### **"Collected Times": Miguel Génova's Reflections on Pandemic Life at MIFA**

**Miami, FL** – Miami International Fine Arts (MIFA) is proud to present "Collected Times," an exhibition by Miguel Génova that brings together a series of works created in Madrid and Miami during the uncertainty and confinement of the pandemic. The exhibition runs from July 6-27, 2024, opening July 6 from 4 to 8pm and marks Génova's first solo exhibition in the United States.

**"Collected Times"** features three central calendars from 2020, 2021, and 2022. Each month is depicted as a grid of life, with each day represented as a cell of activities and signs. Génova uses spots, strokes, and images to reflect on daily life, combining fragmented moments into a cohesive vision.

The exhibition is complemented by five series of collages derived from specific circumstances over these three years. These include:

- **Spaces Occupied:** Imaginative spaces created even in the most drastic constraints.
- **Double-sided Cards and Tickets:** Symbols of changes in daily life.
- **Convergences and Divergences:** Clashes and approaches to surprising and everyday situations.
- **Farewells:** Emotional goodbyes from places and affections between smiles and tears.

Additionally, two assemblages are included, showcasing Génova's talent for collecting and combining diverse elements.

**About Miguel Génova:** An engineer, writer, and art collector, Miguel Génova works at the intersection of writing and image. In "Collected Times," he explores the fragmentary nature of collage, memory's capricious imprint, and the present's threatening visions.
