I CALLED MATTHEW TERRY AT VADA IN SOME SORT OF CHAOTIC STATE AND ASKED HIM IF THERE WAS SPACE AT THE STUDIO THE FOLLOWING WEEK AND IF HE KNEW OF ANY MUSICIANS THAT WOULD BE INTERESTED IN TRACKING SOMETHING LIVE AND WILD. HE DID, AND SO A WEEK LATER WE FOUND OURSELVES STOOD IN THE CHAPEL AT VADA, GUITARS AND STICKS IN HAND NOT KNOWING WHAT WOULD HAPPEN.



AS IS NOW MY PREFERRED METHOD OF RECORDING WE TRACKED THIS SONG FULLY LIVE, IN ONE TAKE AND WHAT YOU HEAR IS WHAT WAS PERFORMED IN THE ROOM. NO EDITING, NO FUNNY BUSINESS, NO TRICKS JUST MUSIC. GEORGE PERKS (VADA'S STUDIO ENGINEER) AND MYSELF MIXED THE SONG UP THE SSL DESK AT 2AM AFTER FINISHING TRACKING.



I HAVE ALWAYS LOVED THE LIVE ELEMENT OF MUSIC AND SO NOW FIND MYSELF OFTEN FIGHTING TO MAKE SURE THAT THE SOUNDS CREATED AND FEELING IS ORGANIC. IT MAY NOT BE PERFECT BUT IT IS REAL AND THERE IS A LOT TO BE SAID FOR THAT (IN MY HUMBLE AND SMALL OPINION).

The very next day Callan and I sat down to discuss the story part of the video. Being an avid horror fan and interested in all things symbolic we discussed the concept and what references / inspiration we would like to include in the visuals. So that night we began building a 8ft crucifix to carry up the Malvern Hills at 5am the following day. Freezing and tired we shot the video and edited it that same day.



I've always been fascinated by the idea of dark and light, heaven and hell if you will (with little leaning to any one con-scribed religion) this offering touches on that. I believe we fear darkness that we consider it evil and it also my belief that darkness is not evil, rather necessary, there is no day without night, no light without dark, they need each other and each guides us greatly.
