NIEDZIELA ŚWIETEJ RODZINY

Nasze rodziny mogą być święte, jeśli będzie tam Jezus. Zadbajmy o atmosferę modlitwy, stan łaski uświęcającej, dobre słowo od poranka po zmierzch, zawsze pełni szacunku dla inności naszych bliźnich. Zadajmy sobie dzisiaj pytanie, czy podobnie jak Józef z Maryją potrafimy zaakceptować niezależność innych ludzi? Czy bierzemy pod uwagę to, że mają oni swoje życie, za które sami są odpowiedzialni i nie muszą żyć tak jak nam się wydaje, że powinni żyć? Ważna i wcale nie bez znaczenia kwestia; czy potrafimy słuchać naszych braci, nasze dzieci? Jesteśmy w stanie przyjąć, że mogą wiedzieć coś, czego my nie wiemy? Nikt nie znał Jezusa lepiej niż Maryja, ale i Ona poznawała Go także i przez to, że potrafiła i chciała uważnie słuchać spotykanych w drodze ludzi. Często mówili oni rzeczy wręcz zdumiewające, tak że zarówno Józef jak i Maryja dziwili się. Jednak w żadnym wypadku nie pozwolili sobie na próbę zawłaszczenia Jezusa i podporządkowania Go sobie. Nie chcieli przerabiać Go na swoją modłę, pozwolili Mu pozostać Kim jest. Próbujemy naśladować świętych rodziców a wtedy i my doświadczymy odbłasku rodziny nazareńskiej pod naszym dachem.

THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS MARY AND JOSEPH

Our families can be holy if Jesus is there. Let us take care of the atmosphere of prayer, the state of sanctifying grace, a good word from morning to night, always full of respect for the otherness of our neighbors. Let us ask ourselves today whether, like Joseph and Mary, we are able to accept the independence of other people? Do we take into account that they have their own lives, for which they are responsible and do not have to live as we think they should live? An important and not insignificant issue; are we able to listen to our brothers, our children? Are we able to accept that they may know something that we do not know? No one knew Jesus better than Mary, but she also got to know Him through the ability and willingness to listen carefully to the people she met along the way. They often said things that were simply astonishing, so that both Joseph and Mary were surprised. However, they did not allow themselves to try to appropriate Jesus and subordinate Him to themselves. They did not want to change Him to their own style, they allowed Him to remain Who He is. Let us try to imitate our holy parents and then we too will experience the reflection of the Nazareth family under our roof
