful to the qualitative and quantitative growth of production, and the Port of Nampho made a container crane which helps increase cargo storage and traffic capacities, with a less manufacturing cost. These research findings enjoyed popularity among visitors.

Also attracting the interest of the visitors were various kinds of other sci-tech achievements including the establishment of a lead smelting process based on a rotary kiln-electric furnace method and a production process for putting the production of lighting appliances on a Juche basis.

By creating new and advanced things

Also noteworthy at the exhibition were new, advanced and innovative sci-tech achievements of a Korean style.

The Central Mining Research Institute under the State Academy of Sciences developed in a Korean way a pneumatic-mechanical flotation machine capable of turning the dressing plants into energy-, land- and labour-saving ones while increasing their processing capacities.

The technical group of the Hungnam Fertilizer Complex provided a sure guarantee for increased fertilizer production by optimizing the ammonia synthesis process and remodelling the condensation and separation tower. The Electric Power Information Institute under the Ministry of Electric Power Industry established a national integrated power control system to make a rational use of the country's electric power resources, thus making a great contribution to stepping up the modernization of the electric power industry.

The Sangwon Cement Complex increased its production capacity by combining various production processes in keeping with the world trend of cement production and put the cement industry on a modern, IT and scientific basis by establishing a distributed control system for production processes.

The machine-building industry sector upgraded the Kumsong Tractor Factory and other machine factories and made lots of sci-tech achievements in the production of materials, tools, machine elements and

equipment parts.

The agricultural sector concentrated efforts on providing a scientific and technological guarantee for the sustainable growth and long-term development of agriculture and thus newly bred and introduced dozens of high-yielding crop varieties and made a positive contribution to agricultural production.

The Pyongyang Wheat Flour Processing Factory set up a new technical process capable of producing high-quality dried yeast by selecting a yeast strain suitable for the production of dried yeast and establishing a method of preserving spores.

The Pyongyang advanced biotechnology development company of Kim Chaek University of Technology developed and produced phytosine and solved sci-tech problems arising in introducing it into various sectors of the national economy. Phytosine has proved effective not only in agricultural production but also in livestock farming, fishing industry, sericulture, forestry, public health and other sectors.

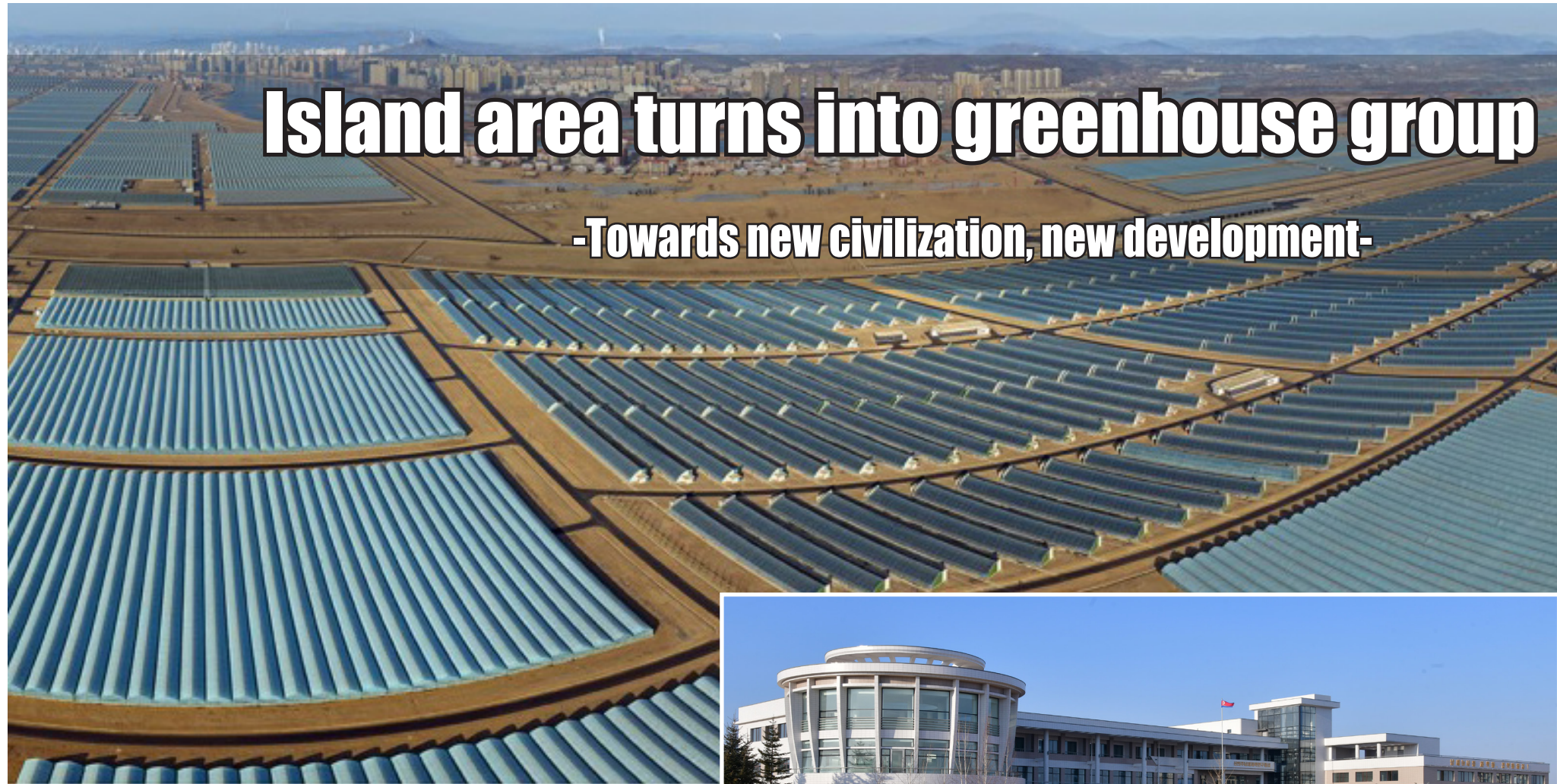

Island area turns into greenhouse group

-Towards new civilization, new development-

The Wihwa Island area has undergone a great transformation.

The area was notorious for sandy dust blown by the river wind, which is so strong to make it difficult to open eyes, and for the flood, which hits the island every year, from time immemorial. Now it has been turned into a treasure island covered with modern vegetable greenhouses, an ideal farm town envied by everyone, in a matter of one year.

Unprecedentedly large greenhouse group

The Sinuiju Combined Greenhouse Farm and the Sinuiju Vegetable Science Research Centre were wonderfully built in the Wihwa island area covering Wihwa, Taji and Ranja islands.

Well over 1 000 greenhouses covering an area of 450 hectares are larger in scale than the recently built greenhouses in Jungphyong and Ryonpho on the east coast and in Kangdong of Pyongyang put together.

And the greenhouses vary in type according to crops and economic profits, including semi-arched double-sheet hydroponic greenhouse, arch-style inter-connected vinyl soil greenhouse, double-slope inter-connected glass hydroponic and soil greenhouse, and domed glass

hydroponic greenhouse.

The double-slope inter-connected glass hydroponic greenhouse is a new-generation one based on an evaporative air cooling system to ensure suitable temperature in greenhouse even in summer while consuming less energy, and it is said to be the one close to industrialization of vegetable production.

The three domed glass hydroponic greenhouses built to look like a huge gem on Ranja Island comprehensively show the latest level of development of vegetable greenhouse as they are furnished with vertical rotary multi-layer vegetable cultivation arrangements, vertical flow multi-layer cultivation arrangements and horizontal plate multi-layer cultivation arrangements using LEDs.

And solar-heated greenhouses, where vegetable cultivation can be combined with fish farming and mushroom cultivation, highlight the characteristics of the vegetable greenhouse area.

The Wihwa Island area has a geothermal heating system, a nutrient solution supply ground and fertilizer factory, a carbon acid gas production ground and so on for the operation of vegetable greenhouses. And the combined greenhouse farm is based on an intelligent integrated production system, thus putting production organization on an IT and

scientific basis and optimizing cultivation technology management.

The Sinuiju Vegetable Science Research Centre, based on a vegetable sci-tech research and dissemination support system, will play the role as a scientific guidance unit and scientific research centre, which provides technical service for greenhouse vegetable cultivation across the country while conducting vegetable science research.

New civilization, new development

The establishment of the large greenhouse group in the Wihwa Island area has changed people, their life and development in the locality. The islanders did farming hard on fields generation after generation but now they produce vegetables by pressing control buttons in modern greenhouses, wearing neat work clothes.

Whenever they talk about their dwelling houses, the locals can hardly suppress their excitement and gratitude.

Modern dwelling houses were their impossible dream as they lived on, repairing their houses every year due to flood. But now they have become the owners of new modern houses without paying a penny thanks to the country's benefits after the picturesque houses were built in rows following the

construction of the firm bulwark along the edges of the islands.

The whole island area resounds with happy laughter and singing day and night as it has been spruced up with the paved roads stretching here and there so that they can walk without having to step on earth, the landscape as beautiful as a picture and the wonderful cultural and welfare facilities.

An official of the North Phyongan Provincial Rural Economy Committee said with deep emotion that the island area known as a vegetable production area from olden times has become able to produce incomparably more vegetables than before with the large greenhouse group built there and that the area shows the new development of vegetable production.

Unbelievable miracles

The change in the Wihwa Island area is unimaginable in common sense.

No one now believes that the area was the one submerged by the unprecedented flood in July 2024.

It is General Secretary Kim Jong Un who brought about the change even the locals, once the sufferers of the flood damage, still regard

as a dream.

In that month, the General Secretary visited the dangerous disaster-hit area to personally guide the operations for the rescue of the flood victims and unveil a grand plan to build dwelling houses and a modern large-scale greenhouse farm there for the well-being of the locals.

At the impressive inauguration ceremony of modern dwelling houses built there in a little over four months, he declared a new construction plan for the change of the region and led its implementation.

In February 2025, he attended the groundbreaking ceremony for the construction of the Sinuiju Combined Greenhouse Farm and the vegetable science research centre to dig the first spadeful of earth to signal the start of the construction. In the latter half of the year alone he visited the construction site four times to repeatedly give matchless courage to the soldier-builders and young builders and show great love for them and wisely led the construction.

He gave guidance over 170-odd plans for the construction, including the master plan and bird's-eye view, and over 3 850-odd technical blueprints.

He also took many measures and gave instructions on

many problems and issues, including those arising in the construction of a railway station and vegetable storehouse and those of planting many cover plants and fruit trees in the areas around the greenhouses, creating windbreak forests and natural park, creating drainage and water passage capacity, making preparations in a responsible manner for starting production immediately after the completion of the project and putting the management of the farm on an IT and automated basis, and the ways to prepare for the operation of the farm and manage it.

On February 1 2026, the day of the grand inauguration when the disaster-stricken island area turned into an ideal farm town, a new model of regional development, the General Secretary said in his speech at the inauguration ceremony that he was very happy and pleased that the area, where the local residents had suffered from flooding generation after generation, regarding it as their fate, became a base for their new life, which they will work cheerfully to build up, as it came to be protected by a solid dam that would resist even the heaviest flooding on record and wished all the residents a happy life.

Kim Yo Jong, department director of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea, issued the following press statement "Strong is the will of our state to defend peace and security in the Korean peninsula and the region" on March 10:

At a critical time when global security structure is collapsing rapidly and wars break out in different parts of the world due to the reckless acts of the outrageous international rogues, the US-ROK war drill is being staged in the ROK. This will result in further destroying the stability of the region.

On March 9 the enemy states launched the large-scale joint military exercises Freedom Shield, intensively revealing once again their inveterate repugnancy toward the DPRK and their policy of habitual hostility toward it.

The drill, involving more than 18 000 troops of the ROK and the US forces, is to be staged day and

night for 10-odd days across the territory, waters, airspace, outer space and cyberspace of the ROK. It is not a "military game" but a provocative and aggressive war rehearsal of those plotting and planning together the confrontation with the DPRK.

The enemies are again calling it "annual" and "defensive" but no matter what justification they may establish and how the elements of the drill may be coordinated, the clear confrontational nature of the high-intensity large-scale war drill staged by the most hostile entities in collusion at the doorstep of the DPRK never changes.

With its danger having been escalated in recent years as a result of the drastic addition of command and actual field mobilization exercises to apply and get familiar with new modern war manuals and methods appropriate to the actual conditions of the Korean peninsula, accompanied by nuclear elements, the war drill is being further supplemented by practical and provocative military elements

including information warfare and AI technology this year, too. This is another proof of its confrontational nature.

The recent global geopolitical crisis and complicated international events prove that all military manoeuvres of the field warfare troops, to be conducted by the enemy states, assume no distinction between defence and attack and between drill and actual warfare and that they should be suppressed through an extraordinarily overwhelming and preemptive super-powerful offensive, rather than a responsive or proportional action, in order to get fully prepared to cope with them.

Our head of state has already clarified that it is undoubtedly a law and iron principle that the most powerful offensive capability constitutes the most reliable deterrent.

Israel's registration of land as 'state property' a product of territorial ambition

The international community is raising voices against Israel as it recently decided to officially register the land in the West Bank belonging to the Palestinian territory as its "state property".

The foreign ministers of Arab and Islamic countries including Egypt, the United Arab Emirates, Indonesia, Pakistan, Türkiye, Saudi Arabia and Qatar issued a joint statement to assert that Israel has no qualifications to have sovereignty over the occupied Palestinian territory.

Denouncing Israel's

measure as a blatant violation of international law that endangers the two states solution, they called on the international community to fulfil its legal and moral responsibilities to stop Israel's dangerous moves to expand the Jewish settlements in the West Bank.

The Jordanian King warned that Israel's measure related to land registration is obstructing the detente process in the region and might deteriorate the Palestine-Israel dispute.

Foreign ministries of Jordan, Pakistan and other countries issued statements to brand Israel's act as a clear

violation of international law and relevant resolutions of the UN Security Council and the UN General Assembly sessions and asserted that to establish an independent state of Palestine is the only way to ensure regional security and stability and achieve just and comprehensive peace.

As to the recent decision of the Israeli cabinet on tightening control of the West Bank, a spokesman for the European Commission dubbed it a wrong step.

In its advisory opinion made public as to the legal results of Israel's policy and practices in the Palestinian territory, the International Court of Justice judged as

illegal the act of changing the legal, historical and demographic status of an occupied territory, holding a territory by force of arms or forcing the new composition of population.

Israel's measure of land registration is a product of its persistent wild ambition for territorial expansion and establishment of the great Israeli empire in the Middle East.

It began to build Jewish settlements soon after occupying the West Bank and East al-Quds through the Middle East War it started in June 1967. The Israelis indiscriminately arrested, expelled and killed

those who protested against it and demolished their living bases by mobilizing bulldozers and tanks.

At present, over 700 000 Jews accounting for 10 percent of the Israeli population are living in the Jewish settlements in the West Bank and East al-Quds. Not content with that, Israel is now running wild to seize all the land of the Palestinians.

The acts of Israel running amok for territorial expansion in defiance of international law and the denunciation from the international community are the main factor worsening the regional situation.

Human rights situation seen through contempt for women

The strike and demonstration staged by women workers in Chicago, the US, on March 8 117 years ago were an eruption of their wrath at the unequal social system where women are the objects of contempt.

Since then, fierce struggles for gender equality and emancipation of women have been waged on the earth, but there has been little change in the status of women until today.

In the society where contempt for and ill-treatment of women have become a social trend, the plight of women is as good

as that of fallen leaves in autumn.

The US constitution has not yet the provision banning discrimination against women. Such issue was placed on the agenda of the Congress in 1972, thanks to the struggle of the broad working masses against sexual inequality, but the relevant bill has not yet been passed even after a lapse of over 50 years.

The number of deaths of expectant and nursing mothers has gone up dramatically in the US over the past 20-odd years. More than 2.2 million women fail to receive obstetric care and nearly 5 million live in areas where obstetric care

conditions are very poor.

In the country, about 54 000 women lose their jobs each year for the reason of pregnancy.

And more than 6 million women suffer from violent crimes. In the US, a law was adopted in order to prevent domestic violence, as it is so rampant in the country, and even an "additional domestic violence tax" is collected when issuing a marriage certificate.

In Japan, even the women who conduct political activities are subjected to sexual harassment.

In the country, women are regarded as "childbearing machines" and encounter all sorts of unjust

discrimination. As it is commonplace for women to get fired by reason of childbirth, pregnant women and nursing mothers opt for suicide or unhesitatingly kill their babies out of fear about the harsh environment for existence after childbirth and for other reasons.

According to the Ministry of Health, Welfare and Labour of Japan, the number of children born in 2024 dropped by 5.7 percent over the same period of 2023.

Contempt for and ill-treatment of women are a social trend not only in the US and Japan but also in many other countries.

For women to get a job is "as hard as a bull

going through a pinhole" and even if they get jobs, they suffer from extreme discrimination in their workplaces. The first targets of unemployment are also women.

The word "glass ceiling" in vogue in many countries figuratively refers to the situation of women who are suffering misfortune and pain in their work and life for the reason that they are women.

A UN agency stated that many women across the world are being killed by their spouses, relatives and other people close to them, deploring that "family is the most dangerous place for women".

Putin refers to root cause of Ukrainian crisis

Russian President Vladimir Putin referred to the root cause of the Ukrainian crisis in an interview with a journalist of the All-Russia State TV and Radio Broadcasting Company on March 8.

The Ukrainian crisis was caused by the Western countries' support to the coup in Kiev, he said, adding that the crisis was caused not by any action of Russia but by the actions of the West including European countries.

He went on to say that everything going on in Ukraine can be said to be undoubtedly attributable to the systematic mistakes of Western countries.

The Kiev authorities are playing a trick on European countries, he said, adding sarcastically that the situation is very strange as it seems that the dog is being wagged by its tail rather than wagging it.

Mexico

President calls for enhancing women's role

The Mexican president stressed the need to enhance the role of women in nation building as she addressed an event held on the occasion of March 8 International Women's Day.

Referring to the importance of women's role in building a free, equal and independent state, she pointed to the necessity to make all women exercise the same rights with men, free from any restrictions, and fully display their talents.

And she called for building an equal society, free from discrimination and violence.

China

Australia's infringement of sovereignty decried

A spokesman for the Chinese Defense Ministry at a press conference on March 6 expressed the stand to safeguard the national sovereignty and security.

He disclosed that an Australian warship recently sent its military helicopter to the waters around China several times to conduct approach reconnaissance and commit ceaseless provocations and thus infringed upon the national security of China.

The Chinese army responded promptly to Australia's acts of violating the sovereignty of China and disturbing peace, he noted.

He strongly demanded Australia stop spreading false information and disturbing and undermining the regional peace and stability, stressing that China will never connive at any acts of infringing upon its national sovereignty and security but will surely counter them in a determined manner.

The bird feeds mainly on fallen cereals, grass roots like those of pondweed and insects as well.

The wetland in Ryongyon County is a wintering place or stopover for not only cranes but also swans.

White-naped crane nests on the ground in the northern region around April and a female lays two light brown eggs with dark brown spots.
