Su Noujaim: *Loose Threads*

Based in London, Noujaim brings her unique perspective to the art of weaving, creating intricate works that serve as both personal and collective narratives. Her pieces capture events where she is physically and emotionally engaged, simultaneously reflecting themes of public interest. As the artist explains:

"My weavings, like our relationships with people and events, are chained threads, tangled either orderly or randomly; they hang and fall, inviting the viewer to connect in some way, creating a sense of belonging."

Through her art, Noujaim explores the metaphorical ties that bind us to moments, people, and experiences, weaving together the personal and universal in threads that echo the complexities of human connection.
