### Institution

The International **Kim II Sung** Prize was instituted on April 13, Juche 82(1993), according to the decision of the International **Kim II Sung** Prize Council. A certificate, gold medal, gold medal lace and trophy are awarded to a winner of the prize.

The international **Kim Jong II** Prize was instituted on December 24, Juche 101 (2012), according to the decision of the International **Kim Jong II** Prize Council. A certificate, gold medal, gold medal lace and trophy are awarded to a winner of the prize.

#### **Rules of Conferment**

The International **Kim II Sung** Prize and the International **Kim Jong II** Prize are to be awarded to prominent figures in the political, social and academic circles and businesspersons who have made distinguished services to the struggles for the independence of their countries and nations, the cause of global independence and peace and cultural development of humankind on the occasions of the Day of the Sun, birth anniversary of the Great Leader Comrade **Kim II Sung**, and the Day of the Shining Star, birth anniversary of the Great Leader Comrade **Kim Jong II**.
