Introduction:

Messiah instructed His disciples, "Let your *light* so *shine* before men, that they may *see* your good *works*, and *glorify* your *Father* which is in heaven" (Matthew 5:16). When was the last time you heard or saw multitudes or even a few people in the world giving glory and praise to Elohim on account of the love or works of believers? Not lately, right? Yet, the Almighty has commanded and does expect His servants to do just that. He requires that we do all we can for the world to see the evident love of Elohim amongst ourselves and the works of Elohim being done through us.

For, only by so doing are we His body and by the demonstrated love of Elohim working in us and amongst us will the world believe that He sent His Son. We need to be a united and organized body to represent EL the Father, His Son and Spirit accurately, concertedly, and powerfully on this earth. In fact, Messiah died and resurrected to establish Elohim's congregation - His representative body on earth for all generations.

This wonderful Divinely assigned work and goal can only be achieved by synchronized collective efforts of a tightly united body as Elohim ordained, not by the disorganized and scattered factious organizations of this generation. The following will elucidate on Body of Messiah is, other important relevant information on why and how we can be His genuine body to serve Him effectually in this generation.

1) What is the Body of Messiah?

It is Elohim's single worldwide organization, comprised of faithful disciples united in Messiah Yeshua by the Holy Spirit to uniformly represent Him on earth, as the exemplar of the divine way of life and the tower of truth on earth.

The Body of Messiah exists and functions to achieve Elohim's exact goals as assigned by His Son. By His Spirit Elohim inspires and empowers His united disciples to proclaim His messages and accomplish His will on earth as in heaven. Elohim taught the Body of Messiah that it is the house of Elohim, His congregation as well as the pillar and basis of truth on earth. This was expressed through the apostle Paul, "But if I tarry long, that you may know how you ought to behave yourself in the *house* of Theou, *which is* the *ekklesia* of the living Theou, the *pillar* and *ground* of the *truth*" (1Timothy 3:15). Thus, the Body of Messiah is Elohim's dwelling, congregation, the model of the divine way, the foundation and tower of the truth on earth.

2) Who Established and Owns it?

It was established and is owned by Messiah Yeshua the Uniquely Born Son of EL the Father.

He started His first congregation with one gentile tribe, Abraham, next Isaac Abraham's son, and then Isaac's son Jacob, in a covenant of circumcision (Genesis 28:1-3). In time, Elohim selected and ordained Jacob to be Israel - His set-apart nation and congregation (Genesis 35:10-11, Exodus 19:3-5, Leviticus 19:2). Elohim was the exclusive owner of the congregation and ordained what it was to do and how it was to be done. Over one thousand years later, the Word and Son of Elohim - the Messiah Yeshua came to establish a New Covenant for the congregation and declared, "I will build my congregation and the gates of hell will not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18).

Paul, His apostle, describes the building process thus, <u>20</u> having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christou Iesou Himself being the corner *stone*, <u>21</u> in whom the whole building, being joined together, is growing into a holy sanctuary in the Kyrio, <u>22</u> in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of Theou in the Pneumati (Ephesians 2:20-22).

3) Who Leads the Body of Messiah?

Messiah Yeshua is the sole Leader and Head of the body. He assigns all administration, operation, purpose, functions, goals, and missions for Elohim's congregation.

The apostle Paul explained this in Ephesians 1 starting in verse 17, "That the Theos (EL) of our Kyriou (Supreme) Iesou Christou (Yeshua Messiah), *the Father of glory*, may give unto you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him... 20 Which He wrought *in Christo*, when He raised him from the dead, and *set Him* at His own right hand in the heavenly places, 21 *Far above all* principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 And has put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the *head over* all things to the *ekklēsia*, 23 Which is *His body*, the fulness of Him that fills all in all" (Ephesians 1:20-23). Paul also taught, "And He is the *Head of the body*, the *ekklesias*: Who is the Beginning, the Firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* He might have the preeminence" (Colossians 1:18).

4) Who Are Members of the Body?

The body of Messiah consists only of repentant people selected and united by Elohim from all over the world and generations who reciprocally love Him and accept His New Covenant in the Name of Messiah Yeshua by the Spirit.

The members, chosen from around the world, are united by their love for Elohim and acceptance of his Covenant being renewed in our hearts in the name of Yeshua by the Spirit. Connected in Covenant, the members follow the divine requirements of repentance, faith, and baptism. Staying focused, the brethren are gathering together in every way for Elohim to cultivate true unity in us through His Spirit, despite differences in viewpoints. So, its members are those who genuinely comply with the New Covenant requirements of, repentance, faith, and baptism. All who love and long for Elohim are empowered and sealed by His Spirit to produce virtuous fruit of the Spirit and are given gifts of the Spirit to effectively live and function as exemplars onto everlasting life (Acts 2:40-41, 46-47; Acts 5:13-14). 5) What Are the Roles and Duties of Members?

Members can be given the responsibility to *serve* as elders, pastors, deacons and, other ministerial roles *only* if and when so *selected* by the *Holy Spirit*. Elohim provided *instructions* by which the body of Messiah is to *recognize* the *ones* He *chooses*. Those He *selects* will be *recognized* by their *evident fruit* and *gifts* from the *Spirit* to *successfully* perform and *accomplish* the pre-ordained *works* of particular *roles*. This way of verifying who are Elohim's genuine servants was the standard since the early periods of Old Covenant to the New Covenant (Numbers 16:28, Matthew 7:15-20). The Body of Messiah is to uphold and *perform* His works *faithfully* as a unit *without* any addition, subtraction, or deviation *from* the *Scriptures*. Together, as a unit, it performs the foreordained works of Elohim concertedly by His Everlasting Arms.

Elohim assigned all administration, operation, purpose, functions, goals, and missions for His organization by the Messiah and His Holy Spirit. He established roles and chooses suitable members to fulfil the duties of the roles as His loving *servants*, not chiefs. His congregation is *not* governed *by* any *mortal* leader or leaders. It has *no main congregation* or *earthly* headquarters and does not need such. True congregations unite with other true congregations by *covenanted* rule of the *Spirit* over the *natural* inner *person* of each member, *not* by *human* constraints. Thus, while all true congregations are to edify each other and serve as one unit, *none* are to *control* the *other*. Every congregation is *responsible* to *be* and *do* what *Elohim* Has *established* by Messiah, each are *accountable* for *their* own *results*, and are blessed or chastised accordingly.

Of this Paul wrote, _Ephesians_2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christo Iesou for good works, which Theos preordained so that we would walk in them. He further stated, Ephesians_4:10 He who descended is Himself also He who ascended far above all the heavens, so that He might fill all things.) 11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for

the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of Theou, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christou (Ephesians 4:10-13). The preordained duties are specified and preserved in the Scriptures. The following are the roles and duties assigned to the body of Messiah.

- 1. *Apostles*: Chosen to see Yeshua and be empowered by the Spirit to preach, teach, with all the fruit and gifts of the Spirit to make disciples, and establish congregations of Elohim all over the world. The apostles Matthias and Paul are examples of this.
 - The Apostle Matthias
- 21 "Therefore it is *necessary* that of the *men* who have *accompanied* us *all the time* that the *Kyrios Iesous* went *in* and *out among us*—22 beginning with the baptism of John until the day that He was taken up from us—one of these *must* become a *witness* with us *of His resurrection*." 23 So they put forward two men, Joseph called Barsabbas (who was also called Justus), and Matthias. 24 And they prayed and said, "You, Kyrie, who know the hearts of all men, show which one of these two You have chosen 25 to occupy this *ministry* and *apostleship* from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." 26 And they drew lots for them, and the lot fell to Matthias; and he was *added* to the eleven *apostles* (Acts 1:21-26).
 - The Apostle Paul
- 6 "Now it happened, as I journeyed and came near Damascus at about noon, suddenly a great light from heaven shone around me. 7 "And I fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?' 8 "So I answered, 'Who are You, Kyrie?' And He said to me, 'I am *Iesous* of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting.'... 11 "And since *I could not see* for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of those who were with me, I came into Damascus. 12 "Then a certain Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good testimony with all the Jews who dwelt *there*, 13 "came to me; and he stood and said to me, 'Brother Saul, *receive your sight*.' And at that same hour I looked up at him. 14 "Then he said, 'The *Theos* of our fathers has *chosen you* that you should *know* His will, and *see* the *Just One*, and *hear* the *voice* of His mouth. 15 'For *you* will be *His witness* to all men of *what* you have *seen* and *heard* (Acts 22:6-8, 11-15).
 - 2. *Prophets*: Chosen and empowered to accurately foretell important matters to local or distant congregations by the Spirit of Elohim.

Numbers 12:6 And He said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I YHVH will *make myself known* unto *him* in a *vision*, *and* will *speak* unto *him* in a *dream*. Deuteronomy 18:22 When a prophet speaks in the name of YHVH, if the thing *does not come about or come true*, that *is* the thing which YHVH *has not spoken*. The prophet has spoken it presumptuously: you shalt not be afraid of him. Acts 3:24 Yea, and *all* the *prophets*

Yehoshua said "I will build my congregation and the gates of hell will not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18)

from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise *foretold* of these days.

3. *Bishops*: Chosen from a local congregation to guide, serve and, keep the local congregation stable and growing in Elohim.

1 It is a trustworthy statement: if any man aspires to the office of overseer, it is a fine work he desires to do. 2 An overseer, then, must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not addicted to wine or pugnacious, but gentle, peaceable, free from the love of money. 4 He must be one who manages his own household well, keeping his children under control with all dignity 5 (but if a man does not know how to manage his own household, how will he take care of the ekklesias Theou?), 6 and not a new convert, so that he will not become conceited and fall into the condemnation incurred by the devil. 7 And he must have a good repute with those outside, so that he will not fall into reproach and the snare of the devil (1Timothy 3:1-7).

- 4. *Deacons and Deaconesses*: Chosen from a local congregation to assist the local bishop.
- 8 Deacons likewise *must be* men of *dignity*, *not double-tongued*, or *addicted* to much *wine* or *fond* of *sordid* gain, 9 but *holding* to the *mystery* of the *faith* with a *clear conscience*. 10 These men *must* also *first* be *tested*; then *let* them *serve* as deacons *if* they *are beyond reproach*. 11 *Women must* likewise be *dignified*, *not* malicious *gossips*, but *temperate*, *faithful* in *all things*. 12 Deacons must be *husbands* of only *one wife*, and good *managers* of their *children* and their own *households*. 13 For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a *high standing* and *great confidence* in the *faith* that is in Christo Iesou (1Timothy 3:8-13).
- 5. *Evangelists*: Chosen to preach the Good News to local people as a testimony and for the growth of local congregation. Here are some examples.

Acts 6:5 The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose *Stephen*, a man *full of faith* and of the *Holy Spirit*, and *Philip*, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch. 6 And these they brought before the *apostles*; and after *praying*, they *laid* their *hands* on them. 7 The word of Theou kept on spreading; and the number of the disciples continued to increase greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were becoming obedient to the faith. 8 And *Stephen*, *full* of *grace* and *power*, was *performing* great *wonders* and *signs* among the people (Acts 6:5-8). Similarly in Acts 8, 6 The crowds with one accord were giving attention to what was said by *Philip*, as they heard and saw the *signs* which he was *performing*. 7 For in the case of *many* who had *unclean spirits*, they were coming out of them shouting with a loud voice; and *many* who had been *paralyzed* and *lame* were *healed*. 8 So there was much rejoicing in that

city... 12 But when they believed *Philip preaching* the *good news* about the *kingdom* of *Theou* and the name of *Iesou Christou*, they were being *baptized*, *men* and *women* alike. (Acts 8:6-8, 12). Also in Acts 21, 8 On the next day we left and came to Caesarea, and entering the house of *Philip* the *evangelist*, who was one of the seven, we stayed with him. Acts 9 Now this man *had* four *virgin daughters* who were *prophetesses* (Acts 21:8-9).

6. *Preachers*: Chosen to preach the Good News within a local congregation

The Old Testament describes some of what preaching involves, "Behold, I have discovered this," says the *Preacher*, "adding one thing to another to *find* an *explanation* (Ecclesiastes 7:27). 9 In addition to *being* a *wise* man, the *Preacher* also *taught* the people *knowledge*; and he *pondered*, *searched* out and *arranged* many proverbs. The Preacher *sought* to find *delightful words* and to *write* words of *truth correctly* (Ecclesiastes 12:9-10). Per the New Testament records, Messiah Yeshua taught, "And He said to them, "Go into all the world and *preach* the *gospel* to all *creation*" (Mark 16:15). Paul taught, "*How* then will they *call* on Him in whom they have *not believed*? *How* will they *believe* in *Him* whom they have not heard? And *how* will they hear *without* a *preacher*?" (Romans 10:14).

7. **Teachers**: Chosen to **allege** and **demonstrate** the instructions and way of Elohim for a local congregation.

The apostle Paul specified the placement of teachers among other Divinely ordained ministries and duties, "And Theos has *appointed* in the ekklēsia, first apostles, second prophets, *third* teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, various kinds of tongues (1Corinthians 12:28). Apostle Paul was one of such teachers, 10 but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christou Iesou, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel, 11 for which I was *appointed* a preacher and an apostle and a *teacher* (2Timothy 1:10-11).

- 8. *Widows*: Chosen to pray day and night for the growth and well-being of Elohim's congregations
- 9. *General Disciples*: Chosen to support divinely appointed ministers as needed, be the vital daily visible exemplars, lights, and models of Elohim's heavenly way of life for all others in this world, while engaged in everyday necessities.

As taught by Messiah and His apostles, the objective is to *demonstrate* to the world that *Elohim* exists and has indeed *sent* His *Son* to the *world*, so it may observe the love the members of His congregation have for Him and each other.

Also, that the world may see the praiseworthy grace, majesty, and practicality of living for and in Elohim. Messiah Yeshua elucidated, "Let *your* light *shine* before *men* in *such* a way that *they* may *see* your *good works* and *glorify* your *Father* who is **in** *heaven*" (Matthew 5:16). Paul exhorted in Romans 12 starting with verse 1, Therefore I *urge* you, *brethren*, by

the *mercies* of *Theou*, to *present* your *bodies* a *living* and *holy sacrifice*, *acceptable* to *Theoi*, which is your *logical* service of *worship*. 2 And *do not* be conformed to this *world*, but be *transformed* by the *renewing* of your *mind*, so that *you* may *prove* what the *will* of *Theou* is, that which is *good* and *acceptable* and *perfect* (Romans 12:1-2).

It is paramount for the body to always take due diligence to verify and accept, as official ministers, only those with the abundant evidence of the divine fruit and power of the Holy Spirit in their lives. *There are diverse roles, one body, yet one Spirit. Members discover and perform their high calling within the congregation – whether as an apostle, bishop, deacon, evangelist, Elder, or as a General Member – all guided and recognized by the evidence of the Holy Spirit's fruit and power in their lives.* For more details on the roles of the body of Messiah, refer to the "*True Ministers*" document on the website.

6) What is the Purpose of the Body of Messiah?

The Body of Messiah was established to *represent* Elohim, by learning, living, modeling, and teaching the Good News on earth. No matter their location, nationality, or race, members *love* and *serve* Elohim and each other as the *earthly family* of Elohim. The *purpose* of the Body of Messiah is for it to be the *exemplar* of the *right* loving *relationship* with *Elohim* and with *each other* so the *world* may *believe* EL the *Father* has indeed *sent* Messiah *Yeshua* His *Son*. This is poignantly expressed in Messiah's prayer for His disciples before He suffered (John 17).

20 "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word; 21 that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. 22 "The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; 23 I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me' (John 17:20-23).

Collectively and individually, *all members worship* (serve) Elohim by circumspectly *keeping* the divine *covenant*. In unity, they *proclaim* the *Goodnews* of Elohim by *faith* and demonstrated *power* of the *Holy Spirit* as given *by Yeshua*, the Supreme Savior and Judge of all. They are divinely guided, cared for, and united by the Holy Spirit as a body – the body of Messiah. The Spirit fills and enables them to *grow* as the *tower of truth* to *perform* foreordained *good works* in the knowledge of Elohim and Yeshua. They are the *firstfruits* of Messiah Yeshua unto *everlasting life*. Also, the apostle Paul explained that it is an instrument to show celestial authorities the variety of Elohim's wisdom in the world, "so that the manifold *wisdom* of Theou might now be *made known through* the *ekklēsia* to the *rulers* and the *authorities* in the heavenly places" (Ephesian 3:10).

7) How Does it Operate?

Elohim's Holy Spirit lives in and enables the Body of Messiah to be obedient and to do every good work successfully. It does everything out of love for Elohim and each other circumspectly. Unlike in the Old Covenant, in the New Covenant in Messiah Yeshua, Elohim replaces our carnal inner person with His Holy Spirit to enable disciples to live His way. They perform all duties in strict adherence to the Scriptures and guidance of the Spirit.

Grace by the Spirit to Obey and Prove Elohim's Will

The Spirit enables the body to be obedient and function to achieve the exact goals prescribed by Messiah. The Bible states, "But this shall be the *covenant* that I will *make* with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the YHVH, I will *put my law* in their *inward parts*, and *write it* in *their hearts*; and will *be their Elohim*, and they shall *be my people*" (Jeremiah 31:33). Also in Ezekiel, "I will *give* you a *new heart* and *put* a *new spirit* within you; I will *remove* your *heart of stone* and *give* you a *heart of flesh*. And I will *put My Spirit* within you and *cause* you to *walk* in My *statutes* and to *carefully* observe My *ordinances*" (Ezekiel 36:26-27).

The *need to remove man's heart of stone* and to replace it with hearts of flesh *implies that man's natural inner person is incapable* of proper obedience. In His *grace*, Elohim *inspires* and *empowers* His disciples to follow His instructions and to effectually accomplish His will as lights in the world. This grace *enables* members to *have* and develop *virtuous* character described as the *Fruit of the Spirit* and *gives* them *power* termed the *Gifts of the Spirit* to perform *miraculous* good *deeds*.

Through His apostle Paul, He described *nine* major *attributes* of the *Fruit of the Spirit* all disciples must have and cultivate. Paul taught, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law" (Galatians 5:22-23). He also taught, "For the *fruit of the Spirit is* in *all goodness* and righteousness and truth; *proving* what is acceptable unto the *Kyrio*" (Ephesians 5:9-10). Thus the fruit of the Spirit is the growing characteristic of genuine disciples of Messiah and their effectual means to prove the will of Elohim. Paul admonished, "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may *prove* what the will of Theou is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect" (Romans 12:2). This is the grace of Elohim by His Son and His Spirit.

Grace to Perform Miraculous Virtuous Deeds

In addition to the fruit of the Spirit, Elohim also gives His faithful disciples the Gifts of the Spirit. The gifts of the Spirit are graces given to disciples of Messiah to perform beneficent extraordinary deeds by the power of the Spirit. These *gifts* are *divine* and *cannot* be gained,

learned, or performed in any way other than the Spirit. Paul explained the gifts of the Spirit as follows.

1Corinthians 12:1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware.

<u>1Corinthians 12:2</u> You know that when you were pagans, *you were* led astray to the mute idols, however you were led.

<u>1Corinthians 12:3</u> Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the *Pneumati* of Theou says, "Jesoun is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesoun is Kyrion," except by the Holy *Pneumati*.

1Corinthians 12:4 Now there are *varieties* of *gifts*, but the *same Pneuma*.

1Corinthians 12:5 And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Kyrios.

<u>1Corinthians 12:6</u> There are *varieties* of *effects*, but the *same Theos* who *works* all things *in all persons*.

<u>1Corinthians 12:7</u> But to *each one* is given the manifestation of the *Pneumatos for* the *common good*.

<u>1Corinthians 12:8</u> For to one is given the *word* of *wisdom* through the *Pneumatos*, and to another the *word* of *knowledge* according to the *same Pneuma*;

<u>1Corinthians 12:9</u> to another *faith* by the same *Pneumati*, and to another gifts of *healing* by the one *Pneumati*,

<u>1Corinthians 12:10</u> and to another the effecting of *miracles*, and to another *prophecy*, and to another the *distinguishing* of spirits, to another *various* kinds of *tongues*, and to another the *interpretation* of tongues.

<u>1Corinthians 12:11</u> But *one* and the same *Pneuma* works all these things, *distributing* to *each* one individually just as *He wills*.

Paul taught that the body of Messiah should seek to have the gifts of the Spirit. Of all the gifts, he emphatically admonished the body to earnestly seek the gift of prophecy.

<u>1Corinthians 14:1</u> Pursue love, *yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts*, but *especially* that you may *prophesy*.

<u>1Corinthians 14:2</u> For one who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to Theo; for no one understands, but in *his* spirit he speaks mysteries.

<u>1Corinthians 14:3</u> But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation.

<u>1Corinthians 14:4</u> One who speaks in a tongue edifies himself; but one who prophesies edifies the church.

<u>1Corinthians 14:5</u> Now I wish that you all spoke in tongues, but *even* more that you would prophesy; and greater is one who prophesies than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may receive edifying.

Grace to Know and Support Each Other in Sincere Love

In 2Corinthians 8, Paul encouraged the Corinthian congregation to support disciples in other locations as needed by testifying of the ardent help supplied by disciples in Macedonia, 1 "Now, brethren, we wish to make known to you the grace of Theou which has been given in the *congregations* of *Macedonia*, 2 that in a *great* ordeal of *affliction* their *abundance* of *joy* and their *deep poverty* overflowed in the *wealth* of their *liberality*. 3 "For I *testify* that *according* to their *ability*, and *beyond* their *ability*, they *gave* of their *own accord*, 4 *begging* us with much urging *for* the *favor* of *participation* in the *support* of the *saints* (2Corinthians 8:1-4).

10 "I give my opinion in this matter, for this is to your advantage, who were the first to begin a year ago not only to do this, but also to desire to do it. 11 But now finish doing it also, so that just as there was the readiness to desire it, so there may be also the completion of it by your ability. 12 For if the readiness is present, it is acceptable according to what a person has, not according to what he does not have. 13 For this is not for the ease of others and for your affliction, but by way of equality—14 at this present time your abundance being a supply for their need, so that their abundance also may become a supply for your need, that there may be equality; 15 as it is written, "HE WHO gathered MUCH DID NOT HAVE TOO MUCH, AND HE WHO gathered LITTLE HAD NO LACK" (2Corinthians 8:10-15).

Grace for Divine Edifying and Joyful Convocations

As part of the worship, the Body of Messiah *observe holy days* set by Elohim as *found* in the *Bible*, such as the Seventh Day Sabbath, Renewals/New Months, Passover, and other High Holy Days in honor of Messiah. Based on *freewill offering principles* of the Law, *additional solemnities* may be *observed* in *loving* respect to *acts* and *events* of the *Messiah's life* on earth or other New Covenant matters.

The Scriptures state, "And when you offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the YHVH, offer it of your own free will" (Levitical 22:29). "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The feasts of the YHVH, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts" (Leviticus 23:2). "So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new month or sabbaths" (Colossians 2:16). Also, "These are the men who are hidden reefs in your love feasts when they feast with you without fear, caring for themselves; clouds without water, carried along by winds; autumn trees without fruit, doubly dead, uprooted" (Jude 1:12).

8) How the Body Makes Decisions as Elohim Commands?

The congregation is Divinely obligated to search the Scriptures to find its consensus on any particular matter that must be decided. When a matter is not specified in Scripture and the Spirit Yehoshua said "I will build my congregation and the gates of hell will not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18)

does not provide guidance, the congregation must decide by casting lots as instructed in the Scriptures.

Adhere to the Most Weighted Biblical Consensus

Guided by the Spirit, each active member is part of a dynamic community led by the Holy Spirit, making collective decisions in strict adherence to Biblical commands and the Spirit's guidance. The congregation works as a unit to make decisions cautiously and prayerfully according to the current covenant by the Spirit. The Body of Messiah is to perform all due diligence to research and find the option with the most Biblical weight or emphasis in consensus with the current covenant. When such a definitive result is found, the congregation must faithfully uphold and or do whatever that option is per the covenant. The decision must be made

Must Cast Lots to Decide Between Good or Unknown Options

When a decision or selection must be made between two or more acceptable options, where precedent and or direction is not available in the Scriptures or the Spirit respectively, the congregation is to *faithfully*, *prayerfully cast lots* to *know Elohim's will* as He *emphatically commanded*.

As stated in the law, "When direction from YHVH is needed, Joshua will stand before Eleazar the priest, who will use the Urim - one of the sacred lots cast before YHVH - to determine His will. *This is* how *Joshua* and the *rest* of the *community* of Israel will *determine everything* they *should do*" (Numbers 27:21). Likewise, the New Testament states, "*Then they cast lots*, and *Matthias* was *selected* to become an *apostle* with the other eleven" (Acts 1:26). For a comprehensive review of the casting lots requirement, refer to the "Casting Lots Biblical References" document on the website.

9) What is the Body of Messiah's Principal Faith?

There is only One EL (Deity) the Father

The Father is the First and Principal Reality, who alone is Eternal in duration. He is infinite in immensity, philanthropy, justice, love, majesty, power, wisdom, and all virtues. This fact is clear in the Scriptures, as the following examples demonstrate.

<u>Malachi 2:10</u> Have we not all *one Father*? hath not *one EL* created us? why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers? Mark 12:32 And the scribe said unto Him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is *one*

Theos; and there is none other but He:

Romans 3:30 Seeing it is one Theos, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith.

Ephesians 4:6 *One Theos and Father* of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

From the Father proceeds the Word and the Spirit termed the Everlasting Arms

The Word is the Firstborn and Elect Son of EL the Father – the exact likeness of the Father. The Spirit is the Power and Wisdom of EL the Father. By His Word and Spirit, EL created and sustains the heavens, the earth, and all they contain.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning *Elohim* created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:2 The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the *Ruah of Elohim* was hovering over the face of the waters.

<u>Deuteronomy 33:27</u> The eternal Deity *is your* refuge, And underneath *are* the *Everlasting* (olam) *Arms* (Z'roat); He will thrust out the enemy from before you, And will say, 'Destroy!'

<u>Psalms 33:6</u> By the *Davar of the YHVH* the heavens were made, And all the host of them by the *Ruah* of His mouth

<u>Psalms 104:30</u> You send forth Your *Ruah*, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth. <u>John 1:1</u> In the beginning was *the Logos*, and *the Logos* was *with Theou*, and the *Logos was Theos*.

1Corinthians 8:6 But to us *there is but one Theos, the Father*, of whom *are* all things, and we in Him; and *one Kyrios Iesous Christos*, by Whom *are* all things, and we by Him.

<u>Colossians 1:15</u> *He is the image* of the *invisible Theou*, the Firstborn over all creation.

<u>1Timothy 2:5</u> For *there is one Theos*, and one mediator between *Theou* and men, the man *Christos Iesous*;

<u>1Corinthians 12:13</u> For by *one Pneumati* we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one *Pneuma*.

Ephesians 2:18 For through Him we both have access by *one Pneumati* to the Father.

<u>Ephesians 4:4</u> There is one body and **one Pneuma**, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;

Mankind Needs El's Salvation (Yeshua/Iesou/Sōtēria)

By His Son and His Spirit, Elohim *planned* and *created* space for celestial creatures and earth for terrestrial creatures, including mankind, for *endless* fulfilling *life*. Elohim created the first people, Adam and Eve, to have continuous development, success, and happiness while experiencing their efforts, pure fellowship, and wholehearted loving gratitude towards Him.

Being their Divine Father, He gave them everything they needed to abound and the instructions to live and never die. He created them to be His loving family.

For that purpose, He created them with freewill to choose to live His Way of life or to choose otherwise. He provided boundaries and rules by which every creature and structure of the creation may function and thrive. He foreknew that Adam and Eve would eventually forsake His Way and would follow their own harmful paths, which would bring suffering and death to them and their descendants. He also foreknew that they and many of their descendants from generations would repent from the paths of death and follow His Way of Life with His Help. Wonderfully, Elohim's plan includes everything needed to accomplish His divine purpose to *salvage* all righteous and *repentant* beings to be *filled* with His *Holy* (Set Apart/Apportioned) Spirit to live in His Way for *endless* existence *by covenant* and to *eliminate* whatever and whoever is *harmful*.

All Have Sinned, Israel and All Nations

<u>Deuteronomy 9:5</u> "It is not because of your righteousness or the uprightness of your heart that you go in to possess their land, but because of the wickedness of these nations that the YHVH your Deity drives them out from before you, and that He may fulfill the word which the YHVH swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

<u>Deuteronomy 9:6</u> "Therefore understand that the YHVH your Deity is not giving you this good land to possess because of your righteousness, for *you are a stiff-necked people*.

<u>2Ch 33:9</u> So Manasseh seduced *Judah* and the inhabitants of *Jerusalem* to do *more evil than the nations* whom the YHVH had *destroyed* before the children of *Israel*.

<u>Jeremiah 16:12</u> 'And you have done *worse* than your fathers, for behold, each one *follows* the dictates of his *own evil heart*, so that *no one listens to* Me.

Ezekiel 5:6 'She has rebelled against My judgments by doing wickedness more than the nations, and against My statutes more than the countries that are all around her; for they have refused My judgments, and they have not walked in My statutes.'

<u>2Ch 36:14</u> Moreover all the leaders of the priests and the people transgressed more and more, *according* to all the *abominations of the nations*, and defiled the house of the YHVH which He had consecrated in Jerusalem.

The Son Elect of Elohim is Salvation – Yeshua

As planned before anything was created, Elohim sent His Son to earth by His Spirit, born as a male child via a virgin Judean woman. The child was named Yeshua, which means Salvation or Savior; commonly called Jesus. Per the Bible, Yeshua taught "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of Elohim has come near. Repent and believe the Good News" (Mark 1:15); the news that Elohim governs the universe. Yeshua did many amazing virtuous miracles which proved He was Messiah (Christ) so that whoever would believe in Him (trust and obey Him) would not be eliminated but be saved. All who repented and believed as He required, were baptized in water, and later by the Holy Spirit to be saved. He taught them to recognize each other and to live in unity of the goodness of Elohim. To set the covenant as planned, Yeshua allowed some Jews and Gentiles, who hated Him, to arrest and kill Him during Passover season. Yet, to their dismay, Yeshua came back to life after three days, then united and equipped His best students to be ministers of the Good News to all nations. Afterwards, the Savior returned to Elohim and will one day return as Judge and Sovereign of all.

Gen 49:10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

<u>Isaiah 49:6</u> Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that *You should be My Servant* To *raise* up the *tribes of Jacob*, And to *restore the preserved ones of Israel*; I will also give *You as a Light to the Gentiles*, That *You should be My Salvation* to the ends *of the earth*.'"

<u>Isaiah 52:10</u> The YHVH has made bare *His Holy Arm* in the eyes of all *the nations*; And all *the ends of the earth shall see* The *Salvation* of our Deity.

<u>Isaiah 59:16</u> *He saw* that *there was no man*, And wondered that *there was no intercessor*; Therefore His *own Arm* brought *Salvation* for Him; And His own righteousness, it sustained Him.

<u>Daniel 9:25</u> "Know therefore and understand, *That from* the going forth of *the command* To *restore* and *build Jerusalem* Until *Messiah* the Prince, *There shall be seven weeks* and *sixty-two weeks*; The street shall be built again, and the wall, Even *in troublesome times*.

The Resurrection and Final Judgement

All faithful members of the body of Messiah are judged and declared righteous firstfruits during their present mortal lives and are set for everlasting life by the grace of Elohim through Messiah. They will not be judged during Elohim's final judgement day but will be witnesses of His Divine justice on everyone else in the world. Before this final judgement, The Messiah Yeshua will visibly return as Supreme Ruler to this earth to resurrect all His faithful who had already died and gather with them all faithful who were alive before His coming. They will all be raised or gathered with incorruptible bodies for everlasting life. Messiah will destroy all who insist on opposing His rightful rulership and incarcerate the devil that deceived the whole world for one thousand years. Messiah will reign over all to restore and spread righteousness throughout all the earth. Then, after the one thousand years, He will release the devil for short time to expose his character and to expose people who still prefer evil rather than goodness.

Once all evil is exposed, Messiah will then destroy this present heaven and earth and dissolve all their elements with fire with everything in them. The devil will be judged, condemned, and thrown into a lake of fire prepared for him and his minions. Then Elohim will resurrect everyone who were not already declared righteous firstfruits by Messiah for their final judgement. They will all be judged according to the deeds they committed during their lifetime on earth. A celestial Book of Life contains precise record of every deed committed by every individual.

During the judgement, those whose names are registered in the Book of Life, on account of their desire to do right despite their inability, will be granted everlasting life and undergo a process of regeneration. Those whose names are not in the book, due to their rebellion against Elohim's Spirit of grace extended to them, will be irrevocably condemned to suffer and perish in the lake of fire.

<u>Psalms 96:10</u> Say among the nations, "The YHVH *reigns*; The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved; *He* shall *judge* the *peoples* righteously."

<u>Psalms 96:13</u> For *He* is *coming*, for He is coming to *judge* the *earth*. He shall *judge* the world with *righteousness*, And the peoples *with* His *truth*.

Acts 17:30 "Truly, these times of ignorance *Theos* overlooked, but now *commands* all *men* everywhere to repent,

Acts 17:31 "because He has appointed a day on which **He will judge** the **world** in righteousness by **the Man** whom **He** has **ordained**. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."

Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Iesou and for the word of Theou, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christou for a thousand years.

<u>Revelation 20:5</u> But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the *first resurrection*.

Revelation 20:6 **Blessed** and **holy** is he who has part in the **first resurrection**. Over such the **second death** has **no power**, but they shall be **priests** of **Theou** and of **Christou**, and shall **reign** with Him a thousand **years**.

Revelation 20:7 Now when the thousand *years* have *expired*, *Satan* will be *released* from his prison

Revelation 20:8 and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.

Revelation 20:9 *They* went up on the breadth of the earth and *surrounded* the camp of the *saints* and the *beloved city*. And *fire* came down *from Theou* out of heaven and *devoured* them.

<u>Revelation 20:10</u> The *devil*, who deceived them, was cast *into* the lake of *fire* and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they will be tormented day and night *forever* and ever.

➤ <u>2Pe 3:10</u> But the *day of the Kyriou* will come as a thief in the night, in which the *heavens* will *pass away* with a great noise, and the *elements will melt* with fervent heat; both the *earth* and the works that *are in it* will be *burned up*.

<u>Revelation 20:11</u> Then I saw a great *white throne* and *Him* who sat on it, *from* whose **face** the *earth* and the *heaven* fled *away*. And there was found *no place* for *them*.

<u>Revelation 20:12</u> And I saw the *dead*, small and great, *standing* before *Theou*, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is *the Book of Life*. And the dead were *judged* according to *their works*, by the things which were *written* in the books.

Revelation 20:13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up

Revelation 21:8 "But *the* cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and *all* liars shall *have* their part in the *lake* which *burns* with *fire* and brimstone, which is the *second death*."

Everlasting Life in the New Heavens and Earth

After the final judgement, *Elohim* will *create* a *new* and greater *heavens* and *earth* for His *faithful servants* and *all* others *granted* everlasting *life*. He will *bring* down *from heaven* a colossal, radiant *celestial city* prepared by His Everlasting Arms to the *new earth*.

<u>Revelation 21:1</u> Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea.

<u>Revelation 21:4</u> "And Theos will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be **no more death**, nor **sorrow**, nor **crying**. There shall be no more **pain**, for the **former** things **have passed away**."

Revelation 21:5 Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

<u>Revelation 21:6</u> And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts.

Revelation 21:7 "He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his Theos and he shall be My son.

Revelation 21:23 The *city had no need* of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of Theou illuminated it. The Lamb *is* its light.

<u>Revelation 21:24</u> And the nations of *those who are saved* shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor *into it*.

Revelation 21:27 But there shall by **no** means **enter** it **anything** that **defiles**, or causes an **abomination** or a **lie**, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

<u>Revelation 22:3</u> And there shall be **no** more **curse**, but the throne of Theou and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.

<u>Revelation 22:4</u> They shall see His face, and His name *shall be* on their foreheads.

<u>Revelation 22:5</u> There shall be *no night there*: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Kyrios Theos gives them light. And *they shall reign forever and ever*.

10) How long will the Body of Messiah function?

Messiah commissioned the congregation to teach all nations everything He taught them and to baptize everyone who believes at least *until* He *returns* as stated in Matthew. Verse 19 states, "Go therefore and **make disciples** of **all** the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "**teaching** them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the **end of the age**." Amen (Matthew 28:19-20). Also, the apostle Paul to Elohim's Congregation in Ephesus wrote, "Unto Him be glory in the **ekklēsia** by Christos Iēsous **throughout all ages**, world without end. Amen" (Ephesians 3:21).

11) Where is It located?

Initially, in the Sinai covenant, Elohim's congregation was comprised solely of the nation of Israel and was located only in Canaan. The land of Israel, particularly Jerusalem, used to be the headquarters of the congregation, until its destruction. Since then, Elohim's congregation has its headquarters in heaven rather than an earthly location. By the New Covenant in Messiah, the congregation of Elohim the Body of Messiah, exists all over the earth, is of all nations, and all peoples as prophesied in Malachi and by Messiah Yeshua.

Elohim inspired Malachi to prophesy, "For from the rising of the sun even to its setting, My Name will be great among the nations, and in every place incense is going to be offered to My Name, and a grain offering that is pure; for My Name will be great among the nations," says the ETERNAL of hosts" (Malachi 1:11). Some 400 years later, the Savior affirmed this plainly to a Samaritan woman as recorded in the Gospel of John chapter 4, beginning in verse 20 which states, "Our fathers worshiped in this mountain, and you people say that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship." 21 Yeshua said to her, "Woman, believe Me, an hour is coming when neither in this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. 22 "You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. 23 "But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. 24 "Elohim is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth" (John 4:20-23).

This was also impressed on the apostle Peter as recorded in Acts chapter 10. "Opening his mouth, Peter said: 34 "I most *certainly understand* now that *Elohim* is *not one to show partiality*, 35 "but in *every nation* the *man who fears Him* and does what is right *is welcome to Him*" (Acts 10:34-35). The apostle John saw the same thing, "And they *sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and *purchased* for Elohim with Your blood *men* from *every tribe* and *tongue* and *people* and

nation" (Revelation 5:9). Thus, over time, Elohim increased His congregation which was first one nation from a single tribe, to be one congregation of all tribes, tongue, people, and nations.

Clearly, it was and is *Elohim's great will* for *His one congregation* to be in *every* tribe, nation, and of every language. Thus, anyone or group teaching that Elohim's congregation is of only one particular nation and or emphasizes the use of one language over others, is opposing the expressed will and honor of Elohim.

In *this generation*, the body of Messiah is disconnected and *scattered* all over the world. Thankfully, in every generation, *Elohim* always *has* some *faithful* members *who*, by His Spirit, *know* to *seek* and *unite* with fellow *disciples* to *help* gather *disciples* all *over* the *world* for the *unity* Elohim requires. These *faithful* disciples *are* the *Body of Messiah* – the Congregation of Elohim *serving* Him in *all* the world. This can be understood in the following statement from Paul, "Unto the ekklēsia of Theos which is at Corinth, to *them* that are *sanctified* in Christos Iēsous, *called* to be *saints*, with all *that* in every place *call* upon the *Name* of *Christos Iēsous* our *Kyrios*, both *theirs* and *ours*" (1Corinthians 1:2).

12) What is the Divinely Assigned Name of the Body of Messiah?

Throughout the Old and New Testaments, Elohim *gives* His *congregation* a practical, *simple*, and yet *most awesome name* for *His* earthly *organization*. The immediate table shows the names assigned by Elohim to His one congregation and their occurrence throughout the Bible. The *Body of Messiah*, being Elohim's New Covenant congregation, *gladly* and *honorably* accepts *only* the *Divinely* assigned *names*. The following are some common Hebrew and Greek words found in the Old and New Testaments often translated as congregation.

Old Testament:

In the Old Testament, of our common Bibles, there are several different Hebrew words translated as congregation, four of which are **Edah**, **Kahal**, **Kehillah**, and **Moed**. Below is a summary of the meaning and usage of these Hebrew words sometimes translated as congregation. Knowing these Hebraic expressions and understanding how they were used in Scripture provide insight of what Elohim's organization was named and why.

New Testament:

In the New Testament, one Greek word *Ekklēsia* (G1577), is used to represent Elohim's organization. ἐκκλησία ekklēsía, ek-klay-see'-ah; means a calling out, congregation, assembly. This word occurs 118 times in the New Testament. It is first found in the Gospel of Matthew where the Sovereign told Peter; "And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build My Ecclesia; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18). The second time is found in Matthew 18 where the Messiah Yeshua instructed His disciples on how to manage congregants refusing to repent of sin, "And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the Ecclesia. But if he refuses even to hear the Ecclesia, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector" (Matthew 18:17). Here are four of ten passages where Ecclesia is specifically combined with the word Theos.

- Acts 20:28: Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Spirit hath made you overseers, to feed the *Ecclesia* of *Theos*, which he hath purchased with his own blood.
- 1Corinthians 1:2: Unto the *Ecclesia* of *Theos* which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Messiah Yehoshua, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Yehoshua Messiah our Absolute Ruler, both theirs and ours:
- 1Corinthians 10:32: Give none offence, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the *Ecclesia* of *Theos*:

• 1Corinthians 11:22: What? have ye not houses to eat and to drink in? or despise ye the *Ecclesia* of *Theos*, and shame them that have not? What shall I say to you? shall I praise you in this? I praise you not.

The six other references used are 1Corinthians 14:28; 1Corinthians 15:9; 2Corinthians 1:1; Galatians 1:13; Ephesians 3:10; and 1Timothy 3:5. All these passages combine the Greek word *Ecclesia* with **Theos** to convey *Ecclesia Theos*.

Notice, whether in *Hebrew* or *Greek* each one is simply a combination of the congregation and the Name or Title of the Deity. Regarding Greek, the Septuagint utilizes the ekklesias for congregation. The *Latin* translations use ecclesiam. The *Tyndale Bible*, the first *English* translation of the Bible, uses the word *congregation – not* church. *Elohim* gave us a *corporate* title that *always* includes His *Name* or *Title* to show *we* belong to *Him*. All denominations, groups, or individuals that use a different title have entrenched division among believers. The body of Messiah must never deviate from His expressed standard, as doing so would initiate and perpetuate division.

13) The Body of Messiah Must be United

We must unite as Messiah expects and requested in prayer.

Jhn 10:16 "And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd."

<u>John 17:11</u> "Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We *are*."

<u>John 17:21</u>-23 "that they **all** may be **one**, as You, Father, *are* in Me, and I in You; that **they** also may be **one** in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. <u>22</u> And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that **they may be one** just as **We are one**. <u>23</u> I in them, and You in Me; that **they may be made perfect in one**, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."

To those with ears to hear, by the Messiah's words, we know He expects His **true servants** to **unite** – very **cohesively**.

We must unite whether in suffering or honor to grow to the measure of Messiah.

<u>1Corinthians 12:25</u>-27 that there should be **no schism** in the body, but *that* the members should have the **same care** for one another. $\underline{26}$ And if **one** member **suffers**, **all** the members **suffer** with *it*; or if **one** member is **honored**, **all** the members **rejoice** with *it*. $\underline{27}$ Now you are the body of

Messiah Holds Each Congregation Accountable for their Own Deeds

As afore stated, the congregation is governed only by Messiah, not by any mortal leader or leaders. It has *no leading congregation* or *earthly* headquarters and does not need such. True congregations choose to unite with other true congregations by the *covenanted rule of the Spirit* over the natural inner person of each member, not by human constraints. Thus, while all true congregations are to edify each other and serve as one unit, none are to control the other. Every congregation is *responsible* to *be* and *do* what Elohim Has established by Messiah, are each held *accountable* for *their* own *results*, and are blessed or chastised accordingly.

<u>Luke 12:42</u> And the Kyrios said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom *his* Kyrios will make ruler over His household, to give *them their* portion of food in due season?

<u>Luke 12:43</u> "Blessed *is* that servant whom his Kyrios will find so doing when he comes.

<u>Luke 12:44</u> "Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has.

<u>Luke 12:47</u> "And that servant *who knew* his Kyriou will and did *not* prepare *himself* or *do* according to his will, shall be *beaten* with *many stripes*.

14) Benefits Of Unity

As in all commands from Elohim, the command to stay united has benefits. Considering a few, unity facilitates our effectual learning, work, growth, in His Uniquely Born Son and His Holy Spirit. Let us examine some of these benefits from the scriptures.

Elohim greatly values our active fellowship in Him

Mal 3:16 Then those who feared the YHVH spoke to one another, And the YHVH listened and heard them; So a book of remembrance was written before Him For those who fear the YHVH And who meditate on His Name.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,

<u>Hebrews 10:25</u> **not forsaking** the **assembling** of ourselves **together**, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so **much** the **more** as you see the Day approaching.

Enables efficient communication of Elohim's messages

Exo 3:16 "Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them, 'The YHVH Deity of your fathers, the Deity of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared to me, saying, "I have surely visited you and *seen* what is done to you in Egypt;

<u>Deuteronomy 4:10</u> "especially concerning the day you stood before the YHVH your Deity in Horeb, when the YHVH said to me, '**Gather** the people to Me, and I will let them **hear** My words, that they may **learn** to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and *that* they may **teach** their children.'

<u>Deuteronomy 31:12</u> "Gather the people together, men and women and little ones, and the stranger who *is* within your gates, that they may hear and that they may learn to fear the YHVH your Deity and carefully **observe** all the words of this law,

It fosters a state of pleasantness

<u>Psalms 133:1</u> A Song of Ascents. Of David. **Behold**, how **good** and how **pleasant** *it is* For **brethren** to **dwell** together in **unity**!

Receiving answers to prayers and fellowship of Messiah

Matthew 18:19-20 "Again I say to you that if two of you **agree** on earth concerning **anything** that they **ask**, it **will** be **done** for them by My Father in heaven. 20 "For where two or three are **gathered** together in **My name**, I am there in the midst of them."

15) Achieving Unity

As per the scriptures every command Elohim gives His people are achievable, including unity. Deuteronomy 29:29 "The secret things belong to the YHVH our Deity, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law." Deuteronomy 30:14 "But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it.

The failure to achieve unity comes from the same sources that scattered the body of Messiah, divisive self-serving false leaders, cult of personality, and the unfaithful. As for the faithful, we know that whatever Elohim commands He empowers and graces His faithful ones to fulfill His directives. For us as members of His congregation we know that His congregation is being built and led only by Yehoshua Messiah the only head.

We are not deceived into thinking that everyone will unite. His word and His Spirit teach us that only those who are His, that is those who obey him in hope faith and love, will heed the call to unite. As such we will do all we can to find our fellow members of the body of Messiah to connect and unite for the honor and name of Elohim in His everlasting arms. really brethren this work is not easy it is not too hard it is not impossible. As we serve looking to the author and finisher of our faith, with the fruit of the Spirit and His gifts, we will achieve it. Let us review some scriptures that affirms this.

Honor and Regard Only Messiah as Head of the Body

Know and expect Elohim to unite our hearts and minds when we differ in understanding.

Ezekiel 36:27 "I will put **My Spirit** within you and **cause** you to **walk** in My **statutes**, and **you** will **keep** My judgments and do *them*.

<u>Colossians 2:2</u> that their **hearts** may be **encouraged**, being **knit together** in **love**, and *attaining* to all **riches** of the full **assurance** of **understanding**, to the **knowledge** of the mystery of **God**, both of the **Father** and of **Messiah**,

16) Maintaining Unity

To maintain this unity, we must do it as Elohim commanded in hope faith and love of Elohim His Son and His Spirit. the basis of unity is primarily love for Elohim and secondly love for all, especially those who love him. As aforementioned in the prior two teachings, the body of Messiah was scattered by false teachers, cult of personality, and everything that comes from these sources and works of darkness. The key to maintaining unity is the light that comes from love - the love of Elohim. Let us now review the unity that comes from the light of the love of Elohim.

Be Gentle and Patient When There are Reasonable Differences of Opinion

<u>Psalms 25:5</u> **Lead** me in thy **truth**, and **teach** me: for Thou *art* the Eloha of my (Yish-iy) salvation; on thee do I **wait all the day**.

<u>John 16:13</u> Howbeit when He, the **Spirit** of **truth**, is come, He will **guide** you into all **truth**: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will **show** you **things** to **come**.

Acts 4:31 And when they had **prayed**, the place where they were **assembled together** was shaken; and they were all **filled** with the **Holy Spirit**, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

<u>1Corinthians 1:10</u> Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Yeshua Messiah, that **you** all **speak** the **same** thing, and *that* there be **no divisions** among you, but *that* you be **perfectly** joined **together** in the **same mind** and in the **same judgment**.

<u>Ephesians 4:2-3</u> with all **lowliness** and **gentleness**, with **longsuffering**, bearing with one another in love, 3 endeavoring to **keep** the **unity** of the **Spirit** in the **bond** of **peace**

<u>Ephesians 4:15</u> But **speaking** the **truth** in **love**, may **grow** up into Him in all things, which is the Head, even Christ:

<u>Ephesians 5:9</u> (For the **fruit** of the **Spirit** is in all **goodness** and **righteousness** and **truth**;)

Thus, rather than falling for the adversary's snares we must grab firm hold of each other to *study* and *pray* for the *unity* of *mind* in the *bond* of *peace* of Messiah in the *Spirit*. Again, we *must* in *long suffering* trust the *Son* and the *Spirit* to *unify* our *understanding*.

Teach only What We Know - Not Unverified Beliefs

Keep all uncertain ideas or personal, unverifiable faith as private matters among the established brethren only. Until proven, we do not teach anything that is not of faith - that is of empirical knowledge.

<u>John 3:11</u> "Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness.

Romans 14:22 Do **you** have **faith? Have** *it* **to yourself** before God. Happy *is* he who does not **condemn** himself in what he approves.

<u>Titus 3:9</u> But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the **Law**, for they are **unprofitable** and **worthless**.

Note, this verse does not state we should not discuss these matters, but rather to avoid doing so in a *foolish* (absurd, impious, stupid, unrighteous) *context*.

Cast Lots to Decide Between Good Vital Options - Not by Votes

When there is an impasse in deciding between two or more Scripturally sound options *requiring* a *decision*, the representative *servants* of the body *must* come *together* to *cast lots* before *Elohim* and *witnesses* in *prayer*. This *way*, the congregation *will* let Elohim *decide* for them and *commit* in Elohim by His Son and Spirit to *faithfully* accept and *adhere* to the *outcome* of casting the lots.

<u>Joshua 13:6</u> "all the inhabitants of the mountains from Lebanon as far as the Brook Misrephoth, and all the Sidonians—them I will drive out from before the children of Israel; **only** divide it **by lot** to Israel as an inheritance, as **I have commanded you**.

Proverbs 16:33 The lot is cast into the lap, But its every decision is from the YHVH.

Acts 1:24-26 And **they prayed** and said, "You, O **Lord**, who know the hearts of all, **show** which of these two **You have chosen** 25 "to take part in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place." 26 And **they cast** their **lots**, and the **lot fell** on **Matthias**. And **he** was numbered **with** the eleven **apostles**.

Reject or Expel the Contentious and Rebellious

<u>Proverbs 13:10</u> Only by **pride** comes **contention**: but with the well advised is wisdom.

<u>Proverbs 26:21</u> As **coals** are to **burning** coals, and wood to fire; so is a **contentious** man to kindle **strife**.

<u>Proverbs 22:10</u> Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yes, strife and reproach shall cease.

Matthew 18:15 Moreover if your brother shall trespass against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone: if he shall hear you, you have gained your brother. 16 But if he does not listen to you, then take with you one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every fact may be established. 17 And if he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the congregation: but if he refuses to listen to the congregation, let him be to you as an heathen man and a tax collector (Matthew 18:15-17).

<u>1Corinthians 5:1</u> It is actually reported that there is immorality **among you**, and **immorality** of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that **someone** has his father's wife.

<u>1Corinthians 5:5</u> I have **decided** to **deliver** such a **one** to **Satan** for the **destruction** of his **flesh**, **so** that **his spirit** may be **saved** in the **day** of the **Kyriou Iesous**.

<u>Titus 3:10</u> **Reject** a **factious** man **after** a **first** and **second warning**, 11 **knowing** that **such** a man is **perverted** and is **sinning**, being **self-condemned** (Titus 3:10-11).

Thus, differences in understanding or opinion are not justifiable reasons for division. A child of Elohim will never divide for that - must never divide in these situations. The enemy looks for every opportunity to sow discord and division to weaken and render the body of Messiah ineffectual. Therefore, in cases when contentious, divisive, or rebellious people claim to be of Messiah or who want to be so, such people must be expelled or rejected as Elohim instructs.

Conclusion:

It is clear then, that Elohim established the Body of Messiah through His Everlasting Arms, to demonstrate the right loving relationship with Him and with each other so the world may believe He sent His Uniquely Born Son, the promised Elect Savior, into the world. Elohim endowed the body of Messiah, His workmanship, His congregation with fruit and gifts of the Spirit to achieve that blessed work through virtuous, foreordained works, and the proclamation of His Good News in His Son and Spirit.

Yet, what is being demonstrated today and what is being experienced in the world? Sadly, the world is seeing examples and experiencing very weak, ineffectual, scattered, unrecognizable, organizations claiming to be the body of Messiah. The world is being turned away from the truth by factions contributing to the apostasy and unbelief that is ruining the beautiful creation of the Almighty beneficent Elohim.

Thankfully, it does not have to be so, for it is Elohim's manifest will that His organization stay united. Of old in many generations past He lit the hearts of His servants Jews and gentiles alike to fulfill His will by the fruit and gifts of His Spirit by His Son. We know from the scriptures old and new that His congregation, the Body of Messiah, was establish and blessed to accomplish great works.

Brethren, Elohim commands that we unite and stay united – it is not an option if we want to serve Him in spirit and in truth. In His word, and as is observable all around us, there are powerful benefits in being united. As we reviewed unity is a foundation for us to learn, grow, and perform the foreordained works effectively efficiently. Furthermore, we must always remember that Elohim has provided the means for us to achieve every work He requires of His servants.

Therefore, brethren let us put aside every agenda and preferences that would hinder or conflict

with Elohim's will. Let us put aside doubts stemming from failures of others or our own. Let us no longer be immobilized or paralyzed in wondering how or what we can do to unite everyone. Rather, let us, like our Father, work to unite **only whosoever wills** — not idolatrous organizations, divisive denominations, the unfaithful, or scoffing blasphemers. Let us be believing in Elohim as we focus to gather and help reunite the scattered body of Messiah.

Brethren, given the present dire situation all over the world, reuniting the body of messiah is a very high priority, if not the highest priority for His servants. For, without our being united, the necessary knowledge, faith, evident love, growth, and work that brings honor and praise to Elohim cannot be properly achieved. When was the last time you heard or saw multitudes or even a few people in the world giving glory and praise to Elohim on account of the love or works of believers? Not lately, right? Yet, we must make sure we do all we can for the world to see the evident love of Elohim amongst ourselves and the works of Elohim being done through us. Only by so doing are we His body and by the demonstrated love of Elohim working in us and amongst us will the world believe that He sent His Son.

Let us therefore be believing in the purpose, command, and graces of Elohim in His Son and Spirit. Let us devotedly do all we can to participate in His work to reunite His scattered people as His One Body and representative organization on earth. We may not get to see all His people united, but we will see some of it happen and have heaven's honor of being participants in Elohim's will being done on earth. Furthermore, we will be counted among all those who believed and worked to unite the body of Messiah, the holy Congregation of Elohim. He will indeed accomplish that before His Elect and Uniquely Born Son visibly appears in the world as King over all the kings. Let us be believing and unite in hope, faith, and love of Elohim in Messiah and the Spirit. Finally, let the words of the Uniquely Born Son of Elohim – the Elect One resonate in our ears, hearts, and minds to stir us to gather and unite the scattered, "He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad" (Matthew 12:30).
