

Kim Jong Un's Historic Visit to the Russian Federation

As is well known, Kim Jong Un, President of the State Affairs of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, visited the Russian Federation in September this year, drawing the attention of the international community. And the significance of his visit is growing with the passage of time.

It is a common view of political analysts that his visit boosted the DPRK-Russia relationship onto a new higher level.

This, too, is unprecedented in the history of visit of foreign heads of state to the Russian Federation and proves that the relationship between the two countries is of great strategic importance and it has entered a new phase of development.
