Miami, FL – Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA) proudly presents *Neither Here Nor There*, a juried group exhibition curated by Yi Chin Hsieh. On view from June 7 to 28, 2025, this timely and thought-provoking show brings together a dynamic roster of artists whose works investigate the liminal space between past and future, departure and arrival, self and other.

Caught between two states of being, *Neither Here Nor There* is a meditation on transformation and ambiguity. The exhibition explores themes of migration, displacement, cultural duality, and personal growth through a diverse array of visual languages and media. It captures the uncertainty and beauty found in transition, urging viewers to engage with the tension and richness of the in-between.

Together, their works reveal how states of flux become fertile grounds for introspection, creativity, and new identity formations. From personal narratives of migration to conceptual

engagements with space and memory, this exhibition resonates deeply with today's global experience of movement and change.
