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XI World Textile Art Biennial 2025 The Four Elements

Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA) is proud to host the **XI World Textile Art (WTA) Biennial** from **March 6 to 29, 2025**. This renowned event brings together 122 exceptional textile artists from 32 countries, showcasing three categories of textile art: **Large Format**, **Small Format**, and **Three-Dimensional Textiles**. This year's theme, **The Four Elements**, invites artists to explore the connection between earth, air, fire, and water in their creative works.

The Biennial will kick off with an exciting program of cultural events, starting with the **Opening Reception on March 6**, beginning at **5:00 PM**. The opening ceremony will feature the **Artist of Honor Exhibition**, *Weaving the Past into the Future*, honoring renowned textile artist **Pilar Tobón**, and the much-anticipated **XI WTA Biennial Opening Ceremony – The Four Elements** at **7:00 PM**.
