Miami, FL – Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA) is proud to present *Decibels of Life*, a moving solo exhibition by Venezuelan artist **Villasierra**, curated by **Adriana Meneses**. On view from **May 3 to 27, 2025**, this thought-provoking show explores the quiet resilience and emotional intensity of human life amid global uncertainty.

Decibels of Life invites viewers to engage with the invisible frequencies of existence—those emotional undercurrents that pulse beneath the chaos of modern life. In a world defined by conflict, division, and noise, Villasierra turns his attention to the subtleties: the softness of internal strength, the silence that follows upheaval, and the deeply human capacity to persevere.

Through mixed media works that oscillate between the expressive and the minimal, Villasierra balances metaphor and material. Each piece becomes a testament to life's fragility and fortitude—capturing both the decibels of despair and the quiet, enduring rhythms of hope.

"Decibels of Life is about listening," says curator Adriana Meneses. *"It's about tuning in to the moments of calm and vulnerability that reveal the soul's strength."*

This exhibition reflects Villasierra's ongoing exploration of art as a mirror for contemporary experience and as a means for healing through introspection.
