René Romero: What Lies Between Us

Miami, FL – Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA) is proud to present *What Lies Between Us*, a solo exhibition by resident artist René Romero, on view from July 10 to 30, 2025. Curated by Shirley Moreira, this powerful and intimate show invites audiences to reflect on the invisible yet deeply felt spaces that shape our human relationships.

With a visual language that moves fluidly between the expressive and the symbolic, Romero explores the quiet tensions that live in the gaps—between bodies, glances, gestures, and silences. His works evoke themes of longing, vulnerability, connection, and transformation, offering viewers a contemplative journey through emotional landscapes.

Rather than focusing on individual figures, *What Lies Between Us* turns our attention to the unseen forces that unite, divide, or hold us in delicate balance. It is in these interstitial moments—between "you and me"—that Romero finds his truest subject.

"Romero's paintings ask us to feel what can't be touched, to see what's rarely shown," says curator Shirley Moreira. "This exhibition is a meditation on the invisible threads of human connection."

Rendered in a vibrant palette and guided by intuitive mark-making, Romero's work radiates sensitivity and presence. It calls on us to recognize our shared emotional terrain—and to honor what we hold between us.
