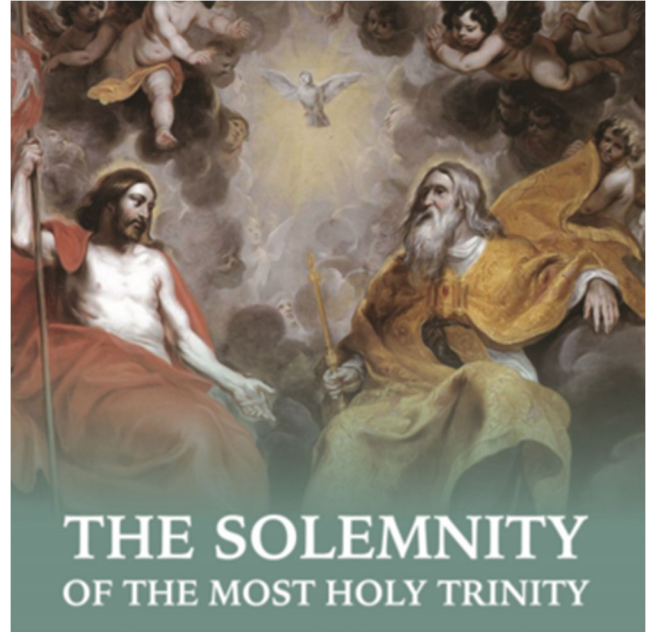

### **SPONSOR CERTIFICATE AND LETTER OF GOOD STANDING**

The purpose of a sponsor certificate is for the individual (sponsor) to aid the candidate in leading a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of Catholic faith. To do this, the individual must be living the Catholic faith. The certificate is a sworn statement that attest you are actively attending mass, practice the catholic faith, and have received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Therefore, if you are not a registered parishioner of this this parish, you will not be able to be a sponsor. If you wish to become a parishioner, then you must register and wait a three-month period before we give you the certificate. Completing the Sacraments in this parish does not qualify you to receive a sponsor certificate.

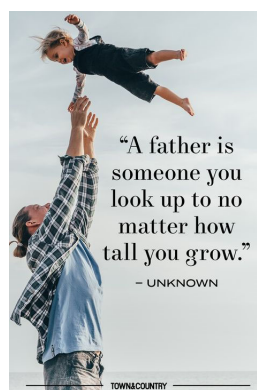

## *Reflections for the week*

From the beginning, the Holy Trinity accompanies our spiritual life. During the sacrament of Baptism, God the Father speaks to everyone the same words He said to Jesus: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased," (Lk 3:22). Jesus invites us to an intimate friendship. And the Holy Spirit fills us with God's love. So we are included in a triple relationship. We have a childlike relationship with God the Father, the Creator; with Jesus Christ, the Savior - a relationship of friendship and brotherhood; and with the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier - the relationship of love, holiness.

Created, redeemed and sanctified, despite the sinfulness and the dark side of our lives, we enter into a relationship with the Holy Trinity: "In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." By the sign of the cross we usually start and end the day, and throughout the day before meals, work, travels, important matters ... . In the name of the Holy Trinity the priest forgives sins. We start and end Holy Mass in the same way. In the name of the Holy Trinity, we will say goodbye to this world to go to eternal life.

How do I make a sign of the cross? Am I aware that I am doing this in the name of the Holy Trinity? What signs and events during my life remind me of the Holy Trinity in a special way? Do I feel like a child of God the Father, a friend of Jesus Christ and sanctified in the love of the Holy Spirit?



## *Refleksja na tydzień*

Trójca Święta towarzyszy od początku naszego życia duchowemu. W czasie sakramentu chrztu, Bóg Ojciec wypowiada wobec każdego te same słowa, które wypowiedział nad Jezusem: „Tyś jest mój Syn umiłowany, w Tobie mam upodobanie” (Łk 3, 22). Jezus zaprasza nas do intymnej relacji przyjaźni. A Duch Święty napędza Bożą miłością. Zostajemy więc włączeni w potrójną relację. Z Bogiem Ojcem, Stworzycielem, łączy nas relacja dziecięctwa; z Jezusem Chrystusem, Zbawicielem – relacja przyjaźni, braterstwa; a z Duchem Świętym, Uświęcicielem – relacja miłości, świętości.

Stworzeni, odkupieni i uświęceni, pomimo grzeszności i ciemnej strony naszego życia, wchodzimy w relacje z Trójcą Świętą: „W imię Ojca i Syna, i Ducha Świętego”. Znakiem krzyża zwykle rozpoczynamy i kończymy dzień, a w ciągu dnia posiłki, pracę, podróże, ważne sprawy... W imię Trójcy Świętej kapłan w sakramencie pojednania odpuszcza grzechy. W taki sam sposób rozpoczynamy i kończymy Mszę św. i każdy psalm w Liturgii Godzin. W imię Trójcy Świętej pożegnamy ten świat, by przejść do wiecznego życia w Niej.

W jaki sposób czynię znak krzyża? Czy towarzyszy mi świadomość, że czynię to w imię Trójcy Świętej? Jakie znaki i wydarzenia w ciągu życia w sposób szczególnie przypominają mi o Trójcy Świętej? Czy czuję się dzieckiem Boga Ojca, przyjacielem Jezusa Chrystusa i uświęconym w miłości Ducha Świętego?



## STATEMENT OF THE NEW JERSEY BISHOPS

### Reinstating the General Obligation to Attend Mass

At this time, due to the observance of public safety protocols and the increase in the availability of vaccines, we have begun a return to some sense of normalcy in various sectors of our society.

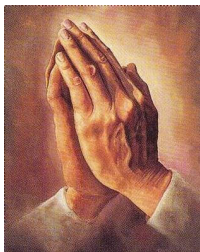
*Therefore, we the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey, are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligation beginning on Saturday, June 5, 2021, and Sunday, June 6, 2021, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.*

We welcome the Christian faithful to return to the regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith (cf. Code of Canon Law canon 1247 and Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2180). This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus or another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult the local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass (canon 87).

Finally, safety protocols (such as wearing masks, social distancing, etc.) and liturgical directives (communion in the hand, communion under one species, etc.) in each New Jersey Diocese remains in place until modified or revoked by the respective Diocesan Bishop

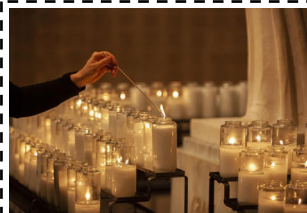
