Reflections for the week

The second Sunday of Easter will forever be associated with God's Mercy. As we read in the Diary: "I want the first Sunday after Easter to be the Feast of Mercy (no. 299). I want the Feast of Mercy to be a refuge and shelter for all souls, especially for poor sinners. On that day, the bowels of My mercy are opened, I pour out a whole sea of graces on souls who approach the source of My mercy" (no. 699). Christ himself invites us and awaits our response full of faith and trust. Today's Gospel shows us the Apostle Thomas, who, no less than the other Apostles, wanted to be convinced that Jesus was alive, that He had truly risen from the dead. St. Gregory the Great, pope is right when he writes that: "Thomas' unbelief helps our faith more than the faith of the Apostles". Thomas, in fact, teaches us a faith far from hasty judgments, sudden exultations, impulses of the heart or flights of passion. They may have some importance in the process of growing in our faith, but this is not the most important thing. All the effort of faith serves to strengthen and purify it. This must happen for it to truly become supernatural and not merely our natural predilection. Allow me today to invite you to try in faith. We must constantly fight for it so as not to lose it, because the world will test it in different ways. Let us therefore often repeat after Thomas and confess: My Lord and my God!

Refleksją na tydzień

Druga niedziela Wielkanocy już na zawsze kojarzyć się będzie z Bożym Miłosierdziem. Jak czytamy w Dzienniczku: "Pragnę, ażeby pierwsza niedziela po Wielkanocy była świętem Miłosierdzia (nr. 299). Pragnę, aby święto Miłosierdzia było ucieczką i schronieniem dla wszystkich dusz, a szczególnie dla biednych grzeszników. W dniu tym otwarte są wnętrzności miłosierdzia Mego, wylewam całe morze łask na dusze, które się zbliżą do źródła miłosierdzia Mojego" (nr. 699). Sam Chrystus nas zaprasza i oczekuje naszej odpowiedzi pełnej wiary i zaufania. Dzisiejsza Ewangelia ukazuje nam Apostoła Tomasza, który nie mniej niż inni Apostołowie pragnął nabrać przekonania, że Jezus rzeczywiście żyje, że prawdziwie powstał z martwych. Ma rację św. Grzegorz Wielki, papież, który swego czasu napisał, że: "więcej pomaga naszej wierze niewiara Tomasza niż wiara Apostołów". Tomasz bowiem uczy nas wiary dalekiej od pochopnych sądów, nagłych uniesień, porywów serca czy wzlotów namiętności. One co prawda mogą mieć jakieś znaczenie w procesie wzrostu naszej wiary, ale to nie jest najważniejsze. Cały trud wiary służy jej wzmocnieniu i oczyszczeniu. To musi nastapić, aby naprawdę stała się ona nadprzyrodzona, a nie była jedynie naszym naturalnym upodobaniem. Zapraszam was zatem dzisiaj do wysiłku w wierze. Trzeba nam o nia nieustannie walczyć, aby jej nie stracić, bo

świat będzie ją doświadczał na różne sposoby. Powtar-

zajmy zatem często za Tomaszem i wyznawajmy: Pan

mój i Bóg mój

Certificates of Eligibility to Become a Godparent

To become a Godparent or Confirmation Sponsor you will need a letter/form stating that you are a Catholic in good standing. Catholic in good standing means you are a registered member of the Church and regularly attend services. We cannot issue a letter/form to become a Godparent or a Sponsor if you do not attend Masses on a regular basis and are not a registered member here at St. John Paul II Parish. If you do not attend St. John Paul II Parish but did receive your Confirmation here we can issue you a certificate with the information regarding your sacraments only.
