Miami, FL – Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA), in conjunction with FAMA, is proud to present – *Thread Upon Thread*, a juried group exhibition that explores the expressive and narrative power of soft textile books. On view from May 3 to 27, 2025, this immersive and intimate showcase invites audiences to experience how cloth, thread, and memory converge to tell deeply personal and universal stories.

Drawing inspiration from the imaginative world of childhood fabric books, *Thread Upon Thread* reimagines the format for adult creators—transforming soft pages into vessels for autobiography, emotion, and cultural heritage. Artists were invited to create textile books of 10 to 20 pages, each hand-stitched narrative representing the complexities and beauty of lived experience.

This exhibition honors the deeply human need to preserve and share memory through touch and image. These soft books—crafted with techniques such as embroidery, applique, and fabric collage—unfold like patchwork diaries, linking generations through stories told in thread. From introspection and healing to legacy and resistance, each work becomes a tactile archive of the soul.

Textile Books – Thread Upon Thread bridges the ancient origins of weaving (“texere” in Latin) with the literary function of narrative, evoking the book as both object and symbol of connection, preservation, and transformation.
