Ties of Kinship between Leader and People

Kim Jong Un, president of the State Affairs of the DPRK, who always goes among the people and shares weal and woe with them, is drawing the attention of the audience.

Saying that he feels happiest when he is among the people, he makes his way to see them everywhere they live, even remote islands, rural villages and hard-to-reach mountain villages. If it is for the sake of them, he readily takes risks and turns impossibility into possibility producing a perfect result.

A typical example is how he acted when the country's northwestern part was flooded in late July last year. Soon after the disaster, he visited the flooded area to oversee the rescue operation. He did not leave the area until he ascertained that every one of the victims was safely evacuated, and the following day he conceived projects concerning rehabilitation while inspecting the dangerous flooded area on a rubber boat. He visited the makeshift tents of the victims to learn about their situation, and took a special measure for the elderly, students and children. When they came to Pyongyang, he made sure that they enjoyed their staying with no inconvenience. Meanwhile, he travelled to the rehabilitation sites several times to guide the reconstruction. Thanks to his efforts, the victims could settle in the new modern houses that were built in a little over four months.

The Korean people regard it as their highest honour to meet their leader.

When meeting him, they throw themselves in his embrace and open their hearts to

him. Even a woman asked him to name her baby to be born. Children and students call him father and take it as their great pleasure and pride to show him how happy they are.

Such a relationship will not come of its own accord.

It will be possible only in a society where the leader is always concerned about his people and devotes himself to them with deep love for them and all the people place absolute trust in their leader.
